

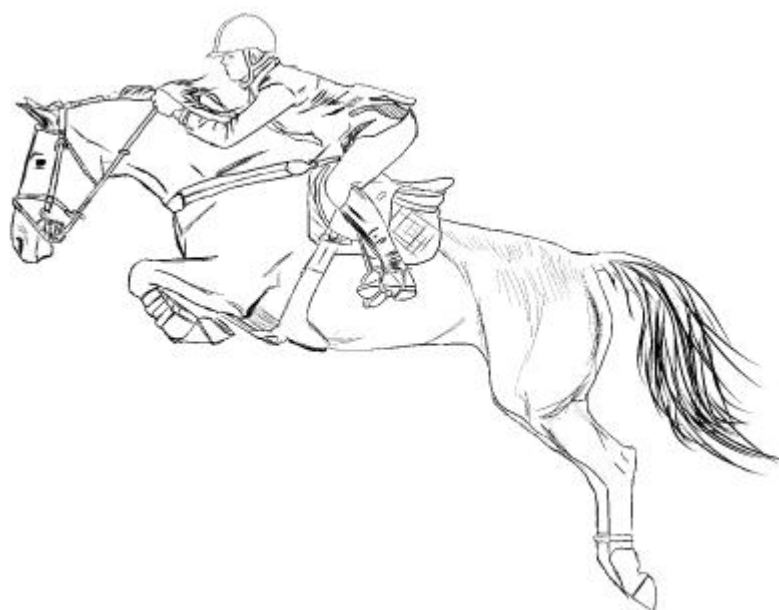

IPSC EQUESTRIAN 2018-19 & REL

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The IPSC Equestrian Championship 2018-19 & REL will be conducted from 12 Apr to 15 Apr 2019 according to the rules of the [Indian Public Schools' Conference](#) (IPSC).

2. **Age Category.** Age categories are as follow:-

S No	Category	Remarks
(a)	Children III (U-10)	IPSC
(b)	Children II (U-12)	IPSC & REL
(c)	Children I (U-14)	IPSC & REL
(d)	Junior (Above 14 years)	IPSC & REL

3. **Entries.**

(a) Entries should be submitted on the prescribed form given at **Appx 'A'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered. All entries must be accompanied with the eligibility form.

(b) **Entry Fee.** Entry fee must be paid in the form of a demand draft in favour of the **Director, Mayo College, Ajmer**. For **IPSC**, Entry fee is Rs. 1000/- for each category. For **REL**, Entry fee is Rs. 500/- for each entry.

(c) **Closing Date for Entries.** Entries of IPSC event will close on 15 Mar 2019. Entries of REL event will close on 09 Apr 2019 at 1800 Hrs.

(d) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give the description, registration number, grading and name of the concerned horse. One horse cannot be registered for two different riders in same event and category.

4. **Introduction of Team Events.** In IPSC, team events will be held for Show Jumping Normal, Dressage in minimum 3 riders & maximum 4 riders, Tent Pegging competitions in 4 riders are compulsory per team will participate.

5. **EFI Horses Passport.** As per EFI rules.

6. **Grading of Horses.** As per EFI Rules.

7. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry Fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the category.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in an event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once the event starts being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

8. **Cancellation.** The Organising Committee may cancel any event which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In such case, the entry fee will be refunded.
9. **Eliminations.** Eliminations will be held for all show jumping and tent pegging events. However, depending on the number of entries received, the Organising Committee may decide against this for any particular event.
10. **Reporting for Each Event.** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the Events. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows valid cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has absolute authority to take appropriate disciplinary action. This is for Gymkhana events and Show Jumpers too.
11. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration No on the bridle during the competition, veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.
12. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.
13. **Elimination / Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised.
14. **Dressage Competition.** The sequence of Dressage event is given at **Appx 'B'**.
15. **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI rules per subject.
16. **Dress Code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. Riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly colored plain shirt, white tie and Jacket or School uniform must be worn. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform..
17. **Appeal.** Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of `2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) should be deposited with the **Organising Secretary, Mayo College** along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
18. **First Aid.** Mayo College will provide First Aid for riders at the venue. The School shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. Mayo College will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be made available. Each riders participating in the IPSC will please fill the Indemnity Bond attached at **Appx C** and submit the same along with the entry form.
19. **Responsibility.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor shall be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.
20. **Camp.** Mayo College will provide space for stabling of mounts. All participating teams must therefore, be self-contained in term of tentage and other equipment needed for camping.
21. **Age Categories** - Age categories and eligibility of Riders are as follows –

