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NATIONAL QUALIFIER GUIDELINES - 2025 IN RESPECT OF TENT PEGGING, ENDURANCE FOR SENIORS AND FOR SHOW JUMPING AND DRESSAGE FOR NEC SUB JUNIOR (CHILDREN-I, II), JUNIOR & YOUNG RIDER

Introduction

1. The Equestrian Sports unlike other sports does not have Distt/ State level championships due to lack of infrastructure and many other reasons. As a result of which many a times naïve horse-rider combinations have participated in National Championships thereby diluting the sanctity of the National Level Competition. A concept in the form of an event named "National Qualifier (NQ)" has been developed to offer more opportunities to riders to participate in various competitions and earn requisite qualification to compete at the National level.

Objective

- 2. (a) Promote Equestrian sports at all over country by improving its club/institution members.
 - (b) Promote more organizing center and venues to hold equestrian events.
 - (c) Popularize the sports throughout the country.
 - (d) Offer more competitions to horses-riders in their own region city thereby reducing the burden of transportation cost.
 - (e) Select riders worthy of participation at National level.

Concept

3. To achieve the above objectives, holding of Equestrian competitions proposed on the lines of FEI World Challenge format will be conducted all over the country with prior approval of EFI through its registered clubs/institutions member only.

Conduct

- 4. Jury/Officials shall be detailed as given below for each **NQ** to ensure that the desired levels are not diluted:-
 - (a) A min of two Jury/Official as per EFI National list will be proposed by OC and approved by NF.
 - (b) EFI Rep will be detailed by NF who will act as an interface between the OC and Federation. The EFI rep will forward a detailed report on the conduct of NQ within 72 hrs of completion of the NQ.
- 5. The Course plan for **Show Jumping** approved by EFI is as given in **Appx 'A'** of these guidelines. The course plan for Show Jumping will be reviewed every year by an FEI approved Course Designer which will be choosen by the Federation. EFI Technical Guidelines-2024 will be followed for conduct of the **NQ** alongwith related FEI Rules & Regulations as applicable.
- 6. The **Dressage** test for various categories is as given in **Appx 'B' to 'E'**. EFI technical guidelines will be followed for conduct of the **NQ**.
- 7. For **Tent Pegging** event, EFI technical guidelines will be followed for conduct of **NQ**.





- 8. For **Endurance**, EFI Technical Guidelines at Article 321 will be followed for conduct of **NQ**.
- 9. The MER as per **Appendix** 'F' will be followed and a rider must achieve two MERs to be eligible to participate in NEC Senior, Sub Junior (Children-I & II), Junior & Young Rider as applicable.

10. Eligibility for Participation.

- (a) To be eligible to participate in **NQ** the rider and the horse should be member of a registered club/institution of the EFI. The Rider can be an Individual or life member of EFI, wherein the horse shall be ridden by the owner or their dependent NOK upto to age of 21 years. Such eligible horse/riders can participate in any number of **NQ** being held at various venues all over the country as per **NQ** calendar published on EFI Website to achieve the desired MER. A rider from any club/institution registered with EFI can ride any horse of any other club/institution provided that both the clubs/institutions are registered with EFI.
- (b) The rider have to obtain MERs as stipulated at **Appx F** to participate in Individual and Team Events at the NEC Sub Junior (Children-II & I), Junior & Young Rider, NEC Tent Pegging and NEC Endurance (as applicable).
- (c) Riders holding valid Indian passport only will be permitted to participate in **NQ**. Others may be permitted as HC entry only for which prior approval of EFI will be obtained by the club/institution of the rider.
- (d) In terms of para 8 of Article 502, a rider who wishes to participate in higher category other than his/her actual category, an undertaking to be forwarded to EFI prior to their participation in the first **NQ** for approval. Also, the rider in such cases need to achieve their **NQ** MER in the higher category choosen by the individual.
- 11. **NQ** will be conducted only for the following categories: -
 - (a) **Seniors**: Only for their participation in NEC Tent Pegging and NEC Endurance.
 - (b) Young Rider, Junior, Children I & Children II: Only for their participation in Show Jumping and Dressage events of NEC Sub Junior (Children-II & I), Junior & Young Rider.
- 12. Expenditure on account of travel (to & from event location) perdiem, local transportation, accommodation and hospitality of officials including EFI Rep shall be borne by the OC.
- 13. The OC to use their own infrastructure. It is mandatory for OCs to conduct **NQ** within the precincts of their own location.
- 14. It is mandatory for the OC to conduct vet inspection of horses on arrival at the Camp and horse inspection before start of **NQ** in compliance with laid down vet protocols and FEI Vet regulations.
- 15. The OC in consultation with jury members shall ensure that none of the participants are students/relatives of the jury. In such a case the club of the participating rider shall recuse the rider from participating and notify the Federation accordingly. The OC shall publicise the list of jury of the event atleast 4 weeks before the event so that the clubs/institution/ life/individual members can submit their entries accordingly.





