REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE & 28TH EXCELLENTIA HORSE SHOW

GENERAL

1. The Regional Equestrian League & 28th Excellentia Horse Show is being organized by the Excellentia Equitation Centre, on the 13th & 14th January 2018 at the Excellentia Equitation Centre grounds on Farm No. 5A, Osho Drive, Sultanpur Mandi Road, Gadaipur, Chattarpur, New Delhi.
2. All the events will be conducted as per EFI guidelines with an aim to provide every horse and rider with a safe & encouraging competition environment according to the standards laid down for Equestrian Events by the Equestrian Federation of India.

OVERVIEW

EVENTS

The REL & 28th Excellentia Horse Show will comprise of the following events which will be conducted over two days. The events at the show are as follows:

12. EHS 1.40 m Jumping Normal
13. EHS FEATURE EVENT: OPEN JUMPING SIX BAR
14. GYMKHANA EVENTS:- Childrens Ball & Bucket, Pole Bending, Boot & Hay Race
15. HACKSEVENTS:- Open Hacks, Beginners Hacks & Equitation Class
16. DRESSAGE EVENTS:- Intro Dressage, Preliminary Dressage, Open Dressage (FEI Elementary Test)
17. AGE CATEGORY DRESSAGE EVENTS:- CH-1, CH-2, Junior Dressage & Young Riders Dressage.

The events :- 50 cm, 80 cm, 90 cm, Ball & Bucket, Pole Bending, Boot & Hay Race, Open Hacks, Beginners Hacks & Equitation Class of the Excellentia Horse Show, will have two sets of prizes, one for seniors category and one for juniors category. The age division of Junior and Senior categories will be decided based on the number of entries received by the jury prior to the competitions to ensure maximum promotion for the riders, specially young riders.



REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE 13th & 14th JANUARY 2018

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL

1. The REL & 28th Excellentia Horse Show will be held on the 13th & 14th of January 2018 at the Excellentia Equitation Centre, New Delhi.

INTIMATION FOR PARTICIPATION

2. All teams desirous to participate in the said event will intimate the show secretary about the total strength of contingent and ETA in terms of participants/adm staff/syces/grooms and horses positively by the 5th of January 2018, well in advance, as per format attached as appx 'A' to hon. sec REL for arrangement of reception.

CAMP ARRANGEMENTS

3. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located at the competition venue. The camp will be functional from 12th to the 15th of January 2018. All teams/contingents to ensure that they do not reach the Camp before 12th. The camp facilities will not be available after 15th.

The cost for stabling will be as follows:

1. Rs. 500/- per horse per day for ready stables (temporary).
2. Rs. 200/- per horse per day for setting up of own camp/stables.
3. The Show Secretary will earmark site for each contingent/team/indl. The rep of the contingent/team/indl will take over the allotted site from the Show Secretary on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition. Any damage to Camp site, accn or property will be the responsibility of the OIC of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all respects for camping arrangement in respect of their personnel and animals.

ACCOMMODATION

4. All participants are requested to make their own arrangements for accommodation. Camping site near the stabling area of civilian horses will be earmarked for accommodating grooms and support staff. The contingents/indl/riders should be self-contained with respect to tentage and other basic requirement for camping of their personnel. Any help reqd pertaining to tentage etc to be intimated 10 days in advance.

PRACTICE AND EXERCISE AREA

5. Suitable arenas will be earmarked for exercise & practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise arena will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the event.



LIGHTING

6. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/petromaxes/gen set etc for emergency use. However, light/power supply shall be provided under camp arrangements.

LINE GEAR FOR ANIMALS

7. Contingents should bring adequate line gear and picketing gear. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

PITCHING OF TENTS

8. Contingents will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

FAMILIES

9. No families will be accommodated in the camp. Any participant/supporting staff coming along with their family have to look for their own accommodation/lodging.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS

10. Contingents will be responsible to cater for their own fire fighting equipments and ensure fire preventive measures of their respective areas. The Camp Commandant however, will detail fire fighting/piquet parties from amongst the participating contingents, if required.

SANITATION AND HYGIENE

11. Measures to ensure proper sanitation and hygiene in camp area as well as on the venue of the competition, will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animal litter by tight packing. All necessary anti-malaria precautions will be adhered to.

DISCIPLINE

12. All participants, grooms and support staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under camp commandant for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is always maintained.

PERS TPT/VEH/PETS

13. It is advisable that no teams/participants/supporting staff bring pets into the camp area or venue of the event. If unavoidable, same should be intimated to the organizing committee well in advance. However under no circumstances, pets should be brought to competition area/venue.



SECURITY

14. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingents during their stay in the camp. All army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during their stay at the competition venue.

