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1. The Equestrian Federation of Assam will be conducting the Regional Equestrian League and the Dibrugarh Horse Show at Dibrugarh on the 28th, 29th, and 30th of April 2019. Following events will be conducted under EFI rules with certain deviations to suit local conditions.

EVENTS FOR THE COMPETITION

- (a) **Dressage Children-II (Over 10 and Under 12 Years of age)**
 - (b) **Dressage Children- I (Over 12 and under 14 Years of age)**
 - (c) **Dressage Juniors. (Over 14 and under 18 years of age)**
 - (d) Dressage Open. (Open to all riders over 16 years of age).
 - (e) Hacks Children II.
 - (f) Hacks Children -I.
 - (g) Hacks Open.
 - (h) **Show Jumping Children-II**
 - (j) **Show Jumping Children-I**
 - (k) **Show Jumping Juniors.**
 - (l) Show Jumping Open.
 - (m) Show Jumping Open Top Score.
 - (n) Tent Pegging Open Individual. Open to Riders over 16 years of age.
 - (o) Farriery Competition (To assess the proficiency of farriers in day to day shoeing of horses for normal work)
 - (p) Gymkhana Events (As per availability of time and Circumstances).

2. **Entry Fee.** Entry fee of Rs 500/- (per entry) will be charged for each event. Entry fee is to paid by the riders or their units/club by Bank Draft in the name of “**EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION OF ASSAM**” on any Nationalised Bank payable at DIBRUGARH or in cash along with Entry Form to the JOINT SECRETARY, EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION OF ASSAM, 'JALAN HOUSE', JALANNAGAR, DIBRUGARH- 786 005 (ASSAM). **Please note, no out station cheques will be accepted towards entry fees. Further, entry fees must be paid along with the entry form except in the case of post entry.**

3. **Entry Form.** All entries must be sent in prescribed form. Entries sent otherwise, will not be entertained. A specimen form is attached as **Appendix “A”**.

4. **INDEMNITY BONDS.** All entries in respect of Children & Junior Riders must be accompanied with Indemnity Bond in respect of the participants duly authenticated by Parents and / Head of the Institution.

5. Due to shortage of horses in the region, one horse may be ridden by two riders / one rider may compete in one event on two horses. However one horse will not be allowed to compete in more than four jumping rounds on one day.

6. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI.**

- (a) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in the REL have to be in possession of EFI passport.
- (b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.
- (c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

7. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI.**

- (a) As per EFI rulings ALL Riders (18 Years & above) participating in the REL Events have to be registered with the EFI. The rider can obtain their EFI ID number through mail after paying registration fee Rs 500/- per Rider.
- (b) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number for REL events.

8. **CLOSING OF ENTRIES.** The last date of receipt of entries for the above Championship is 20th April 2019. Entries received after that will be treated as post entries. Entry fee for the post entries will be double the amount of normal entry. No entries will be accepted after the commencement of Veterinary Inspection.

9. **DRAW.** A draw for the starting order of all events will be held at the time to be notified on the Camp Notice Board a day prior to the event. All Team Captains/riders are requested to be present for the draw. In case of their absence, Member of Ground Jury will draw on their behalf. No changes will be entertained thereafter.

10. **FLAGS.** All teams will bring their Federation/ Club / Institution flags for display in the show ground. Size of flags- 6'x4'.

11. **CAMP.** Limited accommodation for horses and Riders participating in the above Championships will be made available in the Camp, which will be located close to the site of competition. The camp will start functioning from the 26th of April 2019 and will close on the 1st of May 2019. Participating teams (Contingents) will ensure that they do not arrive at the Camp before the stipulated date. The Camp Manager will earmark site for each team. The In-charge of respective Contingents will, on arrival, take over the site allotted to them from the Camp Manager and will hand over the same before their departure in good condition. Any damage to Camp property/ accommodation will be made good by the defaulting Contingents. However all Contingents will come self contained for their messing (Cooking food for personnel and horses as deemed necessary) and animal rations for the duration of their stay at Dibrugarh.

However, participants in the Regional Equestrian League are advised to make their own arrangements for their stay at Dibrugarh during the period of the Competitions.

13. **TRANSPORT.** Local transportation will be provided by the Organizing Committee on as required basis only to meet emergency requirements.

14. **CANCELLATION.** The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel an event, which has insufficient entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case entry fees will be refunded.

15. **PRACTICE AND EXERCISING AREA.** Suitable area will be earmarked in the camp for exercise and practice of rides and riders participating in the above competition.

