3. **Opening Address by the Vice-President (Adm):-** The Vice-President (Adm) welcomed all the members. He further expressed his opinion that all should participate in the proceedings with open mind and without inhibition as this forum is basically for improvement of the equestrian sports in India.

4. **Agenda-I: Progress on last EC Minutes Points and Passing of Minutes.**

4.1 **Promotion of Equestrian Sports in India/NE India:-** The Secretary General informed the house that FEI Solidarity Officer visited India wef 09 Apr to 12 Apr 2015 and the report is being submitted to FEI soon.

4.2 **Court Case : Mr Angad Sahlot v/s Uoi & Others :-** The Secretary Gen informed that the NF advocate appeared on our behalf on 17 Apr 2015 at Delhi High Court. However, the Hon'ble court has adjourned the matter and now listed the case for hearing on 11 Sep 2015

4.3 **17th Asian Games:** The Secy Gen informed the house that claim of Rs 1,13,99,260/- is still pending with IOA. After a meeting with Secy Gen (IOA) on 23 May 2015, it was informed that the claim forwarded by all NFs are under audit at their HQ, the same will be cleared once the audit is carried out by IOA. Vice-President (Adm) directed to pursue the case with IOA.

4.4 **State of Fixed Deposit:-** The Secretary General informed that as per directions given in the last EC Meeting an amount of Rs 50 lakh has been fixed deposited with Syndicate Bank on 17 Apr 2015 with interest rate of 8.50%

4.5 **Recommended amendments to tech Guidelines 2013:** The Secretary General informed the house that amendments have been noted and same will be put up before the upcoming AGM for approval. A few amendments which are recommended have been discussed at Agenda No V. The same was agreed to by the house.

4.6 **Four Eventing events in the next calendar year:** The Secretary General informed that the same has been included in the draft calendar year 2015-16

4.7 **Passing of last EC Minutes:** There being no further discussion on the subject, the passing of minutes was proposed by Col B S Lakra and seconded by Col S S Solanki (Retd).

He further informed that presently, the show jumping set is held with ASC Centre & College, Bangalore which was transported there before the conduct of NEC Eventing Championship during Apr 2015. Vice-President (Adm) directed to explore if another jumping set could be procured for northern region.
