ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **General.** 2nd AEF U-21 Dressage Championship 2019 Qualifiers is being organized under the aegis of Equestrian Federation of India on 26th December 2019 at the Embassy International Riding School, Bangalore.
2. **Programme.** Schedule of Events - Attached at **Appendix 'A'**.
3. **Eligibility :-**
 - (a) **Riders:** The Championship is open to age riders no more than 21 years old (athletes born after 1998) in the year his/her qualifier starts. In the Championship, "Athletes Living outside their country of nationality" (as defined in the FEI General Regulations) **cannot** compete for their country of residence.
 - (b) **Horses :** The qualifier is open to all horses of any origin provided they have successfully passed the Veterinary Inspection. Horses may compete if they are a minimum of 5 years of age.
4. **Rules:** AEF U21 Dressage Championship rules are attached as **Appendix B**.
5. **Entries:** All entries must be on a proper Entry Form as given at **Appendix 'C'** and should be completed in all respects. Entries not on the prescribed entry form and without entry fee will not be considered.
 - (a) Individual Events: Rs.500/- per entry
 - (b) Entries will close by 1800Hrs on 18 Dec 2019.
 - (c) Please provide copies to confirm the Riders Indian Nationality
6. **Payment:** All entries must be paid in cash, cheque or by NEFT transfer along with completed entry form:-

7. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS/ HORSES WITH EFI.** As per EFI rulings all Riders/Horses participating in the EFI Calendar Events have to be registered with the EFI. Entries will not be accepted without valid EFI registration Number.

8. **WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTIONS OF ENTRY.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

9. **SHOW NUMBER.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

10. **ROSETTES.** No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

11. **ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals.

12. **JUDGING.** The decision of the judges will be final.

13. **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.** EIRS will provide medical assistance for riders at the venue. EIRS shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor/ staff/ visitor or any other person on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving the club of any responsibility in this regard. EIRS will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary.

14. **INSURANCE.** The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.

15. **RESPONSIBILITY.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

16. **CAMP: CAMPING AND ACCOMODATION**

- (a) The camp will open on 14^h December 2019 and the camp will close on 31st December 2019.
- (b) All participants should preferably come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show. A fee of Rs.1500 + taxes will be charged per stable which is set up on EIRS grounds.
- (c) The Organisers will try to arrange for Bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- (d) All participants that require stables must send their requirements before the 30th of November 2019, after which no stable orders can be accepted (att as **Appendix D**).
- (e) The cost of one temporary stable provided by EIRS is Rs. 4500 + taxes for the duration of the show. (Tarpaulin for the sides must be arranged at your end).
- (f) All participants must inform the organisers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.
- (g) Any participants requiring a horse float and/or a vehicle to transport luggage from the Bangalore Railway Station to Embassy must inform the Organisers by 30th November 2019, to facilitate reservation of floats.
- (h) The cost of transporting six horses from the railway station to Embassy via horse float is Rs. 8000/- + taxes.
- (j) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.
- (k) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbins provided. Please minimize your use of plastic materials.
- (l) No open fires are permitted on EIRS grounds.
- (m) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited

17. **COGGIN'S AND GLANDERS TESTS.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT for Glanders) certificate on arrival in Bangalore. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

18. **VETERINARY COMMISSION.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

19. **ANTI DOPING.** The organiser will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders/Athletes who need to use a prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition, a **Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate** (TUEC) will be obtained from the Doctor prior to taking any medicine.

20. **DRAW OF LOTS / STARTING ORDER.** The draw of lots will be held on the day before the day of the event. However, the organiser may change the draw of lots to any other time, after making necessary announcement for the same.