(a) Junior Rider	Above 14 Years	Born on 31 st Dec 2004 and before
(b) Children Group I	12 to 14 Years	Born between 1 st Jan 2005 to 31 st Dec 2006
(c) Children Group II	10 to 12 Years	Born between 1 st Jan 2007 to 31 st Dec 2008
(d) Children Group III	Below 10 Years	Born on 1 st Jan 2009 and after

25. **Show Jumping** -

STANDARD FOR SHOW JUMPING COMPETITIONS (Minimum 50% of the jumps will be of full height and spread to include three vertical and three parallel jumps.)

26. **TENT PEGGING** –

RULES OF (LANCE) TENT PEGGING INDIVIDUAL :-

- Speed** :- 750 M / min.
- Number of Rounds** :- Two.
- Number of Runs** :- Three. The first round is 2 runs on 6 cm pegs and 3rd run on 4 cm pegs. In second round the first run is on 6 cm pegs and in 2nd & 3rd run on a 4 cm pegs.
- Placing** :- Highest scorer in both rounds is placed first and the next best scorer will be placed next and so on.
- Length of Course** :- 100 Meters (start to finish line).
- Carry Distance** :- 10 Meters for Card Board pegs.
- First peg** :- 70 Meters from start line.

27. **TENT PEGGING (LANCE) TEAM**

This is a team competition starting with 4 riders per team :-

- Speed** :- 800 M / min.
- Number of Rounds** :- Two.
- Number of Runs** :- First round is 2 runs on 6 cm pegs and 3rd run on 4 cm pegs. In second round the first run is on 6 cm pegs and in 2nd & 3rd run on a 4 cm pegs.
- Placing** :- Points scored by all four riders will count.
- Length of Course** :- 100 Meters (Start to finish line).
- Carry Distance** :- 15 meters for wooden pegs and 10 meters for Card Board pegs.
- First peg** :- 70 Meters from start line.

28. **Specifications of Equipment :-** The lance shall not be shorter than **2.5 meters (8 feet 2 inch) and shall not be exceed 2.75 meters (9 feet)** with a smooth metal point without serration or sharp edges. Grips are permitted. Lances can be of any material.

29. **Pegs (Card Board) :-**

Card Board pegs can be used and should be made of 2 layers of corrugated card board glued together with total thickness of 2.5 cm with corrugations running vertically, sizes will be as specified for wooden pegs.

Any other synthetic peg of same dimensions can be used provided above specifications hold good.

The pegs are driven into the ground at angle of 60degree from horizontal with exactly 17cm of the pegs showing above the ground level. The face of the peg must be painted white or sprinkled with pure chalk/lime.

30. **Award of Points :-**

Pegs:-

(i) **Carry:** - 6 points peg carried/fall beyond 10 meters (in case of cardboard pegs) and 15 meters (in case of wooden pegs) measured from the point of which the peg was placed. In single file same principle hold good.

(ii) **Draw:** - 4 points. Peg removed from the ground, but not carried full distance as stipulated above.

(iii) **Strike:** - 2 points. Peg struck on face but not removed from its position in the ground.

Miscellaneous.

(a) Please get the Coggins and Glanders tests in respects of the mounts participating in the event. The test reports for all mounts participating are required to be '**Negative**'. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory. Test reports are also required and the same may be kindly be forwarded to us.

(b) **Glanders and EIA (coggins) negative certificate:** Glanders validity 30 days and EIA (Coggins) validity 120 days. Recognized Labs are : NRCE Hissar, DRL Pune Race Course and Central Military Veterinary Laboratory, Meerut.

(c) **Animal Ration and School Flag.** All teams must bring their own animal ration and two school flags.

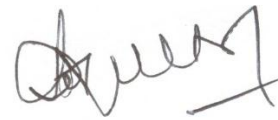
33. **Participation Confirmation.** Participation confirmation must reach the Organizing Secretary by **10 Mar 2019.**