16. **ACCOMMODATION AND MESSING.**

- (a) The horses and the riders participating in the above championship will be accommodated in the camp established for the above championship. Temporary camp/stables complete with water and electricity will be provided. However, the contingents will COME SELF CONTAINED FOR ACCOMODATION (TENTAGE) AND MESSING.
- (b) All contingents are advised to make their own cooking arrangements for food. Contingents will carry sufficient rations for men and animals for the duration of stay at Dibrugarh.
- (c) All Contingent I/Cs should contact the Camp Manager on arrival for their living and messing arrangements. Prior information on their requirements and date of arrival is to be communicated to the Joint Secretary. The Officers must clear their bills prior to departure. Participants are requested not to bring their families. **In case any participant brings family, he/she will have to make his/her own arrangements.**
- (d) For Army contingents, local Supply Depot will cater for fresh items and the units should bring the necessary LRC and Movement Orders. They should get requisite station orders published well in time under their own arrangements.

17. **SHOW NUMBERS.** Each entry (horse) will carry pair of show numbers allotted by EFI. This number will be the same for every class in which the horse participates. The number will be displayed on the exercising head collar/bridle of the horse when it is in the ring / in training area.

18. **ROSETTES.**

- (a) First prize will be denoted by a RED Rosette.
- (b) Second prize will be denoted by a BLUE Rosette.
- (c) Third prize will be denoted by a YELLOW Rosette.
- (d) Highly commanded will be denoted by a WHITE Rosette.

19. **REPORTING FOR THE EVENT.** All participants will report to the collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of commencement of an Event. Any participant not reporting at the scheduled time will be disqualified, unless he has good reasons for the delay, subject to the approval of the President of the Ground Jury.

20. **RATIONS FOR ANIMALS.** Contingents will arrange for animal rations and fodder themselves. Army teams are advised to project their requirement to appropriate authorities well in advance.
21. **LINE GEAR FOR ANIMALS.** Participants will bring adequate line gear, picketing gear with them. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under the own arrangements of the contingents.
22. **FAMILIES.** No family will be accommodated in the Camp.
23. **FARRIERS.** Contingents should bring their own farriers and horse shoes. THE CONTINGENTS SHOULD BRING REQUISITE FARRIERY TOOLS, IF THEIR FARRIERS INTEND TO PARTICIPATE IN FARRIERY COMPETITIONS.
24. **FIRE PRECAUTIONS/SECURITY.** The Officer-in-Charge of contingents will be responsible for fire precautions of their respective areas. Security of animals will be the responsibility of the respective contingent. The Camp Manager will oversee fire safety measures and make sufficient arrangements for the complete Camp.
25. **SANITATION AND HYGIENE.** Proper sanitation and hygiene measures, including disposal of litter will be ensured by all contingent I/Cs. All necessary anti-snake and anti-malaria precautions will be taken by all concerned.
26. **VETERINARY COVER / MEDICAL COVER.** All participating teams will make their own arrangements for Vet cover. For medical emergencies, team I/C may contact Sect Gen/ Jt Sect EFA. A Veterinary officer and Medical officer with ambulance will be present at the show venue. In case of need, the Camp Manager / the Officer-in-Charge at Announcer's Box at the show ground can be approached for help.
27. **DISCIPLINE.** All participants staying in the camp will be under OIC Camp/ Camp Manager for the purpose of discipline. However, the Contingent-in-charge will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained by their contingents.
28. **SECURITY.** All Officers-in-charge of contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingents during stay in the camp. They will not entertain or contact any unauthorized person during their stay in the camp.
29. **LOSSES / INSURANCE.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals, participants or any property of exhibitors through accident or any other cause. Government / Civil horses should be covered by insurance policies etc as deemed fit / necessary.

30. **VETERINARY REQUIREMENT.** All horses arriving at Dibrugarh (Assam) for the competition will be in possession of valid **COGGIN'S TEST CERTIFICATE**, certifying a negative status of EIA and also will be in possession of Glanders (Equine contagious/communicable disease) Negative certificate.

31. **OBJECTION.** Objections can be lodged by the competitors/Team Captains in respect of those events in which they are participating within an hour before the event or within half an hour in respect of result (on announcement of the results). A fee of Rs 2500.00 in CASH will accompany the written objection/appeal to the Ground Jury. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld or else will forfeit objection fee, if the same is over ruled. The decision of the Ground Jury/Appeal Committee will be final in all cases.

32. **QUESTIONS NOT PROVIDED FOR.** Should any question, that has not been provided for in the Prospectus arise, the same must be referred to the Secretary General of EFA in writing. The decision of the Secretary General shall be final.

33. **JUDGING.** The decision of the Ground Jury (Judges) shall be final. All judging will be under latest / amended, EFI/FEI Rules.

34. **DISQUALIFICATION.** The judges are empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling or any such reason which they feel justified including unfit to compete at the level in which he/she is participating.

35. **DRESS.** Protective headgear, of equestrian standard adequately secured, is compulsory in all competitions.
