

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. ENTRIES

There shall be an entry fee of Rs. 500/- for the Individual Events and Rs. 1000/- for the Team Events.

The last date for receipt of the entries is 18th December 2018. All entries received from 18th December and till two hours before draw of lots for the event/the elimination round, will be considered as a post entry and the fees will be Rs. 1000/- for individual entries and Rs. 2000/- for team entries. Entry not sent on the Prescribed form or not accompanied by Birth Certificate and EFI registration number, will not be entertained. Birth certificate/ Proof of age, certified by the school/college must accompany the entry form for the Young Rider, Junior, and Children I & II NEC. For Junior, Children I and Children II – Only REL qualified riders will be allowed to enter/participate in the dressage and show jumping Normal competition. For Jumping Accumulator and/or Top Score, REL qualification not required.

2. ENTRY FORM

All entries must be sent in the prescribed form appended to this prospectus. The name of the rider must be specifically mentioned in the Entry Form. A horse, once entered, cannot normally be substituted by another horse. The same horse cannot be competed in the same event by different riders. The organizers reserve the right to reject any entry without assigning any reasons.

3. PAYMENTS.

All payments will be made to "The Tollygunge Club Ltd" in the form of NEFT / RTGS, demand draft or cash only. Cheques will NOT be accepted.

4. WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Any entry can be withdrawn till 18th December 2018 without attracting any loss of fees. No refund of fees will be allowed for entries withdrawn after 18th December 2018 unless it has to be withdrawn on Veterinary grounds, and in such cases, a certificate from the Veterinary Officer will be required.

5. VET PROTOCOL

It is mandatory for all teams to submit the following valid test reports in respect of their horses before entering the camp.

- (a) Glanders Test
- (b) Coggins Tests

6. CHANGE OF HORSE/ RIDER

A horse/rider can be changed only up to two hours prior to the draw of lots of the event. However the entry shall be treated as a post entry.

7. ELIMINATION ROUND

In case there are a large number of participants for any event, elimination round will be held.

8. CANCELLATION OF AN EVENT:

In case the organizers feel that there are not enough entries for any particular event, that event may be cancelled. Such cancellation or alternative arrangements will be announced at the time of draw of lots for the events, a day prior to the event.

9. ARRIVAL OF THE HORSES / RIDERS AT THE SHOW GROUND:

All horses/riders should be present at the venue half an hour before the scheduled starting time for the respective event and report to the Marshall of the event.

10. CHANGE IN SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

The organizers may make changes in the schedule of events for which necessary announcements will be made at the event area.

11. REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI: (EFI Horse passport)

- (a) As per EFI rules all horses participating in the Junior National Equestrian Championship and All India Preliminary Show Jumping have to be in possession of EFI passport.
- (b) No entry will be accepted without EFI registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horse with EFI prior to the

12. REGISTRATION OF RIDERS:

All riders above 18 years are required to be registered with EFI.

13. SHOW NUMBERS:

All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition, veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the camp.

14. JUDGING

The decision of the Judges will be final.

15. OBJECTIONS

- ❖ All objections must be made in writing to the Appeals committee within half an hour of the completion of the event/announcement of results.
- ❖ A fee of Rupees Two thousand will accompany the objection. If the objection is overruled by the Jury, the deposit will be forfeited. The amount will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- ❖ All Objections/Protests will be governed by relevant EFI/FEI rules

16. LOSS OR DAMAGE

The organizers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any horse, rider or to any other person or property arising directly or indirectly from accident or any other causes. Neither the Committee nor the Vet / Med doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

17. ABUSE/CRUELTY

Refer to Article 13 of EFI Technical Guidelines 2009 shall be penalized severely and a rider maybe eliminated from the event.

18. ABANDONMENT

If for any reasons the show has to be abandoned, the competing units/civilian participants and concerned riders will be informed by fax, email or wireless.

19. RULES

The rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) and the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) will be followed for the conduct of the events of the competition, until and unless otherwise specified for any event.

20. TACKS, WHIPS AND SPURS

As per EFI guidelines and relevant FEI rules

21. QUESTIONS NOT PROVIDED FOR

In the eventuality of any questions arising that has not been covered in this prospectus, the matter will be referred to the Technical Delegate of the meet and his decision will be final.

