1. **Introduction.** The Equestrian Federation of India has entrusted the responsibility to Punjab Equestrian Association, Jalandhar to organize the NEC Tent Pegging 2019-20 from 18th – 23rd March 2020 as per attached schedule of events at **Appendix A** at the Punjab Armed Police HQ Jalandhar. 2. **Venue.** Punjab Armed Police Campus,
Jalandhar Cantt

3. **List of Events.** The following events of NEC Tent Pegging will be conducted as per Equestrian Federation of India's Technical Guidelines 2019:-

(a) **Individual Events**

- (i) NEC Tent Pegging - Lance
- (ii) NEC Tent Pegging - Sword
- (iii) NEC Tent Pegging - Rings & Peg - Lance
- (iv) NEC Tent Pegging - Lemons & Peg - Sword

(b) **Team Events**

- (i) NEC Paired Tent Pegging (Lance & Sword)
- (ii) NEC Indian File (Lance & Sword)
- (iii) NEC Tent Pegging – Lance
- (iv) NEC Tent Pegging – Sword

4. Schedule of events is attached as **Appendix A**.

5. **Entries.**

- (a) All Entries will be made on the Entry Form attached as **Appendix B** and will be as per the EFI Technical Guidelines 2019.
- (b) No entry will be accepted without an Entry Fee. This rule will be implemented across the board for all events.

6. **Entry Fee**

- (a) Individual Events - Rs 500/- per Entry
- (b) Team Events - Rs 1000/- per Team
- (c) **Payment** All payment must be made to the Show Secretary at the Show Office.
- (d) **No entry will be accepted after the Draw of Lots for the particular event.**
- (e) A horse cannot be transferred from one event to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event, a horse once entered, in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

7. **Closing Date for Receipt of Entries.** The last date for submission of entries is **17th March 2020 (1700h)**. The payment for the entries can be submitted once the teams arrive. Otherwise, all entries on prescribed forms must reach the show office by 17th March 2020 (1700h). The entries can be sent by Post/email at the following addresses:-

Note:- After the closing date i.e. **17th March 2020 (1700h)**, all entries will be accepted as **POST ENTRIES**, which will be double of the normal entry for the particular event.

8. **Eligibility**

(a) **Rider**

- (i) Riders of 16 years age and above can participate in the NEC Tent Pegging.
- (ii) Only qualified riders in REL can participated in individual events of NEC Tent Pegging. List of qualified riders will be provided by EFI office.

- (iii) To participate in the NEC Tent Pegging, Riders EFI ID No. is mandatory. No rider is allowed to participate without Rider ID No. renewed in the year of 2019-20. EFI Rider ID will not be allotted by the OC/Show Office during NEC Tent Pegging at Jalandhar. Riders are requested to contact EFI to get/renewed their rider ID before submitting entries (For any queries related to EFI Rider Registration, please contact EFI on tele No +11-25683601 / 02)

(b) **Horses**

- (i) EFI Technical guidelines 2019 must be applicable.
- (ii) All Horses participating in the NEC Tent Pegging 2019-20 must be required to be registered with EFI. The EFI Registration Number of horse should be displayed on the bridle, when the horse moves out of the stables/camping area. No horse is allowed to participate in the NEC Tent Pegging without EFI Registration Number. EFI Horse Registration Number will not be allotted by OC/Show Office during NEC Tent Pegging (For any queries related to EFI Horse Registration, please contact EFI on tele No +11-25683601 / 02).

9. **Withdrawal, Substitution or Change of Entry/Rider**

- (a) **Withdrawal**. The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded.
- (b) **Change of Riders/Horses**
 - (i) Riders or Horse can be changed only on medical ground with sufficient certificate.
 - (ii) Once an event has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

10. **Camp**

- (a) The camp will be located adjacent to the Equestrian Grounds. The Camp In-charge will earmark the site for each contingent.
- (b) The Camp will become functional with effect from **15th March 2020** and will be closed on **24th March 2020**. No one will allowed to enter in Camp before **15th Mar 2020**. No fee will be levied for camping.
- (c) Horse, Riders, Grooms/Farriers coming to participate in NEC Tent Pegging 2019-20 will stay in the camping area.
- (d) Advance information about the number of participants/ horses must be conveyed to the organizers by **01st Mar 2020** so as to finalise camping arrangements.

11. **Self Containment**. All teams coming to participate in the NEC Tent Pegging 2019-20 must be **self-contained**, i.e they should bring their own Equipment, Tent, Feed, Fodder, Cooks, Farriers and Transport etc.

