40 Km and 60 Km All India Open Qualifier Endurance Championship

1. **General-** 40 Km and 60 Km All India Open Qualifier Endurance Championship 2019 event shall be held at Araavli trails resort, Palanpur, Gujarat on the dates 20, 21 and 22nd Dec 2019. Under the aegis of technical guidelines & rules/regulations of the equestrian federation of India. All participants are advised to go through the EFI technical guidelines, rules, regulations and specification, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.
2. **Tentative Programme** – Refer Appendix ‘A’
3. **Entries-**
 - a) All entries must be of the prescribed Entry form given in Appendix ‘C’ and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for All India open 40 & 60 km must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate). All entries must be EFI horse passport number description, EFI registration number & name of the horse concerned & Rider’s EFI I.D.
 - b) Entries must be sent to the Show office, Araavli trails resort, Palanpur, Gujarat. To facilitate processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to below mail:-

 - c) **Entry Fee-** the entry fee will be as under:-
 - i. Individual Events- Rs500/- per entry. Team Events Rs. 1000/- Per Team.
 - d) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.
 - e) **Closing Date for Entries-** Entries will close by 12:00 hours on 20th dec 2019, Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES. However, post entries will be accepted up to one hour before the draw of lots for each event. No entries will be accepted thereafter. Post entry fee will be:-
 - (i) Individual Events Rs. 1000/- per exhibit.
 - (ii) Team events Rs. 2000/- Per Team
 - f) **Payment-** All entries must be paid in CASH at the time of checking in at the event location.

g) EFI Horses Passport –

- i.** As per EFI rules all horses participating in All India open Endurance Qualifier 40 & 60 km - have to be in possession of EFI passport.
- ii.** No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the slow.
- iii.** All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be obtain EFI identity number.

4. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry –

- a) Withdrawal**- The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- b) Transfer and Substitutions** – A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- c) Change of Riders** – Riders cannot be changed unless the jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.
- d)** All changes will be treated as post entries.

- 5. Cancellation**- The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved , those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

- 6.** The class will start once the draw of lots for the order of start has been held.

- 7. Show Number** – All horses will display the EFI registration number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out from the stable.

- 8. Rosette**- No rosette will be worn by a horse during judging.

- 9. Elimination/Disqualification** – the judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animal. Rapping will be severely penalized.

- 10. Whips/Spurs** – As per relevant rules of EFI/FEI rules on the subject.

11. **Dress Code**- As per relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

- (a) Protective headgear, of a recognized equestrian/endurance standard and securely fastened, is compulsory for all persons at all Endurance events whilst mounted.
- (b) Safe riding footwear with heels of 12 mm or more, or alternatively caged/Boxed stirrups/equestrian safety stirrups are compulsory for all persons at all endurance events whilst mounted.
- (c) Dress, that is appropriate and not detrimental to the image of Endurance Riding is required.
- (d) Athlete :- Smart Pressed Team or Individual Riding uniforms.
- (e) Team Officials, Grooms, Crews :- Smart Pressed Team or Individual uniforms.
- (f) FEI Officials :- Smart Clothing to include jacket and tie where applicable, Shorts or sandals are unacceptable standards of dress and will not be allowed.
- (g) During the actual ride
 - (i) Athlete :- Appropriate riding attire, shirt/polo shirt to include a collar.
 - (ii) Team officials, Grooms, Crews : Smart Team or Individual attire. No Shorts within the Vet Inspection area, or sandals allowed within the 'Field of Play' (Safety).
- (h) Officials :- Smart working attire, no shorts or Sandals.

11. **Appeal** – Appeal can be lodged by competitors with two hours before the commencement of any class and within an hour announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousands only) should be deposited with the show secretary. OC along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld. The class has commenced once the draw of lots has been held.

12. **Medical Cover**-OC will provide medical cover for riders at the venue. OC will not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences hospital where necessary, through every possible means available. Each rider participating in the All India open Endurance Qualifier 40 & 60 km will fill the indemnity Bond attached at Appendix and submit the same along with entry form.

