

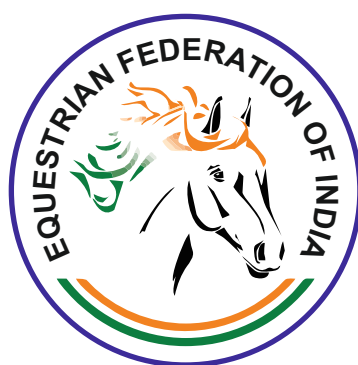

FEI JUMPING WORLD CHALLENGE 2020 (SOUTH INDIA)

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. GENERAL

FEI World Jumping Challenge – 2020 (South India) is being organized on 27th, 29th November and 6th December at the Embassy International Riding School, Bangalore.

2. CATEGORIES

FEI World Challenge Jumping Categories A, B and C.

3. PROGRAMME

Schedule of Events - Attached at **Appendix 'A'**.

4. ENTRIES

(a) All entries will be on proper Entry Form as per format attached at **Appendix 'B'** should be submitted to EFI office latest by 24th November 2020.

(b) **Entry Fee.** Rs 500/- per competition.

(c) **Closing date for Entries:** Entries for FEI Jumping World Challenge 2020 will be closed on **November 24th 2020**. No Entries will be accepted post this date as the entries will need to be uploaded on the FEI Portal.

(d) **FEI WJC HORSE DECLARATION.** Participants with more than one horse need to fill the FEI horse declaration form and submit to the organizing committee before the VET Check.

(e) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give description, EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number, name & year of birth of the horse.

5. REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI

(a) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in the FEI World Challenge have to be in possession of the new EFI passport.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

6. REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI

(a) As per EFI rulings ALL Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without Valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

7. **WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTIONS OF ENTRY**

(a) **Withdrawal:**

The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions:**

A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders:**

Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

8. **SHOW NUMBER**

All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

9. **ROSETTES**

No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

10. **ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION**

The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised.

11. **WHIPS/SPURS**

As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline

12. **DRESS CODE**

When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. **Service personnel will be in uniform.** It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.

13. **APPEAL**

Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) should be deposited with the Show Secretary, Embassy International Riding School along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

14. **MEDICAL COVER**

The Club will as usual provide medical cover for riders at the venue. The Club shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving the club of any responsibility in this regard. The Club will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.

15. **INSURANCE**

The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.

16. **RESPONSIBILITY**

The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

17. **CAMP: CAMPING AND ACCOMMODATION**

- (a) The camp opens on 24th November 2020 and camp closes on 8th December 2020.
- (b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
- (c) The Organisers will try to arrange for Bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- (d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements before the 18th November 2020, after which no stable orders can be accepted.
- (e) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

- (f) All teams must inform the organisers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 18th November 2020, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.
- (g) All teams must inform the organisers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(h) Any teams requiring a horse float and/or a vehicle to transport luggage from the Bangalore Railway Station to Embassy must inform the Organisers by 18th November 2020, to facilitate reservation of floats.

(i) The cost of transporting six horses from the railway station to Embassy via horse float is Rs. 8500 + tax.

(j) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.

(k) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbins provided. Please minimize your use of plastic materials.

(l) No open fires are permitted on EIRS grounds.

(m) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited

18. **COGGIN'S AND GLANDERS TESTS**

All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT or Mallein) certificate on arrival in Bangalore. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

19 **VETERINARY COMMISSION** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

20. **COMPLIANCE OF NADA RULES.** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

21. **COVID-19 PROTOCOL.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.

A separate set of guidelines will be sent from time to time to ensure safety of all. You are all requested to abide by the same. All decisions made by the COVID – 19 Compliance Officer will be final and binding. It is mandatory for all athletes, parents, trainer, grooms and all accompanying individuals to fill the COVID – 19 Self Declaration Form.