12. **Climate.** The climate in the month of March is cold. Participants are advised to make requisite arrangements.
13. **Lighting.** The participants are requested to bring their own Hurricane Lanterns/ Petromax Lamps for emergency use. Power / light will be provided under camp arrangements where feasible.
14. **Discipline.** All the participants staying in the camp will be under the camp in-charge for the purpose of discipline.
15. **Fire Precautions.** All the participants are required to undertake fire-fighting precaution in their respective areas.
16. **Sanitation And Hygiene.** All participants should observe proper sanitation and hygienic measures. There should be proper disposal of litter at pre designated location.
17. **Medical Assistance.** Medical assistance will be provided at the camp site and competition area.
18. **Veterinary Assistance.** Veterinary assistance will be available at the Camp site and competition area.
19. **Responsibility.** The organising committee accepts no responsibility for any injury or loss to entrant/competitor through accident or any other cause. Neither the organisers nor the vet / medico will be held responsible for the consequences of the first aid or other medical treatment given to any injured horse or rider.
20. **Whips and Spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline. Any form of beating, punishment and brutality to horse will lead to disqualification & elimination of the competitor.
21. **Dress Code.** Riders Participating in NEC Tent pegging will wear service uniform/ T-shirt with breeches, riding shoes & Turban/Head gear. Riders kit & tack of horse will be as per FEI/EFI Guidelines.
22. **Coggin's & Glanders Test.** All participating horses must possess a negative Coggins & Glanders Test Report (CFT) . No horse will be allowed inside the camping area without valid Coggins & Glanders (CFT) Test Reports.
23. **Medals**
 - (a) Medals will be awarded to winners of first three positions in NEC Tent Pegging 2019-20. Cash Prizes will be depends upon sponsorships.
 - (b) Rosettes will be given to first four position winners.

Note: In case of Tie, Rules of EFI for that event shall apply.

24. **Cancellation.** The Organising committee may cancel any event which has less than four entries or for any reason in consultation with Equestrian Federation of India (EFI). In such case, the entry fee will be refunded.

25. **Reporting For Each Class.** All horses will report to the Arena Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entrant not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Arena Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

26. **Spectators/Outside Assistance**

- (a) The spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the Judges.
- (b) The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help.
- (c) Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena.
- (d) The Judges' decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the Judges.

27. **Flags.** All participating contingents are required to bring their outfit's Flags to be displayed prominently during the Horse Show. The flags must be handed over to the Show Office, no later than 08 Mar 2020.

28. **Veterinary Commission** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

29. **Veterinary Inspection.** All participants for the NEC Tent Pegging 2019-20 are required to present their horses for veterinary Inspection (Trotting Parade) on **18th March 2020** at **1000 AM** in the competition grounds along with original Coggins & Glanders test report and EFI passports of the horses. **Participating Teams are requested to kindly submit list of horses & riders to the show office for Vet Inspection.**

30. **ANTI DOPING.** The organiser will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders/Athletes who need to use a prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition, a Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate (TUEC) will be obtained from the Doctor prior to taking any medicine.

31. **Elimination Rounds**

- (a) 50% of Individual riders securing highest points in Round A will qualify for Round B (Lance & Sword) events.
- (b) 50% of the Teams securing highest points in Round A will qualify for Round 'B' of Team Tent Pegging (Lance & Sword) events.

32. Conduct Rules.

- (a) The events will be conducted & adjudged as per Technical Guidelines 2019 of Equestrian Federation of India.
- (b) The event will be judged by EFI Panel of Judges who are experts in the field of equestrian sports.
- (c) The decision of the Jury will be final.
- (d) The Organising Committee will cancel any class, which has less than four entries or for any other reason in consultation with Equestrian Federation of India (EFI).
- (e) All Entries are restricted to only Two per Rider in each event.

33. Objections

- (a) Objections may only be lodged by owner or person responsible for horses taking part in the event.
- (b) The objections must be lodged within half an hour of the result announced.
- (c) The appeal committee's verdict will be final and binding on all participants.
- (d) A deposit of Rs 2000/- must accompany all objections in regard to any matter during the competitions.

34. Miscellaneous.

- (a) Should any questions arise not provided for, it must be referred to the organizing committee, whose decisions will be final.
- (b) Scheduling: time and entries are subject to alteration at the discretion of the organizing committee.
