

REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE (REL) GUIDELINES:
SHOW JUMPING, TENT PEGGING AND JNEC

Introduction

1. Unlike other sports, equestrian field does not have Distt / State level championship due to lack of infrastructure, as a result of which many a time naïve horse-rider combinations have participated in National championships thereby diluting the sanctity of the National Level competition. REL concept has been developed to offer more opportunities to riders to participate in various competitions within the region and qualify themselves to compete at National level.

Objective

2. (a) Promote Equestrian sports at Regional Level by empowering Regional Members.
- (b) Promote more civilian organizing committee & civil venues to hold equestrian events.
- (c) Popularize the sports throughout the country.
- (d) Offer more competitions to horse-rider combinations in their own region thereby reducing the burden of transportation cost.
- (e) Select horse rider combination worthy of participation at National level.

Concept

3. To achieve the above objectives, holding of Equestrian competitions at regional level is proposed on the lines of World Challenge Jumping (WCJ) for which the country will be divided into following zones: -

- (a) North Zone (J&K, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana and Union Territories of Chandigarh and Delhi).
 - (b) East Zone (West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand and Orissa).
 - (c) West Zone (Maharashtra, Goa, Gujarat, and Rajasthan).
 - (d) South Zone (Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telengana and Puducherry).
 - (e) Central Zone (UP, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Uttrakhand).
 - (f) North East Zone (Assam, Manipur, Nagaland, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Meghalaya and Mizoram).
4. Respective Zonal Members shall be responsible to organize regional championships.

5. Jury/Officials shall be detailed as given below for each REL to ensure that the desired levels are not diluted:-
- (a) Jury/Official as per EFI National list will be proposed by OC and approved by NF. Atleast, one of the Jury member will not be from the same region.
 - (b) EFI Rep will be detailed by NF. The EFI rep will forward a detailed report on the conduct of REL within 72 hrs of completion of the REL.
6. Course plans for show jumping will be provided by EFI to be followed at all venues so as to have uniformity in level of competition for all and for Dressage and Tent Pegging uniform standards as per tech guidelines of EFI will be followed. OCs will be at liberty to select one of the course plan out of the course plans provided by EFI.
7. The MER as per **Appendix 'A'** will be followed and rider must achieve 02 MERs at two different venues to be eligible to participate in NEC/ JNEC.
8. To qualify for the Nationals, rider may participate in any number of competitions being held at various venues all over the country to achieve the desired MER. Indl has to obtain their MER's for participate in indl, Team and side events.
9. REL's will be conducted only for the following categories:-
- (a) **Seniors**: Only for Tent Pegging.
 - (b) **Juniors**: Only in Show Jumping and Dressage (Junior, Children I & Children II).
 - (c) It shall be mandatory for organiser conducting NEC to conduct REL preceding the NEC.
10. Rest of the categories except mentioned above will not be included in REL and the riders can participate directly in NEC/JNEC as applicable.
11. Expenditure on account of travel (to & from event location), local transportation, accommodation & hospitalities of officials shall be borne by the organizers.
12. Organizers to use their own infrastructure.
13. Course Plans and Dressage tests for these categories are attached as **Appendix 'B'** to 'H'.
14. REL for JNEC will start from the 1st of January every year and for Seniors immediately after the NEC Show Jumping of previous EFI Calender. The last REL will be held 30 days before the commencement of JNEC and NEC Show Jumping & Tent Pegging.

Incentive

15. Incentive will be given by EFI to a club once in a calendar year. Rs 50,000/- will be given if participation of over 25 riders and Rs 25,000/- to be given for less than **25** riders.

Procedure

16. Interested organisers may forward their Bids to EFI as per format Attached as **Appendix 'J'** duly recommended by their respective Regional Member and Vice President (Sports Development). The same will then be submitted to EFI for approval and inclusion in EFI REL Calendar. The refundable corpus money will also be forwarded alongwith bid documents.
17. The Regional member prior to recommending the conduct of REL will ascertain that the venue is fit to conduct the REL by the bidding organiser.
18. On allotment of the event the same will be included in the EFI Calendar for 2020-21 which will facilitate all horse-rider combinations to plan their move to various venues and participate to achieve MER to qualify for NEC.
19. Organizers will have to deposit a refundable security of Rs 50,000/- alongwith bid which will be refunded with incentive mentioned in Para 15 on successful completion of event. In case of non completion of event as per EFI guidelines security deposit will not be returned.

10. **Undertaking:-**

(a) I/We undertake to organize the REL Events as per the laid down conditions i.e, payment of the Corpus Money, register of riders & horses with EFI, rules, terms and conditions . I/We will abide all the conditions stipulated at Appendix and the event will be conducted as per EFI/FEI Rules/Regulations.

(b) I/We understand that should the event not conform to the stipulations I/We will be debarred by the Executive Committee from holding any event, upto two years.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR EVENT ALLOTMENT

- (a) A corpus money of amounting to Rs 50000/- (Refundable) of event be deposited along with the bid (Bid without 100% corpus money will not be considered for event allotment).
- (b) In case the OC fails to meet the technical & administrative requirement for conduct of the show, the EFI Rep will recommend cancellation of the show. The Federation **reserves the right** to cancel such shows without reasons, if needed. In event of such cancellation, the organizer will forfeit his corpus money.
- (c) **It is the responsibility of the OC to ensure that Junior, Children-I and Children II participate in their age group only.**
- (d) **The OC will also ensure use of safety cups and electronic timers for all Show Jumping and Tent Pegging events.**
- (e) **The OC will appoint a person** as a contact person to interact with the Federation on all issues connected with the REL event. It is recommended that the contact person be also the Show Secretary and is available with the OC/ one month prior to the Show and till completion of events.
- (f) **The OC will ensure that soft copy of manuscript results duly signed by jury alongwith result in excel sheet to be emailed within 24 hours of completion of each category of event.**
- (g) **Original result sheets alongwith photograph of complete event in a CD and other supporting documents duly signed by the jury for all events will be dispatched by post to the Federation office within 2 days of completion of show.**
- (h) Veterinary facilities must be made available 24 hours in the camp. During the conduct of events at the show ground, Veterinary First Aid must always be made available.
- (j) First Aid & Ambulance with Doctor must be available during the conduct of events.
- (k) The Ground Jury and other officials for all events will be detailed from EFI empanelled official list and as per terms of Para 5 of REL Guidelines.
- (l) The travel expenses to and fro (as applicable), boarding, lodging & local transport for the all officials and EFI Rep who is detailed by EFI to check the smooth conduct of the show, will be mandatorily borne by the organizer.
- (m) The OC of Tent Pegging will conduct all Tent Pegging disciplines as per EFI/ITPF rules.
- (n) The BID to host an REL will forward to EFI as per para 17 of REL guidelines.