16. **Entry(s)**.

- (a) Entry(s) must be sent to the EFI only by the registered club/institution member of which the respective rider is a member on prescribed entry form attachment as **Appx 'G'**. The entry fee will be deposited with OC conducting the event post receipt of list of participants from EFI and prior to horse inspection. The horse and the rider can be of same or different club/ institution but it is mandatory that both are from a EFI registered club/institution.
- (b) A life/individual member of EFI can send their own entry(s) or of their dependent children upto the age of 21 years directly to EFI on the prescribed entry form attachment as **Appx 'G'**. The entry fee will be deposited with OC conducting the post receipt of list of participants from EFI and prior to horse inspection.
- (c) All entry(s) for Young Riders, Juniors, children I and II category riders must be accompanied by proof of age (passport/national ID). The minimum and maximum age of respective categories eligible to participation in 2025 are attach as **Appx 'H'** to enable all authorized agency/ individuals to make their entries for participation NQs with EFI accordingly.
- (d) All entry(s) must have EFI horse passport number, EFI registration number and name of the horse as well as and rider's EFI I.D.
- (e) Participation will not be accepted without the prescribed fee to be deposited with the OC.
- (f) An eligible horse rider combination can take part on a maximum of one horse only in both disciplines and their qualification is subject to rules mentioned in **Appx F**.

17. Period of NQ:-

- (a) NQ for NEC Sub Junior (Children-II & I), Junior & Young Rider will start from the 1st of January every year with the last NQ conducted 30 days before the commencement of NEC- Sub Junior, Junior & Young Rider for Show Jumping and Dressage.
- (b) **NQ** for Tent Pegging will start immediately after NEC Tent Pegging and last **NQ** will be conducted 30 days before the commencement of next NEC Tent Pegging.
- (c) **NQ** for Endurance will start immediately after NEC Endurance and last **NQ** will be conducted 30 days before the commencement of next NEC Tent Pegging.
- 18. **Results**. The OC will ensure that scanned copy of results duly signed by jury and EFI Rep alongwith results on excel sheet is emailed within 24 hours of completion of each category of event. Original result sheets alongwith all supporting documents will be dispatched by post to the Federation office within 48 hours of completion of the **NQ**.

Incentive

19. A one time incentive will be given by EFI to a club/institution conducting an **NQ** once in a calendar year. Rs 50,000/- will be given if participation is over 25 riders and Rs 25,000/- to be given for less than 25 riders.






Procedure


- 20. Interested OCs may forward their bids to EFI 30 days prior to conduct of **NQ** as per format attached as **Appendix 'J'**. A relaxation of 30 days lead time after each NEC Sub Junior (Children-II & I), Junior & Young Rider, NEC Tent Pegging and NEC Endurance is accorded to all bidding OCs who wish to conduct the **NQ** within 30 days upon completion of previous year's NEC Tent Pegging/Endurance. However, in such case submission of bid forms alongwith corpus fee will be forwarded to EFI and on approval will be included in EFI's **NQ** Calendar.
- 21. The EFI reserve the right to ascertain that the venue of **NQ** is fit to conduct the **NQ** by the bidding OC. It is mandatory for each OC to conduct one **NQ** every three months as per period of **NQ** stated at Para 17 above, otherwise no further **NQ** shall be allocated by EFI. The gap between each **NQ** should be more than 30 days if the same OC wishes to host **NQ** continuously.
- 22. On allotment of the event, the same will be included in the EFI's **NQ** Calendar which will facilitate all horse-rider to plan their move to various venues and participate to achieve MER to qualify for respective NEC.
- 23. Organizers will have to deposit a refundable security of Rs 50,000/- alongwith bid form atleast 30 days prior to conduct of **NQ** which will be refunded alongwith with one time incentive mentioned in Para 19 on successful completion of event. In case of non compliance of EFI Rules & Regulation during the conduct of the event, the security deposit will be forfeited.
- 24. OC will ensure size of Show Jumping arena with soft footing to be min 65 x 45m.



