VET HEALTH PROTOCOLS, COGGIN'S AND CFT TESTS

15. All participating equines are required to be examined by the Veterinary Officer at station of origin and issued with a certificate duly countersigned by SEVO stating them to be free from any infectious or contagious disease. In addition to this, they must be in possession of valid negative Coggin's test certificate and seronegative CFT certificate for Glanders, in original. These certificates will only be valid for particular strn. of participation and will have to be issued by authorized test centres as per latest policy in vogue. The validity of Coggin's test on arrival at the camp should preferably be such that animals returns to their respective places within the validity. Test date will be calculated from the date on which the sample was collected.
16. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will also be done by a designated veterinary commission to ascertain the health status of the animals on arrival.
17. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 20 above or arriving before stipulated date i.e 13th September 2017 will not be allowed to unload their horses at the competition venue and will not be allowed access to camp / training areas. No animal will be allowed to enter the camp area till veterinary and health documents are checked and found to be in order.

REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE (REL) 13th & 14th JANUARY 2018 AT THE EXCELLENTIA EQUITATION CENTRE, DELHI

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. REL is being organised at Excellentia Equitation Centre on the 13th & 14th January 2018. The competition will be conducted as per FEI & EFI guidelines.

ENTRY FEE

2. All individual events - Rs. 500/- per exhibit.

CLOSING TIME/DATE OF ENTRIES

3. Entries will be accepted upto 10th January 2018. Entries after due time/date shall be considered as late entries and charged as under:

- (a) All individual events - Rs 1000/- per exhibit.

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider regn. no., horse passport no. and regn. no. issued by EFI.

ENTRIES

4. All entries will be on the prescribed specimen proforma att as Appx 'C' for events and sent to Honorary Secretary, Organizing Committee, Regional Equestrian League (REL), c/o Excellentia Equitation Centre, New Delhi. Riders /units will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.

PAYMENT

5. (a) The entry fee may be paid in cash, cheque or demand draft in favour of EXCELLENTIA SPORTS PVT. LTD.

TRANSFER AND SUBSTITUTIONS

6. A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another for any reason, whatsoever.

ELIGIBILITY OF HORSES

7. Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades. All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. A hard copy of the current grading list will be available in the camp office and displayed on the notice board of show office. Riders are liable to be disqualified or penalised for incorrect entry of the horses, as per EFI regulations.



TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS OF EVENTS

8. The events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of EFI as per the relevant discipline.

REPORTING FOR EACH CLASS

9. All animals will report to the collecting ring stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the ground jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.

SHOW NUMBER

10. All horses will display the EFI Regn. no. on the bridle during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable under a saddle. If a horse is not registered with EFI, fee of Rs. 500/- must be paid along with the details of the horse to be registered at the show office within 24 hrs of the entry at the venue and not later than 24 hrs before the draw of lots of the event.

The details to be provided for registration are:

- (a) Name
- (b) Year of foaling
- (c) Sex
- (d) Breed
- (e) Identification marks
- (f) Discipline participating in.

HORSE PASSPORT

11. All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. No entries will be accepted without valid horse passport and regd No issued by EFI.

JUDGING

12. Decision of the ground jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

OBJECTIONS

13. Objection may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitor to the technical delegate within 30 minutes before commencement of the event and for objections concerning irregularities or incidents during the competition not later than 30 min after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 1000/- in cash will accompany the objection and will be refunded, if the objection is upheld.

RESPONSIBILITY

14. The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.



DISQUALIFICATION

15. The ground jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition/ practice for rough handling, excessive brutality/abuse or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.

LEASE OF HORSE

Excellentia Equitation Centre will also provide horses on lease for the competition to the riders based on prior intimation and availability. The lease amount will be Rs. 10,000/- for jumping competitions. All riders/teams desirous of leasing horses for the event may please contact the show office at the earliest. Horse will be available for lease for the EHS 50 cm and EHS 80 cm jumping only.

PARTICIPATION

1. Horses may be ridden by more than one rider in one Category except for Hacks.
2. Competitors may also ride more than one horse in one category while still staying competitive with each horse.
3. The competitor may ride the same horse in two or more different events.
4. Each horse may compete in a maximum of upto three rounds on one day.
5. There is no limitation on the number of competitors for any competitions.

ENTRIES

Entry fee for Excellentia Horse Show, is Rs 1,000/- per entry for each class.

1. The last date for receipt of entries is 10th January 2018 till 05.00 PM
2. All Entry fees must be paid in cash at the show office on the competition venue. Format for entries is attached
3. Entries not submitted on the prescribed format or not accompanied by entry fee will not be considered for draw of lots.
4. Riders/Clubs will be responsible for submitting correct entry, complete in all respects.