22. CAMPING AND ACCOMODATION

(a) All civil horses will be stabled at the Tolly Club. The club camp will function from the 18th December 2018 to 1st January, 2019. All civil teams will ensure that they do not reach the camp before 18th December 2018. The representative of Tollygunge Club will earmark site for each civil team at the club. The team in charge will take over the sites allotted to them on arrival and hand them over before departure in the same condition. The team in charge shall be responsible for his teams discipline, security and precautions towards fire.

(b) All Army horses will be stabled at Hastings under the fly over. The camp for the same would be functional from 18th December 2018. For any queries regarding stabling arrangements and transportation of Army Horses please contact **Capt. Vishwadeep Dahiya (9622521414)**.

23. GRADING OF HORSES

It will be responsibility of the Riders / Clubs / Units to ensure that their horses are entered in the correct grade as per the latest updated list available with the EFI // on website / show office. Participation of the horse in wrong grade will entail elimination from that event and disqualification from the entire horse show along with a fine of Rs 1000/-. All prize money won in the events the horse has taken part in will be returned to the Organizing Committee and results annulled. If it is the last event that the horse is taking part in, **then a fine a Rs 1000/- will be deposited by concerned Rider with the Organizing Committee before the horse leaves the camp, which will be forwarded to the EFI. Failure to deposit the fee will entail disqualification from next event, whenever scheduled.**

24. RESTRICTION OF EVENTS

Some of the events in the Competitions are restricted to members and Horses/ Ponies stabled at The Tollygunge Club and The Fort William Riding and Polo Institute.

25. DRAW OF LOTS/STARTING ORDER:

The draw of lots will normally be held on the day before the day of the event. However, the organizers may change the draw of lots to any other time, after making necessary announcements for the same.

26. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS FOR JNEC EVENTS

- Age on 1st Jan of the Calendar year will considered valid upto 31st Dec.
- It will be compulsory to submit the birth certificate & EFI registration number along with the entry forms.

Foreign Nationals: Cannot Participate in the Junior National Equestrian Championship.

27. GRADING OF HORSES

As per EFI list posted on their website

28. TEENAGE EVENT :

Confined to horses exceeding 14.2 hands and to riders whose parents are members of the Tollygunge Club and the Fort William Riding & Polo Institute. Confined to riders who have not attained their 20th Birthday and have crossed their 12th birthday as on 23rd December 2018.

This event will be adjudged on individual performance i.e. the rider's performance, rather than that of the horse, with particular attention to the position of rider at different movements, method and correct use of aids and the co-ordination between the rider and his horse. The Judge may also ask the riders to change horses to judge their capability.

29.CONFINED RIDING:

Confined to horses/ponies and to riders and members of the Tollygunge Club and Fort William Riding & Polo Institute. This event will be adjudged on individual performance i.e. the rider's performance, rather than that of the horse, with particular attention to the position of rider at different movements, method and correct use of aids and the co-ordination between the rider and his horse.

30.CHILD'S PONY EVENT :

Child's pony, upto 14.2 hands, suitable to carry and to be ridden by a child of above 5 and below 12 years as on 23rd December 2018.

The event will be adjudged on the child's performance, i.e. the child's riding capability, with particular attention to the position and correct riding aids of the rider.

31. PAIRS EVENT:

The event will have a pair of riders, one on a horse and the other on a pony. The horse (over 14.2 hands) will be ridden by a rider above the age of 12 years. The pony should be upto 14.2 hands, and should be suitable to carry and to be ridden by a child of above 5 and 12 years of age.

In this event, the rider riding the horse will use a leading rein to perform various normal riding school movements as told by the judges, in coordination with his partner riding the pony. Coordination between the pair of riders in performing the movements will be judged in addition to the riding skills and the turnout of the riders and their mounts.

32. TROTting OF HORSES:

Trotting of horses will be held at Tollygunge Horse Camp and Army Horse Camp at Hastings on 23rd December 2018. The timings for the same will be intimated to the teams on 22nd December 2018. However if desired by the Jury the horses may be asked to trot a day prior to an event or on the same day of the event if a horse has been put on hold.
