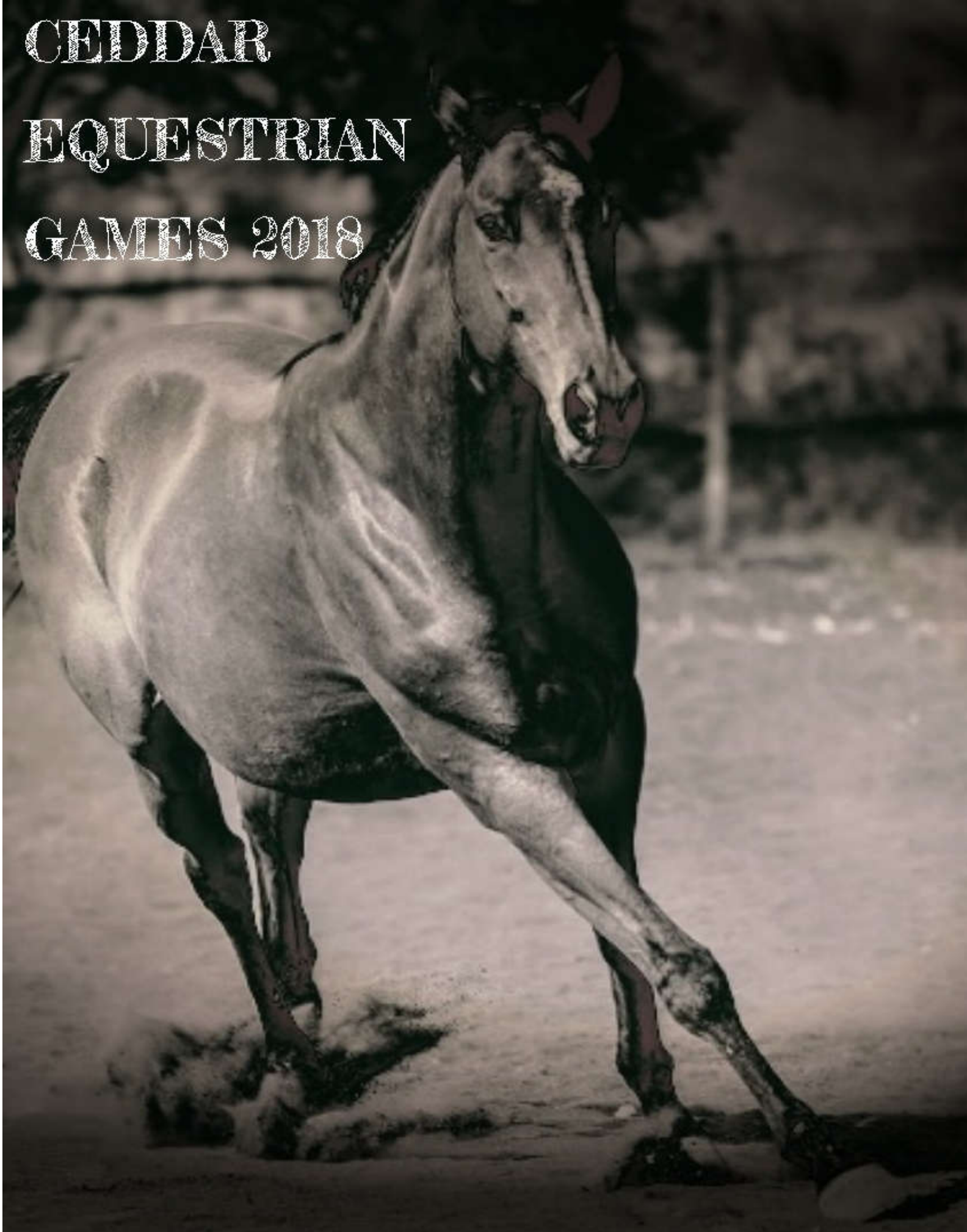

VERVIEW

1. Stabling And Camping:

Temporary stables will be made available to the clubs. Clubs/ Individual riders are requested to inform the office about their stabling requirement latest by 4th Oct 2018. Charges for the stables would be Rs.1500/per stable.

Camping grounds can be provided to those wishing to make their own stables at the rate of Rs. 500/stable.

All contingents are expected to keep their respective stable areas clean and tidy and must be equipped with their own cleaning equipment.

All horse manure will be disposed of at a common spot to enable effective clearance and teams are expected to abide by this.

Teams are to arrange their own transportation; there is a ramp for loading and unloading.

2. Categories:

A. For MEG AND CEDDAR GAMES:

Children Category: 14 years and under (Year of birth 2003 or later)

Junior Category: 15 to 18 years (Year of birth 1999 to 2002)

Open Category: Over 18 years (Year of birth 1998 or earlier)

Beginners Category: Participants must not have won in any previous events in any category before. It is open to riders of all ages.

