ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **GENERAL.** Junior National Equestrian Championship - 2019 (JNEC) and NEC Preliminary Jumping is being organized under the aegis of Equestrian Federation of India between 20th to 29th December 2019 at the Embassy International Riding School, Bangalore.

2. **CATEGORIES**

- (a) **NEC Events** - Preliminary Jumping

3. **PROGRAMME.** Schedule of Events - Attached at **Appendix 'A'**.

4. **Eligibility of Riders for JNEC Events.**

- (a) Young Rider - 16 to 21 Years (born between 01 Jan 1998 to 31 Dec 2003)
- (b) Junior - 14 to 18 Years (born between 01 Jan 2001 to 31 Dec 2005)
- (c) Children – I - 12 to 14 Years (born between 01 Jan 2005 to 31 Dec 2007)
- (d) Children – II - 10 to 12 Years (born between 01 Jan 2007 to 31 Dec 2009)

Note :- Age on 1st Jan of the Calendar Year will be considered valid upto 31st Dec. It will be compulsory to submit the birth certificate and EFI Registration Number of Rider & Horse alongwith the entry form.

5. **ENTRIES**

(a) All entries must be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix 'B'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered.

(b) **Entry Fee.**

- (i) Individual Events : Rs 500/- (Per Entry/Competition)
- (ii) Team Events : Rs 1000/- (Per Team/Competition)

Post Entry.

- (i) Individual Events : Rs 1,000/- (Per Entry/Competition)
- (ii) Team Events : Rs 2,000/- (Per Team/Competition)

(c) **Closing Date for Entries.** Entries will close by 16th December 2019 by 1800h. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES**. No entry will be accepted without an entry fee.

(d) **Entries Instructions.** For Junior, Children – I & Children – II, only the riders/athletes who qualified through REL will be allowed to enter/participate in the Dressage and Show Jumping (Normal) competition. For Jumping Accumulator or Top Score or Knock Out or Fault & Out, REL qualification is not required.

(e) Foreign Nationals cannot participate in the JNEC.

(d) **Payment.** All entries must be paid in cash or by local cheque in favour of "**Embassy International Riding School**" or by Bank transfer to the below account:-

6. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI**

- (a) As per EFI rulings all horses participating in JNEC/NEC must be in possession of the new EFI passport.
- (b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before giving entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.
- (c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

7. **PARTICIPATION OF HORSES IN EQUESTRIAN EVENTS.** A horse should not be allowed to participate in more than three rounds of events in a day. Maximum participation of a horse in a day will be as under:-

(a) **Children Category**

- (i) Two normal Jumping rounds and one side event

OR

- (ii) Two Dressage competition and a side event of Jumping

OR

- (iii) Two rounds of Jumping normal and one Dressage competition

(b) **Junior/Young/Senior Category**

- (i) Not more than two rounds of events (Dressage or Show Jumping).

8. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI.** As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI. Entries will not be accepted without valid /RENEWED/ACTIVE EFI registration Number.

9. **WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTIONS OF ENTRY.**

- (a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- (b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

10. **SHOW NUMBER.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.
11. **ROSETTES.** No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.
12. **ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised. Refer to Article 243 FEI Rules for Jumping Events 2019.
13. **WHIPS/SPURS.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
14. **DRESS CODE.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. **Service personnel maybe in uniform.** It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard helmet with three point retention harness.
15. **RULES.** Technical Guidelines of the Equestrian Federation of India and the rules of Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) will be followed for the conduct of the events of the competition.
16. **JUDGING.** The decision of the judges will be final.
17. **APPEAL.** Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) should be deposited with the Show Secretary, Embassy International Riding School along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
18. **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.** EIRS will provide medical assistance for riders at the venue. EIRS shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor/ staff/ visitor or any other person on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving the club of any responsibility in this regard. EIRS will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary.
19. **INSURANCE.** The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.
20. **RESPONSIBILITY.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.
21. **CAMP: CAMPING AND ACCOMODATION**
 - (a) The camp will open on 14^h December 2019 and the camp will close on 31st December 2019.

- (b) All teams should preferably come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show. A fee of Rs.1500 + taxes will be charged per stable which is set up on EIRS grounds.
- (c) The Organisers will try to arrange for Bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- (d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements before the 25th of November 2019, after which no stable orders can be accepted (att as **Appendix C**).
- (e) The cost of one temporary stable provided by EIRS is Rs. 4500 + taxes for the duration of the show. (Tarpaulin for the sides must be arranged at your end).
- (f) All teams must inform the organisers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 25th November 2019, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams.
- (g) All teams must inform the organisers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.
- (h) Any teams requiring a horse float and/or a vehicle to transport luggage from the Bangalore Railway Station to Embassy must inform the Organisers by 25th November 2019, to facilitate reservation of floats.
- (j) The cost of transporting six horses from the railway station to Embassy via horse float is Rs. 8000/- + taxes.
- (k) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.
- (l) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbins provided. Please minimize your use of plastic materials.
- (m) No open fires are permitted on EIRS grounds.
- (n) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited

21. **COGGIN'S AND GLANDERS TESTS.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT for Glanders) certificate on arrival in Bangalore. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

22. **VETERINARY COMMISSION.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

23. **ANTI DOPING.** The organiser will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders/Athletes who need to use a prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition, a **Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate** (TUEC) will be obtained from the Doctor prior to taking any medicine.

24. **DRAW OF LOTS / STARTING ORDER.** The draw of lots will normally be held on the day before the day of the event. However, the organiser may change the draw of lots to any other time, after making necessary announcement for the same.

25. **QUESTIONS NOT COVERED FOR.** In the eventuality of any questions arising that has not been covered in this prospectus, the matter will be referred to the Technical Delegate of the Championship and his decision will be final.
