REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE-Tent Pegging

1. Introduction

Punjab Equestrian Association has been entrusted the responsibility of hosting the **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE-Tent Pegging** as per attached schedule of events as **Appendix A** according to the rules & technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India, at the Punjab Armed Police HQ Jalandhar. **For the prospectus, schedule of events, officers to be contacted and such other details of the event can be contacted on the Punjab Equestrian Association E-mail :- pbequestrianassociation@gmail.com.**

COVID 19 Protocols

- a) In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.
- b) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents must Wearing a mask at all times in ground, camp, show office etc.
- c) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to follow the norms as per instructions and need to be carry certificate of fully vaccinated or copy of RT PCR 24hrs prior is mandatory due to the prevailing scenario.
- d) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents must carry sanitizes at all times.
- e) A hand wash sink along with antiseptic soap will be provided by organizers. All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are advised to wash their hands properly.
- e) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to maintain a distance of between each other in camp, ground show office and during the competition.
- f) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to kindly follow guidelines of State/Centre Govt for COVID19.

(NOTE: Athletes, grooms, trainers, family, officials or any other person visiting Punjab Armed Police Campus, Jalandhar will not be allowed to enter without the COVID-19 Self Declaration Form and.)

2. VENUE:

REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE will be held at Punjab Armed Police Campus, Jalandhar Cant, from **15-17 Jan. 2022**.

3. ENTRIES:

- (i) **All Entries will be made on the entry form attached as Appendix B** and will be as per the E.F.I technical /REL guidelines.
- (ii) **No entry will be accepted without an entry- fee.** This rule will be implemented across the board for all events.

Entry Fee:

Individual Events : Rs. 500/- per entry

Payment: All entries must be made to the Show Secretary at the show office.

- (iii) **No entry will be accepted after the Draw of Lots for the particular event.**
- (iv) A. horse cannot be transferred from one event to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event, a horse once entered, in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

4. CLOSING DATE FOR RECEIPT OF ENTRIES:

- (i) The last date for submission of **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** is 14 Jan. 2022 (5PM).
- (ii) The payment for the entries must be deposit before the draw of lots.
- (iii) All entries on prescribed forms duly signed by team Captain/Manager/Coach/Owner of concerned team must reach the show office by 14 Jan. 2022 (5PM). The entries can be sent by email on pbequestrianassociation@gmail.com
- (iv) **Note:- After the closing date all entries will be accepted as POST ENTRIES, which will be double of the normal entry for the particular event.**

5. ELIGIBILITY

RIDER:-

- i) Riders of 16 years age and above can participate in the **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** Tent Pegging.
- ii) To participate in the REL, Riders EFI ID No. is mandatory.

6. REGISTRATION OF HORSES:-

All Horses participating in the **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** will be required to be registered with EFI. The EFI No. of horse should be displayed on the bridle, when the horse moves out of the stables/camping area.

7. WITHDRAWAL, SUBSTITUTION OR CHANGE OF ENTRY/RIDER

a) Withdrawal:

The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the event.

b) Change of Riders:

i) Riders or Horse can be changed only on medical ground with sufficient certificate.

ii) Once an event has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

8. CAMP

i) The camp will be located adjacent to the Equestrian Grounds. The Camp In-charge will allot the site for each contingent.

ii) The Camp will become operational on 12 Jan. 2022 and will be closed on 19 Jan 2022.

iii) Horse, riders, grooms/farriers coming to participate in **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** will stay in the camping area.

iv) Advance information about the number of participants/ horses must be conveyed to the organizers by 10 Jan 2022 so as to finalize camping arrangements.

9. SELF CONTAINMENT:

All teams coming to participate in the **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** must be **self-contained**, i.e they should bring their own equipment, tent, feed, fodder, cooks, farriers and transport etc.

10. CLIMATE:

The climate in the month of January is cold. Participants are advised to make requisite arrangements.

11. LIGHTING:

The participants are requested to bring their own Hurricane Lanterns/ Petromax Lamps for emergency use. Power / light will be provided under camp arrangements where feasible.

12. DISCIPLINE:

All the participants staying in the camp will be under the camp in-charge for the purpose of discipline.

13. FIRE PRECAUTIONS:

All the participants are required to undertake fire-fighting precaution in their respective areas.

14. SANITATION AND HYGEINE:

All participants should observe proper sanitation and hygienic measures. There should be proper disposal of litter at pre designated location.

15. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE:

Medical assistance will be provided at the camp site and competition area.

16. VETERINARY ASSISTANCE:

Veterinary assistance will be available at the Camp site and competition area.

17. RESPONSIBILITY:

The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any injury or loss to entrant/competitor through accident or any other cause. Neither the organizers nor the vet / medico will be held responsible for the consequences of the first aid or other medical treatment given to any injured horse or rider.

18. WHIPS AND SPURS:

As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline. Any form of beating, punishment and brutality to horse will lead to disqualification & elimination of the competitor.

19. DRESS CODE:

Dress code for REL Tent Pegging will be as per EFI Technical guidelines.

20. COGGIN's & MALLEIN TEST:

All participating horses must possess a negative Coggins & Mallein Test Report (CFT). **No horse will be allowed inside the camping area without valid Coggins & Mallein test(CFT) reports.**

Participants are advised not to bring horses having nasal discharge or cough (cattar in hindi) or with lower jaw lymph node swelling, while beginning the journey. Such horses will not be allowed to enter the PAP Camus, Jalandhar.

On arrival all horses will be physically inspected for any infectious or contagious diseases by the Veterinary Officers.

Horses which do not comply with the above medical protocol will not be allowed to enter PAP Camus, Jalandhar Cantt.

21. REPORTING FOR EACH CLASS :

All horses will report to the Arena Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entrant not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Arena Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

22. SPECTATORS/OUTSIDE ASSISTENCE:

- i) The spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the Judges.
- ii) The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help.
- iii) Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena.
- iv) The Judges' decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the Judges.

23. VETERINARY INSPECTION:

All participants for the **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** are required to present their horses for veterinary Inspection (Trotting Parade) on 17 Jan 2022 at 8-00 AM in the competition grounds along with a copy of the Coggins & Mallein Test (CFT) report and EFI passports of the horses.

24. Conduct rules:

- a) **REGIONAL EQUESTRAIN LEAGUE** will be conducted & adjudged as per rules of EFI (Equestrian Federation of India/ITPF)
- b) The event will be judged by the panel of judges who are experts in the field of equestrian sports.
- c) The decision of the jury will be final.

25. Objections:

- a) Objections may only be lodged by owner or person responsible for horses taking part in the event.
- b) The objections must be lodged within half an hour of the result announced.
- c) The appeal committee's verdict will be final and binding on all participants.
- d) A deposit of Rs 2000/- must accompany all objections in regard to any matter during the competitions.

26. Miscellaneous :

- a) Should any questions arise not provided for, it must be referred to the organizing committee, whose decisions will be final.
- b) Scheduling: time and entries are subject to alteration at the discretion of the organizing committee.