13. **Insurance** – The Organizer recommends that units/clubs/associations/schools to take Insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Jaipur during the events. The Organizer will not assume responsibility for any accident or illness due to fail of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.

14. **Responsibility** – The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury any animal of any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Organizer nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any aid or other medical treatment provided.

15. **Eligibility of Rider** – Please ref latest relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

16. **Restriction on Horse** - Please ref latest relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

17. **Saddlery and Equipment** – Please ref latest relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

18. **Technical conduct** :- Please ref latest relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

19. **Accommodation** – All Participants are required to make arrangement for their accommodation. In Case any assistance is required you may contact organizing committee, Ref: kahan Patel.
20. **Inspection Decorum** :- Please ref latest relevant rules of EFI/FEI.
21. **Abuse/cruelty to horses** – Please ref latest relevant rules of EFI/FEI.
22. **Camp**- The OC has permitted stabling of horses for all participants in all the grades of event to be held on 22nd dec -2019 for the duration of the event. No civilian employee of any contingent will be allowed to enter will be Camp area without civil police verification. Camp will open on 19 Dec 2019.
23. The Camp incharge will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp incharge on arrival & handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the contingent. The teams should come self contained in all respects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals. All teams will intimate the total strength of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 15 Dec 2019 and intimate Extended Time of Arrival well in advance to org Administrative Arrangements.
24. **Self – Containment** – All teams coming to participate in the above mentioned event will have facilities of accommodation, food and horse stabling on chargeable basis. Kindly reach to organizing committee Mr. Kahan Patel for further information.
25. **Ration/Fodder**- Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/ fodder to sustain their horses during their Stay. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations.
26. **Coggin and Glander Test** – All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount veterinary Directorate, army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander Status (CFT) certificate. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 14 days arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.
27. **Trotting Parade** – All participants are requested to present their horses for veterinary inspection (Trotting parade) at 1000 Hrs 21st dec 2019.
28. **Ground jury, Veterinary / technical delegate, Appeal Committee and insurance**- These are as per Equestrian Federation of India under governing competitions.
29. **Spectators** – The Spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the judges. The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help. Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena. The Judges decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the judges.

30. **Prize Distribution** – Tentatively prizes will be distributed after each event on the same day.
31. **Fire Fighting Arrangement** – All contingents are requested to carry adequate fire fighting equipment.
32. **Veterinary Commission** – The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
33. **Veterinary Assistance** – the following is available for vet assistance in case of an emergency.

34. **Clearance Certificate** – All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Show office at Araavli trails the event location base camp site, during working hours. All accounts concerned needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless they obtain the clearance certificate.

- HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY:** I understand that horseback riding is a hazardous activity and that horses are unpredictable by nature; that when frightened or angry or under stress, a horse's natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger at a trot, canter, or gallop, to kick, to buck, to rear up in front, or to bite; that horses may trip, stumble, and/or fall down while being led, ridden, or otherwise attended to; that horses may step on feet or other body parts; that the behaviour of horses may be affected by weather, terrain, other animals, and the presence of people; that horses are extremely powerful; and that if a rider falls to the ground, the fall distance will generally be more than 5 feet. I understand that these risks and voluntarily assume these risks and dangers for myself or on behalf of my participating rider, child or legal ward.

- ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP:** I understand that travel may be delayed, postponed, interrupted or affected by accident, that horses may be injured in travel, that horses may be certified not fit to compete, show schedules may change, events may be cancelled by show organizers, AIMHS-GUJRAT CHAPTER may take a decision in the interest of the horse, my safety, my psyche's safety, my child or legal ward's safety, or interest of the team, which may result in I or my team members being unable to compete. I understand that it is not guaranteed that I or my team will win a medal or place in the event. All expenses towards endurance championship will be contributed by participating members. I also take full responsibility for the actions of all those associated with my stable including my horses. All losses or issues created by the team or horses are solely my personal responsibility and I am legally and financially liable for the same.
