ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION : REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE (REL)

1. Regional Equestrian League (REL) will be held at ARPA, ASC C & College, Bangalore wef 09 Oct 2021 to 11 Oct 2021. Details of the events including specifications are as per attached technical instructions.
2. The competition will be conducted as per FEI & EFI guidelines.

Camp Arrangement.

3. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located at C coy location. The camp will start functioning wef 06 Oct 2021. Contingents will ensure that they do not reach the camp before 06 Oct 2021.
4. The Camp OIC will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp OIC on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the rep of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all respects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals.
5. All teams will intimate the total str of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 05 Oct 2020 and intimate ETA well in advance. Format attach as **Appx 'A'** to administrative instructions duly filled and signed must reach the show secretary by 06 Oct 2021.

Accommodation.

6. All participants are required to make arrangement for their accommodation. In case any assistance is required you may contact Secy ARPA.

Civilians.

7. Suitable camping site near the horses will be earmarked for accommodating JCOs/OR and civil personnel. The contingents should be self contained to accommodate their civil personnel.

Practice and Exercise Area.

8. A suitable area will be earmarked close to the camp for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise area will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the events.

Lighting.

9. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/patronages/ Gen sets for emergency use. However light/power shall be provided under camp arrangements where feasible.

Ration for Army Animals.

10. Rations for animals for all participating Army horses will be drawn from Supply Depot, Bangalore. Sufficient packing materials for storage of ration including drinking water will be

brought by the contingent for horses and men. Contingent will submit their indent for drawing of ration to Sup Depot Bangalore directly after publishing their Station Order from K & K Sub Area, Bangalore for attachment with Sup Depot Bangalore.

11. Private horses/civil contingent should come fully equipped with stabling facilities, fodder and grain etc.

Transport.

12. Contingents are advised to be self-contained for transport.

Line Gear for Animals.

13. Contingents will bring adequate line gear and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Safaiwala.

14. The contingents will bring their own safaiwalas for cleaning of respective camp site and the surrounding area.

Pitching of Tents.

15. Contingent will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

16. No families will be accommodated in the camp.

Fire Precautions.

17. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precaution of their respective areas. The Camp OIC however, will detail fire fighting/piquet parties from amongst the participating contingents if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

18. Proper sanitation and hygiene measures will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals' litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precaution will be taken by all concerned.

Discipline.

19. All participants, grooms and administrative staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp OIC for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained. No liquor is to be consumed in the camping area.

Security.

20. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingent during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not

entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Bangalore. Local/station order on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All civilians will be in possession of valid prelim police verification.

Veterinary/Medical Cover.

21. Veterinary cover to army animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 49 Mil Vet Hospital, Bangalore who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp. Following are available for vet assistance in case of emergency: -

22. Medical cover will be provided under the arrangement of Command Hospital, Bangalore. The organizing committee will provide medical cover for riders at the venue however, same shall not accept any liabilities for med treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. The organizing committee will only provide first aid treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary. Each rider participating in REL (All Grades) will fill the Indemnity Bonds attach as **Appx-B** to Administrative Instructions and submit the same along with entry form.

Foreign National.

23. All teams arranging foreign nationals as coach/riders are required to forward the details of the foreign national and companions as per format enclosed as **Appx-C** to Administrative Instructions along with photocopy of passport and visa prior to the start of the show and obtain MI clearance from the concerned authorities.

Coggins Test for Equine Infectious Anemia and Mallein Test / CFT for Glanders.

24. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival at Bangalore as per policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have been Mallein tested/ CFT negative and examined by Veterinary Officer with certificate stating to be free from any infectious or contagious disease, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and Mallein/CFT negative certificate are to be produced to Camp OIC on arrival.

Registration of Horses.

25. Only horses registered with the EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI registration No of horses. Riders/team Captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd No of horses which have not yet been registered for passport.

Clearance Certificate.

26. All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Camp OIC and Show Secretary during working hours. All accounts concerned need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless clearance certificate is obtained.

2. I have read the Rules & Regulations for Temporarily Stabling at the ASC Centre & College and have fully understood the same. I will comply with the said Rules & Regulations and any other instructions given from time to time.