Junior Category	Minimum 90 cms	Max 105cms
Children Category	Minimum 80cms	Max 90 cms
Beginners Category	Minimum 60cms	Max 80 cms

B. For REL events:

3. ENTRIES:

- a. All the entries can be mailed to the id below or can be submitted in office before 6th Oct 3pm. Entries submitted after that will be considered as post entries. Entry fees can be paid in cash in office or can be transferred online in the account below.

- b. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry** –

Withdrawal- The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

Transfer and Substitutions – A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

- c. All changes will be treated as post entries.
- d. Beginner Riders category is for riders who have not won anything in any event other than the beginners event itself. Similarly, Beginner horse category is for horses who have not been placed in any event or competition other than the beginners category itself.
4. **Cancellation of an event**- The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded
5. **Elimination/Disqualification** – the judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animal. Rapping will be severely penalized.

6. **Whips/Spurs** – As per EFI rules on the subject.
7. **Dress Code**- When inspection of the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, club shirt is compulsory. White shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn for dressage and REL events. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including rider's uniform.
8. **Responsibility** – The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury any animal of any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Organizer nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any aid or other medical treatment provided.
9. **Coggin and Glander Test** – All rules and instructions issued from the EFI on the subject will be strictly adhered to by concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander Status (CFT) certificate on arrival to the office.

10. Accommodation:

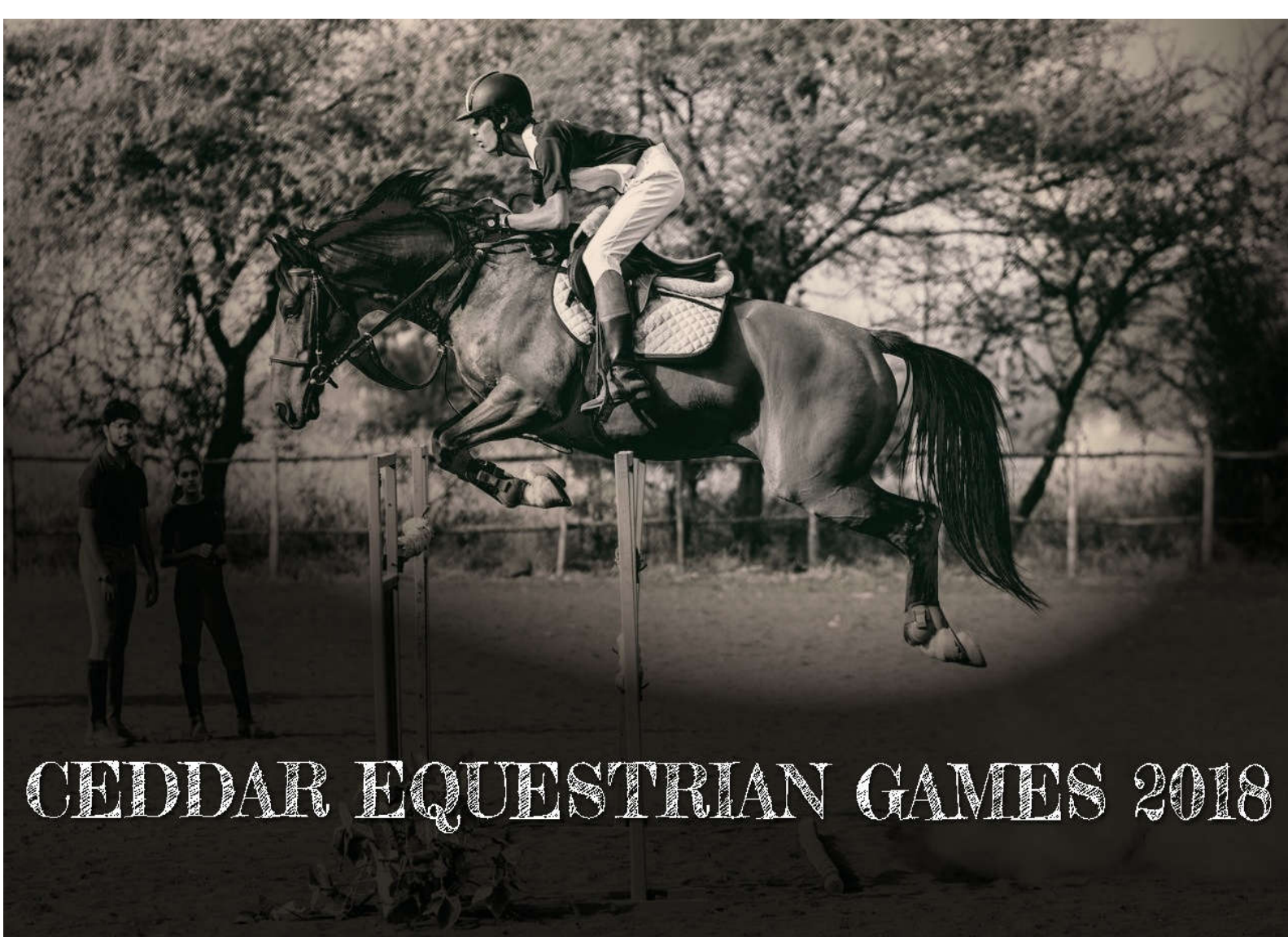
On-site accommodation is provided in 2 rooms (5 people max) with toilets and showers. Tent accommodation is limited to 10 beds, reservations for which will be first come first served. Room beds are charged at Rs.800 PER BED PER NIGHT and Tent beds are charged Rs.500 PER BED PER NIGHT.

