

RULES AND REGULATIONS : TEMPORARY STABLING FACILITY
ARMY EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, (AEC), DELHI CANTT

1. **Eligibility.** The camping facility at Army Equestrian Centre will only be authorized to those who are either members of Indian Polo Association or Equestrian Federation of India for the events being conducted by the APRC.
2. **Security.** All Defence/Para Military contingents, private horse owners and APRC members are hereby instructed to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations. Any violation of these instructions would render the concerned contingent liable to be asked to vacate the AEC premises forthwith.
3. Entry and stabling within the AEC will be regulated by the Officer-in-Charge of AEC. Contingent Cdrs/private horse owners/APRC members will be personally responsible to ensure that only specified areas are utilised for camping, stabling and riding. All Contingents Cdr/Private horse owners/APRC members will render all documents as mentioned in Para 2 (e) of the prospectus alongwith the request for temporary stabling.
4. **Duration.** Camping facility will be opened from **08 Dec 2021 onwards.**
5. **Procedure.**
 - (a) **For Entry to AEC.** All Defence/Para Military contingents, private horse owners and APRC members will render an application as per format attached at Appendix 'A', 15 days before the arrival of the team at the AEC/ date from which temporary stabling is intended at the AEC alongwith documents as mentioned in para 3 above. The application will be addressed to OIC, AEC, B Squadron 61 Cavalry, Delhi Cantt.
 - (b) Without above mentioned documents, the horses will not be permitted for entering in the AEC stables.
 - (c) **For Exit from the AEC.** The following documents will be produced by all Defence/ Para Military contingents, CAPFs, private horse owners and APRC members:-
 - (i) Coggins & Glanders Negative certificate valid for minimum of 15 days at the time of exit.
 - (ii) No demand certificate issued by the OIC AEC.
6. **Jurisdiction.** The responsibility as regard safety of men, material and horses is that of the owner. No claim can be made against the camp authorities.
7. All horse owners/Army contingents who require to stable their horses at the AEC must process their permission from the AEC office in advance.

I hereby assure that antecedents of _____ men working for me have been checked and verified by the civil police and there are no adverse report against any of my men entering the Army Equestrian Centre. Certificates to this effect issued by Civil Police in respect all of my civilian employees along with two copy of their photographs are enclosed for records.
7. I understand that no civilian temporarily stabling at the Army Equestrian Centre is permitted to enter any area of surrounding military establishments and anyone caught on tress passing surrounding military establishments will be handed over to the civil police for further prosecution. I hereby take full responsibility of my civilian employees and assure that they will not indulge in an act leading to breach of security.
8. I also assure that all members of my contingent/our horses & vehicles will use the main entrance only for entry/exit to the Army Equestrian Centre.
9. The responsibility as regard safety of men, material and horses is mine. No claim will be made against the camp authorities /Army in this regard.
10. The responsibility in regards to maintaining trees/plants within my camp area specified by 2IC, AEC is mine.

11. I will be responsible for cleaning up my camp site when I have to move out from the AEC.
