The Secretary General with the permission of Chair informed the house that the subject matter was forwarded to EC for consideration on email and based on their in-principle approval, an advertisement inviting interested vendors was placed on EFI Website & National Newspapers. The procurement committee was activated. 1 Play Sports India was identified as the vendor with lowest and reasonable rates. Mr Harish Khokhar brought out the efforts should be made to live telecast of X-Country phase of Eventing through static cameras because due to presence of trees, the drones are used above tree line which adversely affects the video quality. The Secretary General said this will be taken up with the firm.		
12. <b>Sponsorship Policy</b> . The Secretary General with the permission of Chair brought out that EFI's Sponsorship policy has been completed by the committee which was formed vide Para 11.12 of Minutes of EC meeting held on 20 Aug 2021. The same will be circulated to EC members shortly for their perusal and concurrence. The Secretary General also informed the house that EFI had received form 80G from IT Department to accept funds under Sponsors/Donations/CSR for EFI in Nov 2021.
