REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE

1. The Regional Equestrian League 2020 will be conducted from November 18th to November 19th 2020 and will be conducted as per the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India at GSE stables, Bijwasan, New Delhi.

2. Entry fees and stabling charges for riders participating in Regional Equestrian League 2020 is as under:-

(a). **Entry fees:** : INR 500 plus taxes per event of REL

(b) **Stabling charges:-** It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

ADMINISTRATION

3. **Venue :** All events will be held at The GSE Stables, Near Bark & Walk, Bijwasan, New Delhi. Google maps link: <https://www.google.com/maps/dir/TNT+MOTORCYCLES/>

4. **Camp:** All horses will be stabled at The GSE farm in Bijwasan. Stables will be allotted by the organizing committee to all teams depending on the number of horses per team. All horse handlers are permitted to stay along with the horses in temporary accommodation earmarked for the same. All teams are requested to share the number of horses/ handlers per contingent, which are likely to come latest by **NOVEMBER 17TH 2020** with the show secretary via E-mail.

5. **Self-containment.** In addition to the above all teams must be self contained in terms of tentage, equipment for camping and transport in order to be prepared for any unforeseen emergency.

6. **Ration /Fodder.** All teams should bring their own feed, hay, bedding, grass, etc. for their horses and should make their own provision for staff food. GSE will provide fodder for horses at extra cost.

7. **Coggin's and Glanders Test.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI on this subject will be strictly adhered to by all participating teams. All teams must produce a valid negative EIA and Glanders status certificate on arrival with a validity advised by the governing authorities.

8. **Veterinary commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by Equestrian Federation of India/ GSE Stables for Regional Equestrian League will have the right to examine all the horses participating.

9. **Veterinary Assistance.** Dr. Vikram Malhotra is the official VET for all GSE Stables shows. Mobile - +919871490564. The charges will be borne by the horse owners.

10. **Medical cover.** The organizing committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor on the venue or the consequences thereof. Each rider participating in the Regional Equestrian League will fill the Indemnity Bond attached as and submit the same along with entry form.

11. **Insurance.** The organizing committee recommends units/club/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to GSE Stables and during the conduct of the events. The organizing committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.

12. **Responsibility.** The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves.

13. **Clearance Certificate.** Horse owners are required to obtain clearance certificate from the OC during work hours. All concerned accounts need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses/ Person will be allowed to leave by the Camp In-charge without the clearance certificate.

15. **Note:** The organizing committee may at any time alter/ amend any of the above conditions owing to unforeseen circumstances.

16. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.

A separate set of guidelines will be sent from time to time to ensure safety of all. You are all requested to abide by the same.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

17. **Technical Specifications.** Regional Equestrian League will be conducted as per relevant of Equestrian Federation of India/EFI.

18. **Schedule of Tentative Events for REL.** Refer attached schedule.

19. **Entries**

- (a) All entries will be on proper Entry Form as attached for the Regional Equestrian League and should be completed in all respect. Entries not on the prescribed entry form will not be considered.
- (b) Entry fees must be paid by bank transfer or cash before the submission of the entry forms. Please send all entries to [**ariun.gori19@gmail.com**](mailto:ariun.gori19@gmail.com)
- (c) Entry Fee: INR 500 including taxes per event for REL.
- (d) Closing date for Entries All entries for the Regional Equestrian League will close by **NOVEMBER16TH 2020**. Entries received thereafter will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- (e) Description and Registration of Horses; All entries must give the description, EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number, name and year of birth of the horse concerned.

20. EFI Rider Registration

- (a) All riders participating in the Regional Equestrian League must have a valid EFI Rider Identification Number.
- (b) Riders not having EFI rider ID No. will not be permitted to participate.

21. Horse Registration.

- (a) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in REL have to be in possession of the new EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event.
- (b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.
- (c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

22. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.

- (a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- (b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) **Change of Riders;** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as Fresh Entries. Once an event has started, being judged, no change in rider / horse will be accepted.
- (d) **Technical specification of events.** The events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of FEI and EFI as per relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions and local merits / climate in consultations with EFI.

23. Cancellation or reschedule. The Organizing committee may cancel or reschedule any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, depending on the numbers of entries received, the organizing committee may decide against this for any particular event.

24. Reporting for Each Class. All horses will report to the collecting ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated

unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

25. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

26. **Abuse/ Cruelty to horses.** As per relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

27. **Rosettes:** A horse will wear no rosettes during judging.

28. **Elimination / Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, or any type of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized. Refer to FEI Rules for Jumping Events.

29. **Whips/spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

30. **Dress code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, white or lightly colored plain shirts, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with a three-point retention harness including riders in uniform.

31. **Appeal.** Any competitor can lodge an appeal two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs 2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) should be deposited with the org secretary along with the objection in writing. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

DECLARATION (INDEMNITY BOND)

1. I, _____ resident of _____ desirous to participate in the Regional Equestrian League 2020 at GSE Stables, Bijwasan, New Delhi hereby undertake and agree: -

(a) That horse riding and all equestrian sports are inherently unpredictable and potentially dangerous.

(b) That only some basic provisions for medical treatment are made at the event venue and I am responsible for my safety equipment.

(c) That the Equestrian Centre has various unsupervised areas that may be generally risky.

(d) That in the event of any loss or injury to property or person including injury resulting in death I may suffer while participating, I or any other legal representatives shall not hold the GSE Stables responsible for the same or for any consequence thereof.

2. If any rights exist by operation of law, I hereby waive them and undertake not to initiate any action against the GSE Stables other persons.

3. It is further declared that stamp duty payable on this undertaking shall be borne by me.
