TECHNICAL & ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

General

1. The REL for JNEC 2020 will be conducted on 7th & 8th November, 2020 according to the Rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI)/FEI by the Amateur Riders' Club at our Riding Schools, Mumbai.
2. **EFI Covid 19 Protocol.** All participants will have to comply with the Covid 19 protocol for equestrian training and events issued by EFI. All riders, horse owners, syces should maintain social distancing, wearing of mask and using hand sanitizers is compulsory.
3. **Venue:** REL will be conducted at Amateur Riders' Club, Mumbai.
4. **Tentative Programme:** Refer **Appendix 'A'**.
5. **Entry.**
 - (a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given at **Appendix 'B'** and should be completed in all respects. Entries not on the prescribed form are liable to be rejected.
 - (b) **Entry Fee:** Individual Events: Rs.500/- + GST per exhibit.
 - (c) **Closing Date for Entries:** Entries will close two days prior thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES.
 - (f) **Post Entries:** Post entries will be accepted twenty-four hours before the event. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT. Post entry fee will be Rs.1000/- per exhibit in individual.
 - (g) **Description and Registration of Horses:** All entries must give the description, registration No. grading and name of the horse concerned. The name of the rider will be given for all classes.
 - (h) **Payment:** All entries must be paid in cash / by local cheque in favour of **Amateur Riders' Club** or by NEFT transfer Appendix.
6. **EFI Registration of Riders and horses.**
 - (a) All the riders participating in the EFI recognized events should obtain EFI ID no.
 - (b) A rider who does not have an EFI rider ID number will not be permitted to take part in REL 2020.
 - (c) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in REL have to be in possession of the EFI horse passport.
 - (d) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries

for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(e) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

7. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry Fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as **Post Entries**. Once a class has started being judged, no change of rider will be accepted.

8. **Reporting for Each Class.** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

9. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during completion and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

10. All events scheduled in the afternoons will continue under lights, when required.

11. **Abuse / Cruelty to Horses:** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

12. **Elimination/Disqualification:** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.

13. **Whips/Spurs:** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

14. **Dress Code:** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie must be worn however the jacket may be optional depending on weather. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.

15. **Appeal:** Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) should be deposited with the Secretary, Amateur Riders' Club Riding School along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

16. **Medical Cover:** The Organising Committee will provide medical cover for riders

at the venue. The Organising Committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences thereof. The Organising Committee will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.

17. **Insurance:** The Organising Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, grooms/any other member of the team.

18. **Responsibility:** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

19. **Camping and Accommodation.**

(a) The camp opens on 2nd November, 2020 and closes on 24th November, 2020.

(b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tent age for stabling and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.

(c) The Organizers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.

(d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements on or before 5th Nov 2020 after which no stable orders will be accepted.

(e) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

(i) If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

(ii) If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

(f) The OC will ensure at all times the safety and security of the camp to avoid any mishap.

(g) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by the 5th Nov 2020, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.

(h) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(i) All Army and Government units will be provided space to setup their own

camps. All tent age and other stabling material to be brought by them.

(j) The organizers will provide one bulb and electrical connection for a fan. Fans to be brought by participants.

(k) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.

(l) No open fires are permitted on Amateur Riders' Club Riding School grounds.

20. **Self Containment:** All teams coming to participate in the Horse Show must be self-contained, i.e., they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping, cooks and transport, etc. Any contingent requiring camping stables at the premises may contact the Secretary, Amateur Riders' Club, by 02nd Nov 2020

21. **Ration/Fodder:** Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/fodder to sustain their horses during their stay in Bangalore or they can ask for attachment with the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations. However, animal rations and hay can be procured on cash payment.

22. **Coggin's and Glanders Tests.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status certificate on arrival to Mumbai. Coggin's and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

23. **Calvanza 03 Vaccination:** Every horse must be duly vaccinated with the calvanza 03 vaccine. For horses who are being vaccinated for the 1st time, 3 doses with a gap of 21 days between each dose is required. Horses already vaccinated will require an annual booster dose. **Horses without this vaccination will not be allowed to enter the Amateur Riders' Club / RWITC premises.**

24. **Protocol for bringing horses to Amateur Riders' Club / RWITC premises.**
Every horse should be accompanied by the following valid Veterinary Documents:-

(a) Identification Certificate or Passport alongwith vaccination record.

(b) Glanders & EIA (Coggins) Blood Test Report. (Glanders validity 30 days, EIA validity 120 days).

(c) Calvanza 03 vaccination.

(d) Proof of Pneumobort - K vaccine (only for horses coming from Maharashtra itself). Health Certificate of the Horse (Authorised Vets for Certifying: State Veterinary Officer active, Army Veterinary Office active, Panel Vet (RWITC) Registered).

(e) Declaration Letter from the owner (on his Letterhead) stating the place where the horse was stabled in the last 60 days before proposed entry into ARC / RWITC.

(f) Veterinary Documents should reach to ARC office 72 hrs in advance to enable us to get permission from the race course.

25. **Veterinary Commission:** The Veterinary Commission detailed by office of ARC / RWITC 2020 at Mumbai will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

26. **Veterinary Assistance.** A Veterinary First Aid will be established near the Camp Site for Treatment.

27. **Compliance of NADA Rules.** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