Appendix

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR EVENT ALLOTMENT

- 1. All events being conducted under the aegis of EFI are categorized as "EFI events" for which an OC can bid as a venue partner of EFI wherein the infrastructure and requisite administrative support for conduct of event will be mandatorily provided by the OC. The EFI reserves the right to cancel or relocate the event with or without reasons.
- 2. A corpus money amounting to Rs 50000/- (Refundable) for the event will be deposited along with the bid (Bid without 100% corpus money will not be considered for event allotment).
- 3. A Technical Evaluator (TE) at the discretion of EFI may be detailed to carry tech evaluation of the venue prior to the event. In case the OC fails to meet the tech and adm requirements for conduct of the event, the TE is auth to recommend cancellation of the bid.
- 4. In case the OC fails to meet the technical & administrative requirement for conduct of the show, the EFI Rep will recommend cancellation of the show. The Federation reserves the right to cancel the event with or without reasons. In event of such cancellation, the organizer will forfeit their corpus money.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the OC to ensure that, Young Rider, Junior, Children-I and Children II participate in their age group only.
- 6. The OC will also ensure use of safety cups and electronic timers for all Show Jumping and Tent Pegging events respectively.
- 7. The OC will appoint a person as a contact person to interact with the Federation on all issues connected with the **NQ** event. It is recommended that the contact person is also the Show Secretary and is available with the OC one month prior to the Show and till completion of events.
- 8. The OC will ensure that soft copy of manuscript results duly signed by jury and EFI Rep alongwith result in excel sheet is emailed within 24 hours of completion of each category of event.
- 9. Original result sheets alongwith photograph of complete event in a CD and other supporting documents duly signed by the jury and EFI Rep for all events will be dispatched by post to the Federation office within 2 days of completion of show.
- 10. Veterinary facilities must be made available 24 hours in the camp and during the conduct of events at the show ground.
- 11. The OC will ensure welfare of horse as given in Note 1& 2 of Appendix F and FEI code of conduct on the subject.
- 12. First aid & Ambulance with Doctor must be available during the conduct of events and camp.
- 13. The Ground Jury and other officials for all events will be detailed from EFI empaneled official list and as per terms of Para 5 of **NQ** Guidelines.
- 14. The travel expenses to and fro (as applicable), boarding, lodging & local transport for the all officials, EFI Rep and TE (if detailed as per para 2 above) who are nominated by EFI to check the smooth conduct of the show, will be mandatorily borne by the organizer.





- 15. The OC will provide remuneration to all National level and above civilian/Retd officials and EFI Rep @ Rs 2500/- per day for the duration detailed/utilized for conduct of events and will be paid before the culmination of the event. The same will be communicated to this NF prior to completion of the event.
- 16. The OC of Tent Pegging will conduct all Tent Pegging disciplines as per EFI rules.
- 17. The BID to host an NQ will forward to EFI as per para 18 of NQ guidelines.
- 18. The OC shall forward each day the following to facilitate EFI's PR Agency for publicity:-
 - (i) 2-3 High resolution photos of event with name of Rider and astride participating in the event.
 - (ii) 2-3 High resolution photos of all medal winners with officials alongwith their names.
 - (iii) Any other information required by EFI for publicity through its PR Agency like video clips etc.

Sponsorship Policy

- 19. (a) The OC shall abid by EFI sponsorship policy in totality and without representation. The EFI reserves exclusive rights to raise funds through sponsorship/donations/ Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) for conduct of events under its name wherein an OC through existing Bid procedure may be permitted to conduct an event on behalf of EFI at any of their venues. The OC shall mandatorily provide all support to the EFI's sponsorer during conduct of the event to provide publicity as required by EFI.
 - (b) The OC can generate own sponsorships which shall be done with prior approval of EFI without any legal obligation for EFI. The OC in this case needs to declare the amount received and planned expenditure for which approval of EFI is required. All in house venue partner's sponsorer shall not be provided any placement for publicity in line with EFI's sponsorer but through OC's placements only subject to approval of EFI..
- 20. In case of any dispute/ clarity, the OC will only approach the Secy Gen and the decision given by EFI will be final and binding.