Competitors may make their own food arrangements or avail of onsite cafeteria which will provide veg /non veg breakfast, lunch and dinner from a fixed menu.

Meal coupons can be purchased in advance or on site. Contingent staff/grooms etc may avail of these services as well.

Accommodation for contingent staff/grooms etc. must be arranged by individual teams.

11. The judges hold the right to disqualify any horse on medical fields. The organising committee and the judges may disqualify any rider for inappropriate behaviour towards horse or fellow participants.

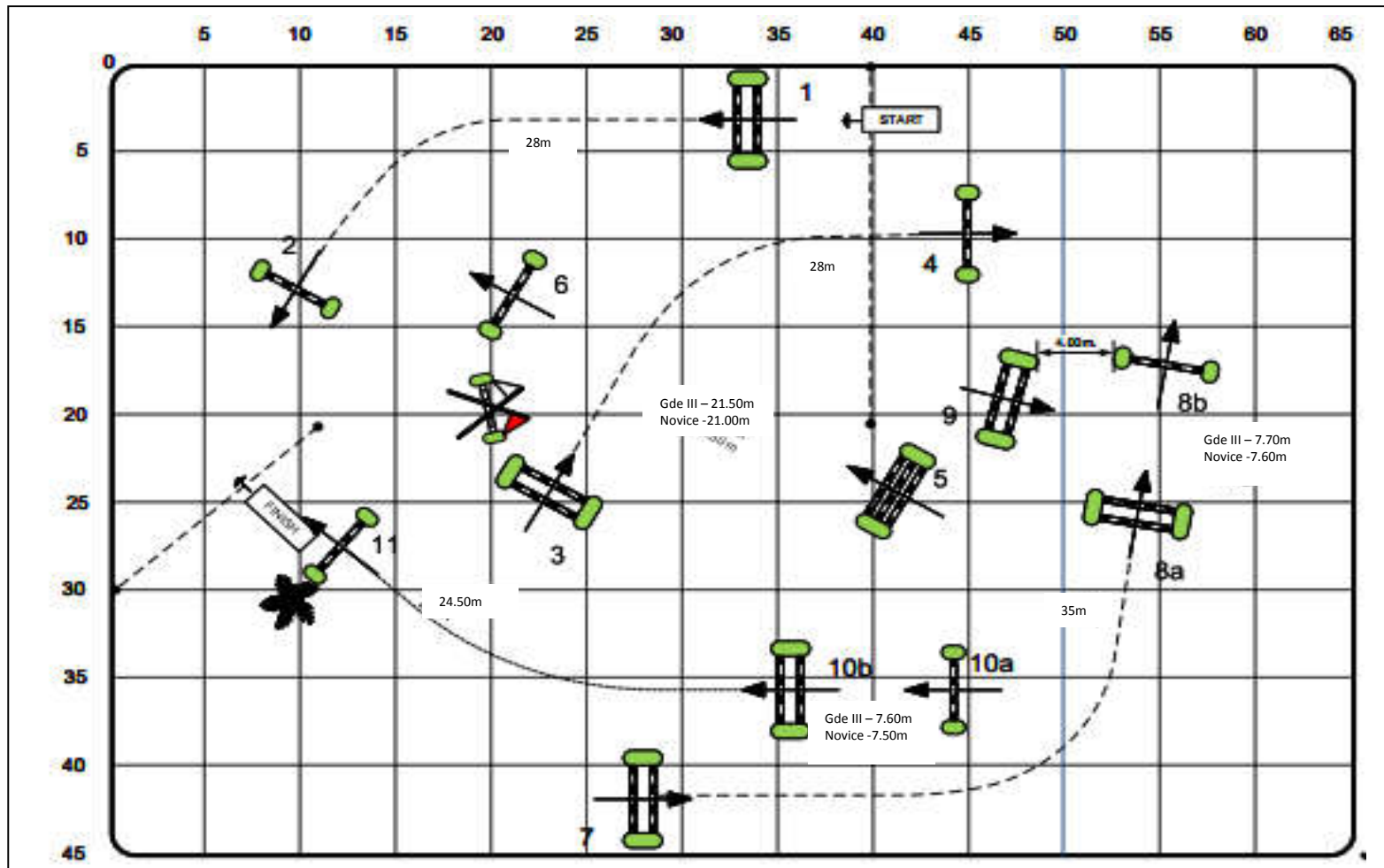

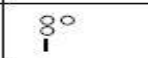

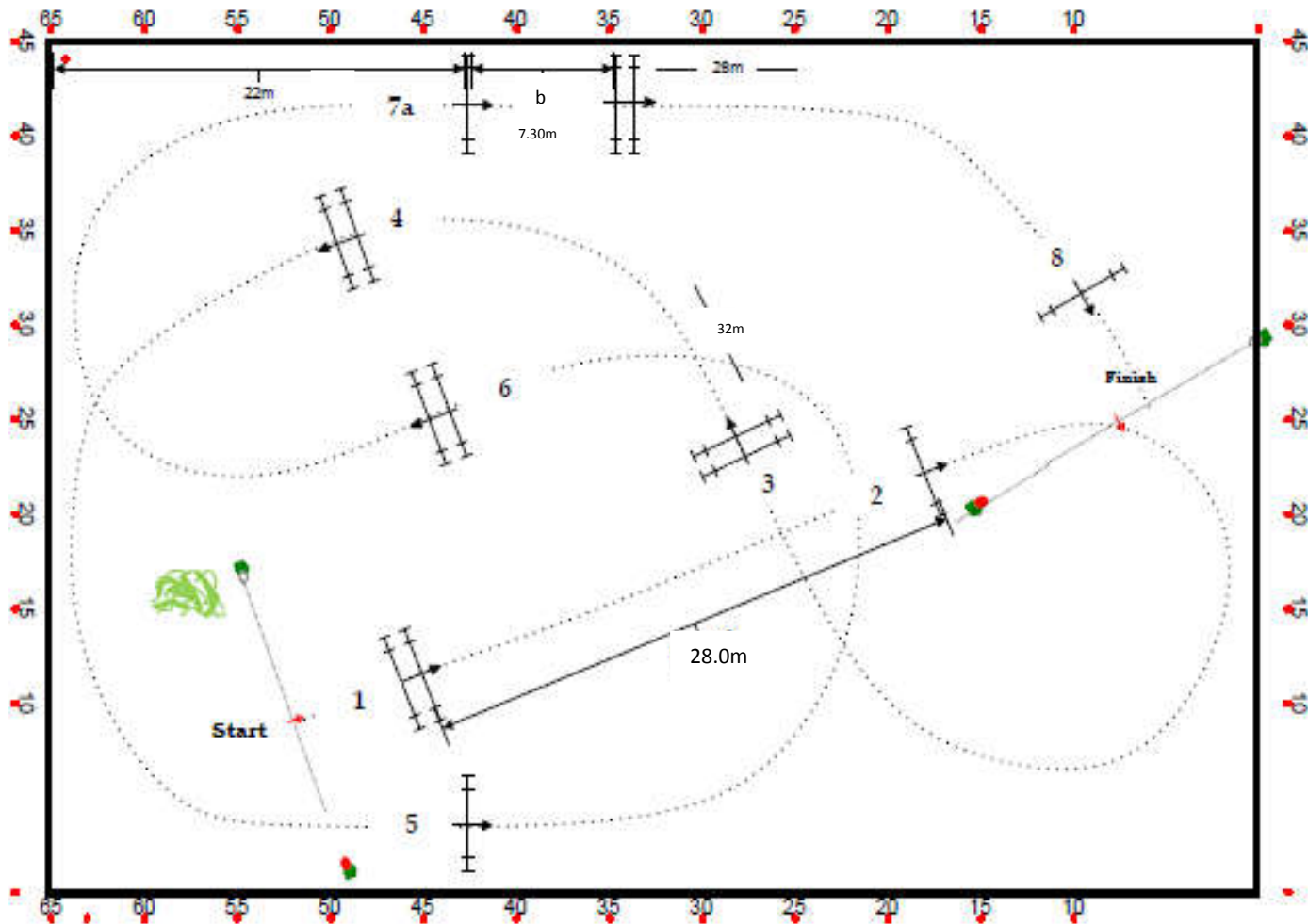