CLOSING TIME/DATE OF ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted latest till Two hour before the commencement of each class. Entries received after due date will be considered 'Post Entries' with a fee of Rs. 1,500/- per entry.

DISQUALIFICATION

The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify any Competitor at any stage of the competition/ practice for rough handling, brutality or any act of cruelty to animals, or for any reasons, which they feel justified.

WHIPS AND SPURS

Whips of up to 110 cms are permitted for all categories when working or while warming up on the flat.

1. On entry into the practice arena and the main arena for a jumping event, only whips of 75 cms or less are permitted.
2. Longer whips are prohibited in the practice jumping arena and the main jumping arena. Whips upto
3. 110cms are allowed in all the dressage competitions including the warmup.

JUDGING

Decision of the Ground Jury will be final under all circumstances.

MEDALS/ TROPHIES & ROSETTES

Medals/ Trophies and rosettes will be awarded to winners for all events upto 4th position in each class. Kindly note that 50cm, 80cm, 90cm, Ball & Bucket, Pole Bending, Boot & Hay Race, Open Hacks, Beginners Hacks & Equitation Class will have two sets of prizes, one for Seniors and one for Juniors.

The age division of Junior and Senior categories will be decided based on the number of entries received by the jury prior to the competitions to ensure maximum promotion for the riders, specially young riders.

