PART – I

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

General

1. The Delhi Horse Show-2019 will be conducted from 29 Mar to 07 Apr 2019 and confined events according to the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) at the Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt.

2. Schedule of Events (DHS). Refer Appx'A'

3. Tentative Programme. Refer Appx'B'

4. Entries.

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as attached at **Appx 'C'** and should be completed in all respects. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any wrong entry. **ALL ENTRIES FOR YOUNG RIDERS, JUNIOR RIDERS AND CHILDREN RIDERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY BIRTH CERTIFICATES.**

(b) Entry Fee.

- (i) Individual Events : Rs. 500/- +18% GST per exhibit per competition
- (ii) Team Events : Rs. 1,000/- +18% GST per team per competition

(c) Introduction of Team Events. Team events will be held for Dressage and Jumping competitions. Please forward your team entries accordingly. Minimum 04 teams should be entered to hold the team events.

(d) Closing Date for Entries. Entries in respect of Delhi Horse Show will close by **20 Mar 2019**. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES or as per Show Secretary's decision.

(e) Post Entries. Post entries will be accepted twenty four hours before the event. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT. Post entry fee will be :-

- (i) Individual Events : Rs. 1,000/- +18% GST per exhibit per competition.
- (ii) Team Events : Rs. 2,000/- +18% GST per team per competition.

(f) Description and Registration of Horses. All entries must give the description, registration No, grading and name of the horse concerned. The name of the rider will be given for all mounted classes.

(g) Payment. All entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer or by local cheque in favour of Army Polo & Riding Centre. Bank details for electronic payment are as under :

5. EFI Horses Passport.

(a) As per EFI rules all horses participating in the Delhi Horse Show-2019 events which are recognized by the EFI in their technical guidelines ie, Dressage, Show Jumping and Tent Pegging have to be in possession of EFI passport. No entries will be accepted without EFI passport of

horses and EFI registration. The Team Captains to be in possession of EFI Passports of horses during event.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are registered before entries for the Delhi Horse Show-2019. The registration No has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

6. **EFI Rider Registration.**

(a) ALL THE RIDERS PARTICIPATING IN THE EFI RECOGNIZED EVENTS SHOULD POSSESS EFI ID NO.

(b) RIDERS NOT HAVING VALID/RENEWED/ACTIVE EFI RIDER ID NUMBER OR PUTTING WRONG ID NO WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN DHS/ EFI RECOGNIZED EVENTS.

7. **Grading of Horses.** It will be the responsibility of the riders/clubs/units to ensure that their horses are entered in the correct grade as per the latest updated list. Entry of the horse in the wrong grade will entail elimination from that event and disqualification from the entire horse show. If it is the last event that the horse is taking part in, then a fine of Rs. 1,000/- will be deposited by concerned rider with the Secretary APRC before the horse leaves the camp, which will be forwarded to the EFI. Failure to deposit fee may entail disqualification from next event whenever wherever scheduled.

8. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as **Post Entries**. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

(d) **Technical specifications of events.** The events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of EFI as per the relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions and local merits/demerits in consultation with EFI.

9. **Cancellation.** The Organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved, those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

10. **Reporting for Each Class.** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. The first three riders in dressage and first five riders in jumping must report to the arena stewards atleast 15 minutes before the scheduled start that event. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action. This is also applicable for Gymkhana events and Show Classes too.

11. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration No on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle. Riders in Gymkhana events will wear Chest No.

12. All events scheduled in the afternoons will continue under lights, when required.

3 **Abuse/Cruelty to horses.** Refer to Article 13 of EFI Technical Guidelines and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

14. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

15. **Elimination/Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized. Refer to Article 243 FEI Rules for Jumping Events.
16. **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
17. **Dress Code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.
18. **Appeal.** Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 3000/- +18% GST should be deposited with the Secretary APRC along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
19. DHS certificates will be given only upto 3rd place and medals will be given upto 6th places.
- Note** – The Show office will close at 2000 hrs every day. No entries will be entertained after 2000 hrs.

21. **Medical Cover.** The Organizing Committee will provide medical cover for riders at the venue. The Organizing Committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. The Organizing Committee will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented. Each riders participating in the Delhi Horse Show-2019 will please fill the Indemnity Bond attached at **Appendix 'D'** and submit the same alongwith entry form.
22. **Insurance.** The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.
23. **Responsibility.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.
24. **Foreign Nationals.** Managers/coaches of all Teams/Clubs who are arranging for foreign riders for taking part in the Delhi Horse Show-2019 are required to forward the details of the foreign riders and companions if any as per format enclosed as **Appendix 'E'** along with photocopy of their passport and visa, 15 days prior to start of the Show to e-mail ID –aprcdelhi@gmail.com, so as to obtain MI Clearance from the concerned authorities. Foreign riders whose MI Clearance is delayed for want of submission of details by the Team manager/coaches will **NOT** be allowed to enter in the Army Equestrian Centre/Army Area.

