REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE AT CHANDIMANDIR
(06th & 07th March 2020)

1. **Introduction:-** The Regional Equestrian League 2019-20 for National Equestrian Championship (NEC) Tent Pegging is being organized on **06th & 07th March 2020** at Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN), Chandimandir Cantonment, Panchkula (Haryana) 134107.
2. **REL Categories:-**
 - (a) Individual tend pegging (Lance).
 - (b) Individual Tent Pegging (Sword).
3. **Schedule of Events:-** As per Appendix 'A'.
4. **Entries:-** All entries will be on a proper Entry forms as provided in Appendix 'B'.
 - (a) Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered.
 - (b) Entry fee will need to be paid for each competition:
 - (i) Individual Entry : Rs 500/-.
 - (ii) Individual Post Entry : Rs 1,000/-.
 - (c) Closing Date for entries : 05th March 2020 at Noon. Post that date will be considered late entry.
 - (d) All entries fees must be paid in cash, Cheque or local demand draft in favour of "Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN)".
 - (e) In case of any objection, original birth certificate/ matriculation certificate will have to be produced before Appeal Committee.
 - (f) A horse cannot be transferred from one event to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event, a horse once entered, in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
 - (g) Riders or Horse can be changed only on medical ground with sufficient Medical Certificate.
 - (h) Once an event has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.
 - (j) In the Tent Pegging Event the minimum age requirement of a rider is 16 yrs.
5. **Registration:-** Horses and Riders must be registered with EFI. Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before submitting Entries for the Events. The registration Numbers has to be recorded in the Entry Form as per EFI rules. Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

6. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry:-**

(a) The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) Additional entry fee will be payable for a change in a Rider or Horse the class to which it is transferred.

7. **EFI Registration:-** All horses must display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and the veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

8. **No Rosettes:-** will be worn by a horse during judging.

9. **Elimination/ Disqualification:-** Judges are empowered to disqualify a competitor at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.

10. **Whips/ Spurs:-** as per relevant EFI rules per discipline.

11. **Dress Code:-** Riders are expected to wear riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly colored plain T-Shirt/ their Uniform.

12. **Appeal:-** Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) should be deposited with the show secretary along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

13. **Medical Cover:-** Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN) will only provide basic medical for facility for riders at the venue. Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN) shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/ team to give a written undertaking absolving to Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN) of any responsibility in this regard. Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN) will only provide first-aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital.

14. **Insurance:-** The Organizing Committee recommends units/ clubs/ associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN) and during the events.

15. **Responsibility:-** The organizing committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team. The Organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provide.

16. **Camping and Accommodation:-**

(a) The camp will be located at Western Command Equestrian Node (WCEN), Chandimandir Cantonment, Panchkula (Haryana). The Camp In-charge will earmark the site for each contingent. The Camp will become operational on 05th March 2020 and will be closed on 08th March 2020.

(b) Horses, riders, grooms/farriers coming to participate in **Regional Equestrian League** will stay in the camping area. No team will be allowed to enter the camping area before 05th March 2020.

(c) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tentage for Stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.

(d) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 05th March, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.

(e) All teams coming to participate in the **Regional Equestrian League must be self-contained**, i.e they should bring their own equipment, tent, feed, fodder, cooks, farriers and transport etc.

(f) Participants are advised to make requisite arrangements as per present weather condition.

(g) The participants are requested to bring their own Hurricane Lanterns/ Petromax Lamps for emergency use. Power / light will be provided under camp arrangements if feasible.

(h) All the participants staying in the camp will be under the camp in-charge for the purpose of discipline.

(j) All the participants are required to undertake fire-fighting precaution in their respective areas.

(k) All participants should observe proper sanitation and hygienic measures. There should be proper disposal of litter at pre designated location.

(l) Medical assistance will be provided at the camp site and competition area.

(m) Veterinary assistance will be available at the Camp site and competition area.

(n) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(o) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be properly disposed off in the compost heap.

(p) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbins provided.

(q) Please minimize your use of plastic materials.

(r) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited.

17. **Cancellation:-** The Organizing committee may cancel any event for any reason entirely at their discretion. In such case, the entry fee will be refunded.

18. **Reporting for Each Class:-** All horses will report to the Arena Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entrant not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Arena Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

19. **Spectators/outside assistance:-** The spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the Judges. The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help. Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena. The Judges' decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or confront the Judges.

20. **Veterinary Inspection:-** All participants for the **Regional Equestrian League** are required to present their horses for veterinary inspection (Trotting Parade) on 06th March 2020 at 03.00 PM. in the competition grounds along with a copy of the Coggins & Mallein Test report and EFI passports of the horses.

21. **Conduct Rules:-**

(a) The events of REL will be conducted & adjudged as per rules of EFI (Equestrian Federation of India).

(b) The events are judged by the panel of judges who are experts in the field of equestrian sports.

(c) The decision of the jury will be final.

22. **Miscellaneous:-**

(a) Should any questions arise not provided for, it must be referred to the organizing committee, whose decisions will be final.

(b) Scheduling time and entries are subject to alteration at the discretion of the organizing committee.

23. **Coggins and Glanders Test:-** All rules to be followed from the EFI on the subject will be strictly adhered to be all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glanders status (CFT or Mallein) certificate before or upon arrival in Chandimandir Cantonment. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.
