ADM AND TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FEI JUMPING WORLD CHALLENGE 2021 **(NORTH INDIA)**

General

1. The FEI Jumping World Challenge -2021 (North India) will be conducted on 22, 24 Nov and 01 December 2021 at TARC Equestrian Centre, Chattarpur, New Delhi as per the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India and FEI . Competition 3 of Category A will be considered as Qualifying Competition for 2022 Youth Jumping Competition (YJC).

2. Stabling/Camp Facility and Charges.

(i) Venue & stabling will be open on **November 20 Nov 2021** and close on **02 December 2021**.

(ii) Limited temporary stables are available which will be allotted on first cum first serve basis.

(iii) All teams that require stables must send their requirements before the **November 15TH 2021**, after which no stable orders can be accepted.

(iv) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

(iv) **Venue.** The event will be held at TARC Equestrian Centre, B-7 Farm, Bhatti Kalan, Chhatarpur, New Delhi - 110074. Route chart of the same is attached as. Venue & stables will be open on **November 20, 2021**. Venue & stabling will close on **December 2nd 2021**.

(NOTE: Athletes, grooms, trainers, family, officials or any other person visiting TARC Equestrian Centre will not be allowed to enter without the COVID-19 Self Declaration Form.)

3. **Camp.** All horses will be stabled at The TARC Equestrian centre, Chhatarpur. Stables / camp area will be allotted by the organizing committee to all teams depending on the no of horses per team. All horse handlers are permitted to stay along with the horses in temporary accommodation earmarked for the same. All teams are requested to share the number of horses/ handlers per contingent that are likely to come, latest by **NOVEMBER 15, 2021** with the show secretary / camp incharge via E-mail. Venue & stables will be open on **November 20, 2021** and close on **December 02, 2021**.

4. **Self-containment.** In addition to the above all teams must be self-contained in terms of tentage, equipment for camping and transport in order to be prepared for any unforeseen emergency.

5. **Ration /Fodder.** All teams should bring their own feed, hay, bedding, grass, etc. for their horses and should make their own provision for staff food. Tarc Equestrian Centre will not provide any assistance for the above unless special facilities are being provided for all teams.

6. **Coggin's and Glanders Test** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI on this subject will be strictly adhered to by all participating teams. All teams must produce a valid negative EIA and Glanders status certificate on arrival with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival.

7. **Veterinary commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by Equestrian Federation Of India will have the right to examine all the horses participating.

8. **Veterinary Assistance.** Dr. Vikram Malhotra– Mobile:+919871490564

9. **Farrier.** All teams & riders are responsible to arrange their own farrier. TARC Equestrian Centre will not provide any assistance.

10. **Medical cover.** The organizing committee will provide first aid and ambulance at the venue, however the organizing committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor on the venue or the consequences thereof. Each rider participating in the TARC Regional Equestrian League will fill the Indemnity Bond as attached at **Appendix D** and submit the same along with entry form.

11. **Insurance.** The organizing committee recommends units/club to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms & horses for their transportation to TARC equestrian Centre & during the conduct of the events. The organizing committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, and groom/ any other member of the team.

12. **Responsibility.** The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves.

13. **Clearance Certificate.** All horse owners /riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the organizing committee during working hours. All concerned accounts need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses/ Person will be allowed to leave the camp by the Camp In charge unless they obtain the clearance certificate.

15. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the

EFI will be strictly adhered to.

A separate set of guidelines will be sent from time to time to ensure safety of all. You are all requested to abide by the same. All decisions made by the COVID – 19 Compliance Officer will be final and binding. It is mandatory for all athletes, parents, trainer, grooms and all accompanying individuals to fill the COVID – 19 Self Declaration Form.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

16. Technical Specifications. Event will be conducted as per FEI Jumping World Challenge Rule 2021 attached at **Appendix A** and other EFI/FEI relevant rules.

17. Programme. Tentative Programme of FEI Jumping World Challenge 2021 including Qualifying Competition for 2022 Youth Jumping Competition (YJC) is attached at Appendix '**B**'.

18. Entries.

(a) All entries will be on proper Entry Form as per format attached at **Appendix C** should be submitted to EFI office latest by 20 November 2021.

(b) **Entry Fee.** Rs 500/- per competition.

(c) **Closing date for Entries:** Entries for FEI Jumping World Challenge 2021 will be close on **November 20, 2021**. No Entries will be accepted post this date as the entries will need to be uploaded on the FEI Portal.

(d) **FEI WJC HORSE DECLARATION.** Participants with more than one horse need to fill the FEI horse declaration form and submit to the organizing committee before the VET Check.

(e) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give description, EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number, name & year of birth of the horse.

(f) **Payment.** All entry fees must be paid to **Equestrian Federation of India** either online, by local cheque or NEFT in favour of Equestrian Federation of India.

19. EFI Horses Passport. As per EFI rules all horses participating in the all EFI events must have the new 'H' series valid EFI passport in original. Entries will not be accepted without the EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number of the horse.

20. EFI Rider Registration.

(a) All riders participating in any EFI event must have a valid/renewed EFI Rider Identification Number.

(b) Riders not having renewed EFI rider ID number will not be permitted to participate.

21. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.

- (a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- (b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as Post Entries. Once an event has started, being judged, no change in rider / horse will be accepted.
- (d) **Technical specification of events.** The events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of FEI and EFI as per relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions and local merits /climate in consultations with EFI/FEI.

22. Cancellation or reschedule. The Organizing committee may cancel or reschedule any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, depending on the numbers of entries received, the organizing committee may decide against this for any particular event.

23. Reporting for Each Class. All horses will report to the collecting ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

24. Show Number. All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

25. Abuse/ Cruelty to horses. Refer to EFI Technical guidelines and FEI rules.

26. Rosettes. A horse will wear no rosettes during judging.

27. Elimination / Disqualification. The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, or any type of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized. Refer to FEI Rules for Jumping.

28. Whips/spurs. As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

29. Dress code. When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, white or lightly colored plain shirts, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with a three-point retention harness including riders in uniform.

30. Appeal. Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee equivalent to Indian currency of 150 CHF should be deposited with the Secretary, TARC Equestrian Centre, Chhatarpur along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

31. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