25. **Clearance Certificate.** All riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the APRC office during working hours. All outstanding needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same.

27. **Note.** The Organising Committee may at any time alter/amend any of the above conditions, owing to unforeseen circumstances.

28. **Camp.** Camping facilities for out station horses are made available at the Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt for the duration of the Delhi Horse Show-2019. Permission to stable horses during the above period is subject to certain conditions and payment of security deposit as laid down in **Appendix 'F'** to this Prospectus. Security aspects as mentioned in Paragraphs 6 to 8 of Annexure II to Appx 'F' pertaining to civilian employees of all contingents including APRC members entering the Army Equestrian Centre for temporary stabling will be strictly adhered to. No civilian employee of any contingent will be allowed to enter the Army Equestrian Centre without civil police verification. **Contingents/individual who had not cleared their earlier dues will not be allowed to camp their horses at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi.**

29. **Self Containment.** All teams coming to participate in the Delhi Horse Show-2019 must be self-contained, ie, they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping, cooks and transport, etc. Any contingent requiring camping stables at the premises may contact 2IC, Army Equestrian Centre.

30. **Ration/Fodder.** Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/fodder to sustain their horses during their stay in Delhi or, they can ask for attachment with the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations. However, animal rations and hay can be procured on cash payment.

31. **Arboriculture.** No Det/Camp will spoil or cut the environment. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced. **No warning will be issued.**

32. **Coggins and Glanders Test.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT) certificate on arrival as per directions given at Para 5(a) of **Appendix 'F'** to this Prospectus. A coggins and glanders negative certificate with a minimum of 14 days validity on arrival and exit of horses is mandatory.

(n) In Dressage, no whips are permitted according to the EFI ruling. Short whips are allowed in Children Group-III.

Dress Code.

(a) White breeches, white shirt, tie, white gloves, dark riding jacket, hard hat, Black/Brown riding boots of leather. Spurs are mandatory for young riders.

(b) The whip must be dropped before entering the space around the competition arena. If this is not complied with the rider will incur a penalty of 2 points from each judge except for Group-III.

8. **Reporting for each Class.**

- (a) All riders must report to the collecting ring steward half an hour before the event for Hacks/Gymkhana races.
- (b) The first three riders in dressage and first five riders in jumping must report to the arena stewards atleast 15 minutes before the scheduled start that event.
- (c) The arena steward has full authority to take appropriate action as per existing rules if competitors are late.

9. For Group III Gymkhana events the Riders will be permitted to be held by a Syce. However they must be able to ride alone for the hacks, dressage and jumping.

10. SPECTATORS ARE REQUESTED NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE JUDGES. THE ARENA STEWARD HAS THE RIGHT TO ELIMINATE ANY PARTICIPANT WHO HAS OUTSIDE HELP. ONCE THE EVENT HAS COMMENCED ALL SPECTATORS AND HELPERS ARE REQUESTED TO CLEAR THE ARENA. IN THE CHILDREN GROUP III RACES, SYCES ARE PERMITTED TO HOLD THE HORSE. IN THE GROUP I & GROUP II RACES CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED ANY ASSISTANCE WHATSOEVER. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL. PARENTS MUST NOT ENTER THE ARENA OR DISPUTE THE JUDGES DECISION. PARENTS AND COACHES ARE REQUESTED TO STAY WELL CLEAR OF THE ARENA. IT IS DANGEROUS FOR THE CHILDREN AND HORSES OTHERWISE. SAFETY COMES FIRST. WE REQUEST TEAM CAPTAINS/COACHES TO READ THE PROSPECTUS FULLY AND NOT JUST THE PROGRAMME.

11. Competitors are required to be correctly dressed for all the events. Civilians should wear a Blazer and Tie. Competitors improperly dressed can be disqualified. Hard hats must be worn with three point contact. In gymkhana events a white shirt is permitted

12. APRC members are requested to submit their entries by the given date. A draw will be held for allotment of APRC horses before the Show for entries received.

13. Competitors are responsible for entering correct grades or categories. The EFI has made a new list of grade for Dressage and Show Jumping horses. The Organising Committee will NOT be held responsible for incorrect entries.
