

**MINUTES OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING OF EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION
OF INDIA HELD ON 21st OCTOBER 2014 AT CONFERENCE HALL, QMG'S BRANCH,
SENA BHAWAN, NEW DELHI**

1. The Executive Committee Meeting of Equestrian Federation of India was held on 21st October 2014, at 1400 hrs at Conference Hall, QMG's Branch, Sena Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Lt Gen Omprakash, PVSM, UYSM, AVSM, SM, President EFI.

3. **Opening Address by the President:-** The President in his opening address congratulated the newly elected the Executive Committee Members and welcomed all including special invitees to the Executive Committee Meeting and then he asked the Secretary General to start the proceedings.

4. **Agenda-I: Progress on last EC Minutes Points and Passing of Minutes.**

4.1 **Amendments to Tech Guidelines 2013:-** The Secretary General informed the house that necessary amendments to Tech Guidelines 2013 has been carried out. NEC Prelim Dressage Test has been made equivalent to FEI Prelim Test and Water Jump in NEC Gd I, II & III Normal Jumping has been included and the amended guidelines is now available on EFI Website.

4.2 **Re-naming of EDFZ, Meerut as Army Equine Disease Free Zone:-** The point has been discussed at Agenda No VIII and covered by VP Vet. It was directed by the President that the assets remain as training assets at RVC Centre & College, Meerut and will continue to be utilized as such since the approval for using it as a quarantine station expires on 31 Oct 2014.

4.3 **Passing of last EC Minutes:** There being no further discussion on the subject, the passing of minutes was proposed by **Col S S Solanki (Retd)** and seconded by **Mr Siddhartha Sharma**.

5. **Agenda-II : Secretary General's Briefing.**

5.1 **Results of Events after Last EC Meeting (17th Asian Games):** The Secretary General presented the results of Indian riders in 17th Asian Games 2014 held at Incheon (South Korea) wef 19 Sep to 04 Oct 2014. Detailed results are attached at Appx A.

5.2 **Court Case:-** The Secretary General informed the house that a writ petition was filed by Mr Angad Sahlot on 08 Sep 2014 for his selection in the Indian Show Jumping Team representing in 17th Asian Games 2014 and was listed as urgent case. Hon'ble justice of Delhi High Court on 11 Sep 2014 directed that urgency of the case cannot be granted and directed that petitioner may file an additional affidavit. Legal fee of Rs 1,75,000.00 (Rupees one lakh seventy five thousand only) has been paid to Indian law Associates / Sr Adv Rajiv Dutta for defending the case on behalf of the NF. The EC was of the unanimous opinion that above fees is on the higher side and negotiations can be done into for out of court settlement in future. This point to be discussed with the legal advisor.

State of Expdr and Govt Grant for 17th Asian Games 2014

5.3 **Loan Against Fixed Deposits:-** The Secretary General informed the house that as per decision taken in the last EC Meeting held on 05th Sep 2014 due to delayed receipt of financial grant from the Govt for 17th Asian Games, the Federation had taken a loan of Rs 33,25,000.00 on 05 Sep 2014 from HDFC bank against its fixed deposits for making advance payment of one way air freight charges (horses) to M/S Re-Rogers, New Delhi. The loan amount has been reimbursed to HDFC bank on 11 Oct 2014 alongwith an interest of 2% i.e. Rs 38,435.00/-.

5.4 **Govt Grant & Expdr for 17th Asian Games**:- The Secretary General informed the house that the federation has projected a for fund of **Rs 2,18,33,800/- (Rupees two crore eighteen lakh thirty three thousand eight hindered only)** for 17th Asian games to MYAS/SAI/IOA. Out of which the following grant has been received from IOA / MYAS so far :-

- (a) Rs 60,00,000.00 on 15 Sep 2014
- (b) Rs 50,00,000.00 on 27 Sep 2014

Complete details of expenditure is att at Appx 'B'. Some bills are still awaited from the athletes and same will be included while submitting final claim to MYAS/IOA. The President has directed that all the expenditures incurred for 17th Asian Games, Incheon be verified through a board of officers before submitting the final claim to Govt of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. He also directed that all pending bill should be deposited forthwith.

5.5 **Indian Officials Participated Abroad**:- The Secretary General informed the house that following officials of this NF have participated in events held abroad:-

- 5.5.1 Col P P Singh (Retd) was invited as steward at World Equestrian Games at Normandy, France during Aug 2014.
- 5.5.2 Col S S Ahlawat, VSM was invited as steward for 17th Asian Games, Incheon.
- 5.5.3 Mr Manoj Jalan was invited as FEI rep for 17th Asian Games, Incheon.

5.6 **Meetings/Invitations**:- The Secretary General informed the house that following meetings and Invitations has been received by the NF for participation and the same was approved by the house:-

- 5.6.1 The FEI general assembly 2014 is scheduled to be held at Baku (Azerbaijan) from 11 - 14 Dec 2014. The President and Secretary General have been invited.
- 5.6.2 The FEI Group – VIII meeting 2014 is scheduled to be held at Dubai on 05 Nov 2014. The President and Secretary General have been invited.
- 5.6.3 Invitation has been recd from Equestrian & Tent Pegging Federation of Pakistan (ETFP) for under 19 – International Tent Pegging Championship scheduled from 05th to 10th Jan 2015 at Lahore.

