

ADM INSTRUCTION FOR NEC – 2019 (PRE- NOVICE, NOVICE, CI
(LONG + SHORT) & CI***) AND BANGALORE HORSE SHOW FROM
15 MAR TO 25 MAR 2019 AT ASC CENTRE & COLLEGE,
BANGALORE**

General.

1. National Equestrian Championship 2019 (Pre- Novice, Novice, CI**- L, CI**-S CI***-S) and Bangalore Horse Show will be held at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore, from 15 Mar to 25 Mar 19.

Camp Arrangements.

2. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located near Military Farm under the arrangement of No 1 ASC Trg Centre. Contingents will ensure that they do not reach the camp before 11 Mar 19. They will also ensure that suitable arngs for the return journey are made by them in time since the camp will close down on 30 Mar 19. CO No 1 Trg Bn (AT), No 1 ASC Trg Centre will be overall resp for camp est and its functioning.

3. The camp commandant as nominated by No 1 ASC Trg Centre will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the allotted site from the camp Comdt on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition. Any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be responsibility of the OIC of the Contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all respect of their personnel and animals.

4. All teams will intimate show secretary about the total str of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 05 Mar 19 and intimate ETA well in advance as per format attached as Appx 'A' to this adm Instruction. The camp will be functional wef 13 Mar 19 (AN).

Accommodation.

5. JCOs and OR will be accommodated in camp area, civilian participants to make own arrangements for accommodation. Accn for participating offrs will be made avlb on sharing basis under the arng of ASC Centre & College. Allotment of accn will however be subject to availability and does not constitute right to accn. Serving offrs to come prep to stay in offrs mess guest room if due to any reason the room in mess not avl then they will stay in hotels (on TD). Hotels details are as under:-

Civilians.

6. Suitable camping site near the horses will be earmarked by Camp Comdt for accommodating grooms and support staff. The contingents should be self contained to ration & accommodate their civil personnel.

- **Note :- The cost of one temporary stable for civilian will be Rs. 3500/- for the duration of the show.**

Practice and Exercise Area.

7. Suitable arenas will be earmarked for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise arena will be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the event.

Lighting.

8. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/ petromaxes/ Gen Sets for emergency use. However light/power supply shall be provided under camp arrangements where feasible.

Ration for Army Animals.

9. Ration for army animals will be drawn ex No 1 Trg Bn (AT), No 1 ASC Trg Centre, Bangalore. Sufficient packing materials for storages of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingents for horses and men. Contingents will submit their indents for drawing rations and get station order done. Any civil horses participating will make their own arng for animal ration.

Transport.

10. Contingents are advised to be self contained for transport incl tpt for conveyance of animals and stores from respective unit location to Bangalore to back.

Line Gear for Animals.

11. Contingents will bring adequate line and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Pitching of Tents

12. Contingents will pitch their own tents in the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

13. No families are permitted in the camp.

Fire Precautions

14. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precautions of their respective areas. The Camp Commandant however, will detail fire fighting/piquet parties from amongst the participating contingents, if required. Min three FF pts adequate FF eqpt will be est in the camp area.

Sanitation and Hygiene

15. Proper sanitation and hygiene measure will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti-malaria precautions will be taken.

Discipline

16. All participants, grooms and supports staff coming for the Championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp Commandant for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

Security

17. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingents during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Bangalore. Local/station orders on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All contingent Cdrs will ensure that security passes for the civilians accompanying them are collected from the office of Dy Comdt, No 1 ASC Trg Centre imdt on arrival. Camp Comdt will ensure that no civ is permitted to stay in the camp without security pass 24 hrs after his arrival.

Veterinary/ Medical Cover

18. Veterinary cover to animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 49 Military Veterinary Hospital, Bangalore, who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp, OC 49 MVH will be assisted by VO ex No 1 ASC Trg Centre. Medical cover will be provided under the arrangement of SMO, No 1 ASC Trg Centre.

Coggin's test for Equine Infectious Anemia, Mallein test / CFT for Glanders

19. All animals are required to be Coggins's tested before their arrival at Bangalore as per latest policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animal should have been Mallein tested / CFT negative and exam by Veterinary Officer with certificate stating to be free from any infectious or contagious diseases, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggins's and Mallein/CFT negative certificates **IN ORIGINAL** are to be produced to Camp Commandant on arrival. The minimum validity of Coggins's test on arrival at the camp should be 10 days.

20. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will be done by a designated veterinary officer to ascertain the health status of the animals.

21. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 19 ibid or arriving before stipulated date 11 Mar 19 will not be allowed to unload their horses in ASC Centre & College premises and these horses will not be allowed to camp / training areas.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS
NEC 2019 (PRE- NOVICE, NOVICE, CI(LONG + SHORT) & CI***) &**
BANGALORE HORSE SHOW MAR 2019

1. National Equestrian Championship 2019 (Pre- Novice, Novice, CI**-L & CI**- S & CI***-S) will be held at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore, from 15 Mar to 25 Mar 19. The competitions will be conducted as per FEI and EFI guidelines. All participants are advised to go through the EFI technical guidelines, rules, regulations and specifications, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.