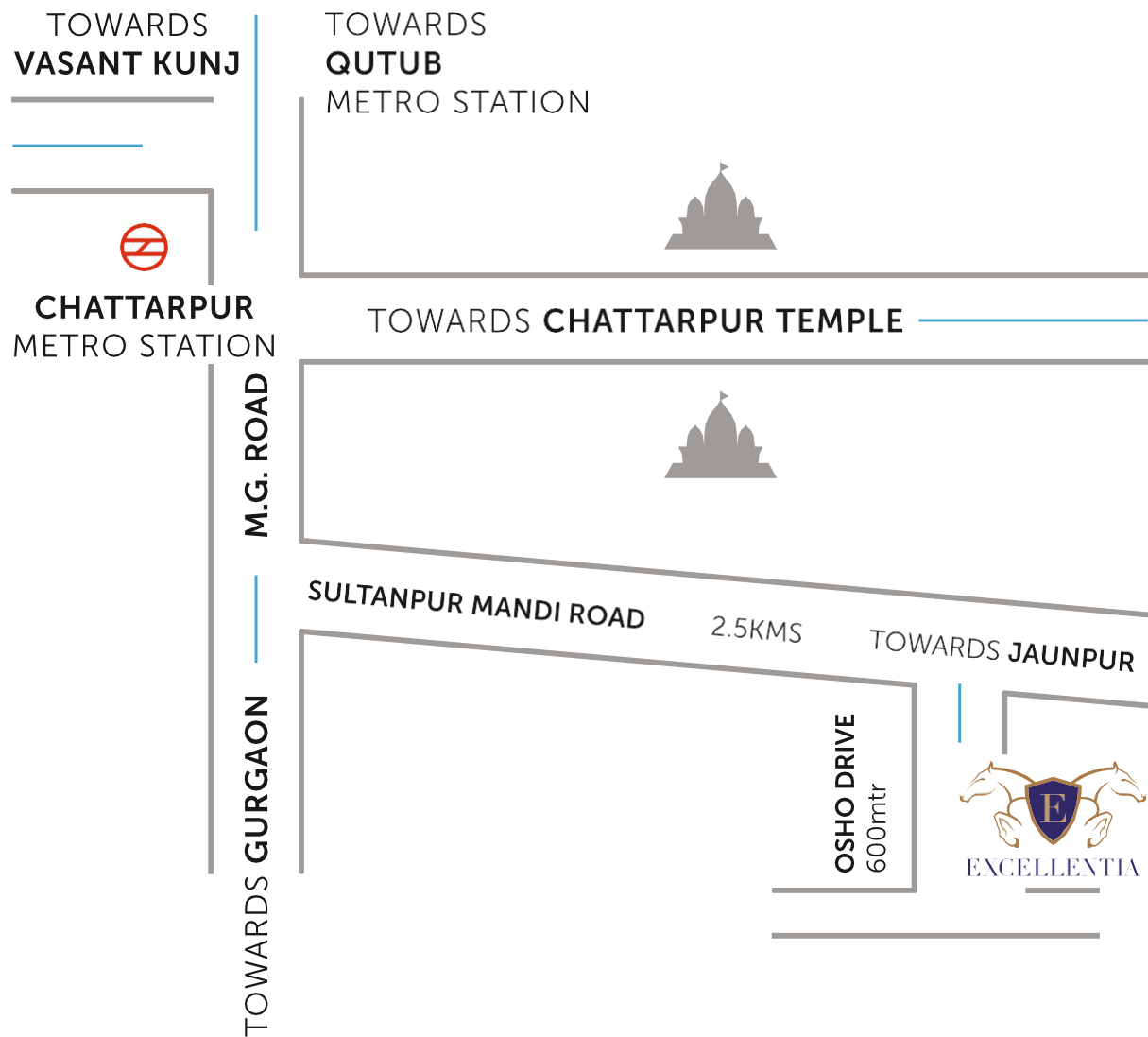

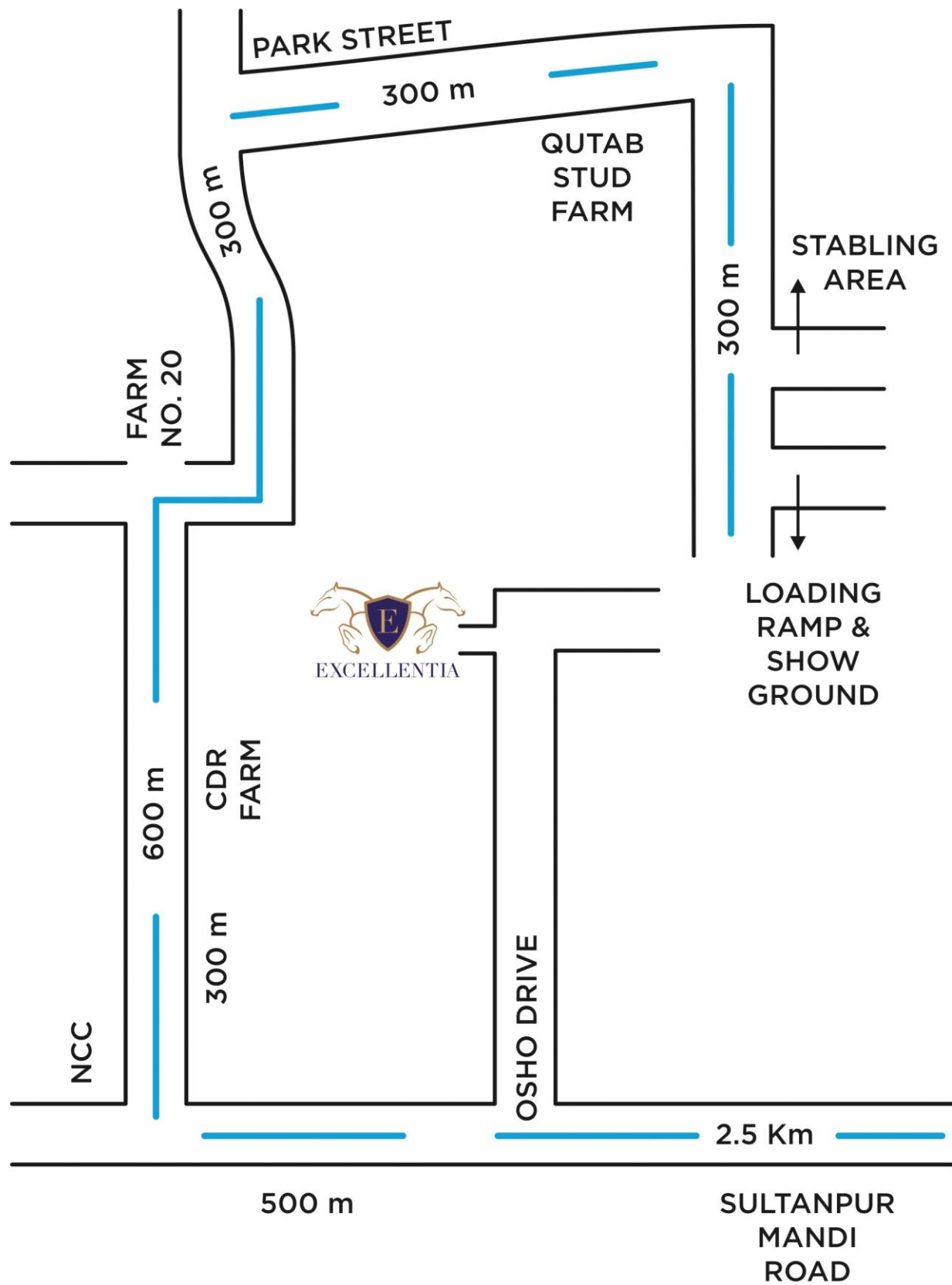