5.7 **Meeting of Coaches & Secy Gen NF With Secretary (Sports), MSDEYA & SAI**:- The Secretary General informed the house that a meeting was held at SAI on 20 Oct 2014 to evaluate the performance of Indian Team (Equestrian) at recently concluded Incheon Asian Games-2014. The points of the meeting were as under:-

- 5.7.1 Below average equestrian performance and report of the foreign coach which refers to the complacent and lackadaisical approach of the eventing riders and non adherence to the coaching directives in letter and spirit.

5.7.2 False hope given for medals.

5.7.3 Lameness of horse Allegro does not commensurate with the prior to departure reports submitted by the vet and coaching staff.

5.7.4 A letter being written by the Secy (Sports) to the President with reference to the action being contemplated by the Federation against the show jumping rider, vet board and coaching staff for seemingly approving an unfit horse.

5.7.5 Funding of Col R Pattu, SJRP, VSM

The President, after due deliberation and discussion on the subject directed that this was the best possible team selected for the Asian Games after the trials and VP (Vet) also gave expert opinion that lameness of the horse is symptomatic and can not be taken as granted. The committee agreed that extensive checks were carried out by vet experts on Allegro before departure and the horse was sound when he left India.

6. **Agenda III - Performance of Indian Team**:- The Secretary General flashed the result of Indian Teams in both the Indl/Team category alongwith the results of other country/riders and briefed about the Indian performance. The results are attached at Appx 'C'. The President praised the performance of the players especially in the individual category of various events. He urged the equestrian fraternity to go even further to achieve better results.

7. **Agenda IV – Tentative calendar, Bids and Suggestion from members for the year 2014-15**:- The Secretary General informed that the bids received on the EFI events calendar 2014-15, the calendar is att at Appx D. After due deliberation the following was decided:-

7.1 JNEC (Excluding Dressage & Endurance) given to MP Equestrian Academy, Bhopal.

7.2 NEC Jumping venue to be ascertained, if could be held at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore.

7.3 NEC & JNEC Endurance will be held at Dibrugarh under Equestrian Federation of Assam.

7.4 CSI 'B' to be planned near Delhi Horse Show 2015.

7.5 All India Preliminary Jumping to be given to MP Equestrian Academy, Bhopal alongwith JNEC.

8. **Agenda V – Revision of List of National Officials (Judges/TD/CD/Steward/FEI Vet)**:- The Secretary General flashed list of all National Officials (Judges/TD/CD /Steward/FEI Vet) before the house. The President directed that inputs be obtained and list be put up to him for approval post haste.

9. **Agenda VI – Important letters/Mails from Ministry/Members:-**

9.1 **Letter recd from Andhra Pradesh Equestrian Association regarding formation of Telengana State and report recd Mr Kishore Futnani:-** The Secretary General informed the house that AGM of AP State Equestrian Association has been conducted on 14 October 2014 for formation of Telengana State Eqtn Association and election of office bearers of both Telengana and Andhra Pradesh Equestrian Associations. Further, he informed that report from Mr Kishore Futnani, Regional Member South is still awaited on the matter. Decision will be taken based on the report.

9.2 **Letter recd from Mrs Shruti Vora regarding sponsorship for her training for Rio Olympics 2016 under National Sports Development Fund Scheme:-** The President directed that a committee be formed to vet such requests for its merit and it will put up its recommendations accordingly.

9.3 **Mail recd from Col Sarpratap Singh (Retd) for obtaining membership of International Tent Pegging Federation (ITPF):-** After a brief discussion on the merits of obtaining EFI membership of International Tenet Pegging Federation (ITPF), the President approved for obtaining membership of International Tenet Pegging Federation (ITPF) by the EFI.

9.4 **Letter recd from RVC Centre & College regarding recovery of rent & allied charges for stabling of civil horses and accommodation for grooms/supporting staff in EDFZ, Meerut:-** The matter was discussed by the house and the President directed that the bill be put up to SAI for release of funds and if SAI does not honour it, in that eventuality the bill will be cleared by the EFI.

9.4 **Letter received from RVC Centre & College regarding waiving off of corpus money for conduct of calendar events:-** The house pointed out that the waiving off corpus money may send out wrong signs and EFI is as it is strapped for cash, therefore corpus money needs to be paid.

10. **Agenda VII – Re-naming of EDFZ, Meerut:-** The EDFZ, Meerut, henceforth will be known as Army Equine Disease Free Zone.

11. **Agenda IX : New Membership:** The name of following Individuals/Club/Unit members was flashed for the EC. Each name was perused and the house approved the new membership to the individuals/clubs unanimously.

12. **Agenda X: Any Other Points from Members:-** Col Sarpratap Singh (Retd) gave the following points:-

12.1 Revival of Asian Tent Pegging Association.

12.2 Revival of State Associations.

12.3 Asst Secy Nafe Singh of EFI should get house rent allowance & perks like PF account as due to him as per norms from the Ministry.

The President directed that all the points merit considerations and to get wheels in motion with reference to the ibid points.

13. There being no more points from the members, the President proceeded with the closing address and directed the following points for implemented:-

13.1 **Press and Publicity Cell:-** The President was dismayed that there is no coverage of any EFI event in any media what so ever. He directed that urgent steps be taken to have a meaningful and constructive media & publicity cell. He directed that Col P P Singh (Retd) will head this cell and that concrete measures will be instituted to project EFI and its activities in true positive style.

13.2 He complemented the selection committee, EFI Sectt and all officials whose collective support and relentless hard work ensured a fairly chosen strong team in all three disciplines. He said we achieved quite a few 'Firsts' in these Asian Games.

13.4 The President emphasized the need for more bonhomie amongst the players which can very well be achieved while retaining competitive spirit. The rider should spend quality time in practice with their horses.