2. List of the events - Ref Appx 'A' & 'B'

3. Tentative schedule - Ref Appx 'C'

4. **Entry Fee.**

(a) All entries must be on the prescribed Entry form given in **Appendix 'D'** and should be complete in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will be rejected. All entries must have the EFI horse passport number description. EFI number & name of the horse concerned.

(b) **Foreign Riders** - Managers/ coaches of all teams/clubs/school who are arranging for foreign nationals as coaches/ staff for National Equestrian Championship all Eventing 2019 are required to forward the details of the foreigners as per format enclosed at '**Appendix D**' alongwith photocopy of their passport and visa, 30 days prior to start of the competition to the EFI, so as to obtain MI clearance from the concerned authorities. Foreigners whose MI Clearance is delayed for want of submission of details by the team manager/coaches will not be allowed to enter the ASC Centre & College Area. Foreign riders are not allowed to participate in NEC-2019.

(c) Entries must be sent to the Show Secretary, Organizing Committee, NEC Events (CI**- L & CI***-S, Novice & Pre- Novice) c/o ASC Centre & College, Bangalore, PIN-560007. To facilitate processing of the data please email a copy of the entries to trainingmashal@hotmail.com.

(d) Attention is drawn to Article 12 of EFI Technical Guidelines for Horse Concourse entries.

(e) **Entry Fee** - The entry fee will be as under:-

(i) Team Events- Rs 1000/- per team.

(ii) Individuals Events- Rs 500/- per entry.

- (iii) There will be separate entry fees for CI** - L, CI** - S & CI*** - S, Novice & Pre Novice Eventing for team & indl events.
- (f) No entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.
- (g) Closing date for entries - Entries will close by 1700hrs on 13 Mar 2019. Entries received thereafter will be regards as POST ENTRIES. However, post entries will be accepted up to one hour before the draw of lots for each event. No entries will be accepted thereafter. Post entries fee will be:-
- (i) Team events - Rs 2000/- per team
 - (ii) Indl events - Rs 1000/- per team
- (h) **Payment** - All entries must be paid in cash or by local cheque in favour of ARPA A/C on or before closing date. No verbal entry will be accepted. No entry will be considered if payment is not made alongwith entry form.
- (j) **EFI Horse Passport.**
- (i) As per EFI rules all horses participating in the National Equestrian Championship Eventing (All grades), Novice & Pre-Novice have to be in possession of passport.
 - (ii) No entry accepted without EFI registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. The horses participating in the event will be registered with the EFI prior to the show.
- (k) Riders interested in participation in CI** (S), CI** (L), CI*** (S) (Non NEC) are requested to fwd their entry directly to EFI before 1500h on 20 Mar 2019. No entry will be accepted thereafter.

Note : No Entries will be accepted for NEC (Eventing) without valid horse passport no and regn no issued by EFI

5. **Entries.** All entries (except the FEI entries) will be on the prescribed specimen performa att as Appx 'D', 'E' & 'F' for events and sent to Honorary Secretary, Organizing Committee, NEC Eventing (All Grades) c/o ASC Centre & College, Bangalore, PIN-560007. Riders / Units will be responsible for submitting correct entry, complete in all respects.

6. **Payment.**

(a) The entry fee may be paid in cash or Demand Draft in favour of ARPA.

(b) There will be separate payment for NEC Eventing (Pre-Novice, Novice, CI** & CI***) BHS.

7. **Transfer and Substitution.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying additional entry fee for the class to which is transferred. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another for any reason, whatsoever.

8. **Eligibility of Horses.** Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades. All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. Riders are liable to disqualified and or penalized for incorrect entry of the horses, as per EFI regulations. All horses categorized in 1* will be permitted to participate in CI** (L) only for NEC however they may participate in CI** (S) Non NEC entry. Similarly all horses categorized as 2* in grading list will only participate in CI*** (S) as NEC entry however they may participate in any category as non NEC entry.

9. **Technical Specifications of Events.** The events will follow broadly the Technical Guidelines of FEI and EFI as per the relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications / number of rounds for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions.

10. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good cause/reason for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horse will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the stewards concerned.

11. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Regn number on the bridle during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable under a saddle. If a horse is not registered at the show office within 24 hrs of the entry at the venue and not later than 24 hrs before the draw of lots of the event. The details to be provided for registration are (a) Name (b) Year of foaling (c) Sex (d) Breed (e) Identification marks (f) Discipline participating in.

12. **EFI Rider Registration.**

(a) All the riders of 18 Years age and above, participating in the EFI recognized events should be obtain EFI ID No from EFI Office, EFI Rider ID Fee is Rs 500/- per head.

(b) Rider who does not have EFI Rider ID Number will not be permitted to take part in the event.

13. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless altered on appeal under rules.

14 **Objections.** Objection may be lodged in written by the team Captain/ Competitor to the Technical delegate within 30 minutes before commencement of the event and for objections concerning irregularities or incidents during the competitions not later than half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs 2000/- in cash will accompany the objection and will be refunded, if the objection is up held.

15. **Responsibility.** The organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accidents or any cause or in any form.

16. **Disqualification.** The ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.

17. **Correspondence.** All communication should be addressed to Honorary Secretary, Organizing Committee, NEC Eventing, BHS c/o ASC Centre & College, Bangalore clearly marked at the top centre of the envelope. It would be advisable to send entry form with entry fee draft and other important communications by Registered Post.