6. I hereby assure that antecedents of _____ men working for me have been checked and verified by the civil police and there are no adverse report against any of my men entering the premises. Certificates to this effect issued by Civil Police in respect all of my civilian employees along with two copy of their photographs are enclosed for records.
7. I understand that no civilian temporarily stabling at the camp premises is permitted to enter any area of surrounding military establishments and any one caught on tress passing surrounding military establishments will be handed over to the civil police for further prosecution. I hereby take full responsibility of my civilian employees and assure that they will not indulge in an act leading to breach of security.
8. I also assure that all members of my contingent/our horses & vehicles will use only the earmarked way for entry/exit to/from the Camp Area.
9. The responsibility as regard safety of men, material and horses is mine. No claim will be made against the camp authorities /Army in this regard.
10. I will be responsible for cleaning up my camp site when I have to move out from the Camp area from ASC Centre & College.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTION: REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE (REL)

1. Regional Equestrian League REL will be held at ASC C & College, Bangalore wef 09 Oct 2021 to 11 Oct 2021 according to the FEI rules and technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue. Tentative program and list events are as per **Appx 'A' & Appx 'B'** to technical instruction.

2. **Fee.**

(a) **Entry Fee.** Entry fee for various events is as under :-

(i) All team events Rs 1000/- per team.

(ii) All individual events Rs 500/- per exhibit.

(b) **Stabling Fee.** Temp stables @ 2500/- per stable for the duration of the event, only if notice given before 06 Oct 2021 and full payment is recd.

Note :- All participants are requested to send entries on trainingmashal@hotmail.com latest by 1700 hrs on 08 Oct 2021.

3. **Closing Time / Date of Entries.** Entries will be forwarded by **1700** hrs on **08** Oct 2021. Entries after due time / date will be by permission of Ground Jury and payment of post entry fee as under :-

(a) All team events Rs 2000/- per team.

(b) All individual events Rs 1000/- per exhibit.

4. **Entries.** All entries will be on the prescribed specimen Performa attached as **Appx 'C'** to technical instruction for events and sent to Show Secretary, Organizing Committee. Riders/units will be responsible for submitting correct entry, complete in all respects.

5. **Payment.** The entry fee may be paid in cash or by demand draft in favour of ARPA, ASC Centre & College, Bangalore.

6. **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse can not be transferred from one class to another without paying additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A rider/horse once entered in any event can not be substituted by another for any reason, whatsoever.

7. **Eligibility of Horses.** Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades. All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. Riders are liable to be disqualified and /or penalized for incorrect entry of the horse, as per EFI regulations.

8. **Technical Specifications of Events.** The events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of EFI as per the relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications / number of rounds for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions. Dressage tests for various categories are attached.

9. **Cancellation of Classes.** The organizing committees reserve the right to cancel any class with less than four entries, in which case the entry fees will be refunded.

10. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the time of judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.

11. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Regn number on the bridle during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable under a saddle.

12. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

13. **Objections.** Objection may be lodged in writing by the team Captain/ Competitor to the technical delegate within 30 minutes before commencement of the event and for objections concerning irregularities or incidents during the competition not later than half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs 2000/- in cash will accompany the objection and will be refunded, if the objection is up held.

14. **Responsibility.** The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.

15. **Disqualification.** The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.

16. **Dress Code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or light colour plain shirt, white tie and jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three-point retention harness including riders in uniform.

17. **Enhanced Competition Safety during the Covid-19 Pandemic.** The Policy for Enhanced Competition Safety during the Covid-19 Pandemic is intended to assist FEI Event Participants in limiting the risk of transmission and further spread of Covid-19 until an effective treatment and/or vaccine as determined by the World Health Organization are available. The decisions regarding the timing of resumption of equestrian Events will be made in close consultation with the applicable domestic government and public health authorities. This is issued according to the FEI Board Decision and applies to all Events held under FEI jurisdiction as of 01 Oct 2021 until further notice.

18. **Safety and Risk Mitigation Compliance of Covid 19.** All teams will ensure the following:-

(a) Ensure a standard approach across FEI Events to mitigate the risk of transmission and further spread of Covid-19 until an effective treatment and/or vaccine as determined by the World Health Organization are available.

(b) Help OCs and NFs assess the risks potentially posed from the planning phase and identify REL event measures to mitigate such risks.

(c) Cover domestic medical resources, essential phone numbers, procedure to follow if a person records a temperature higher than 37.5 degrees Celsius /99.5 degrees Fahrenheit, and compliance to Camp instructions if diagnosed Covid-19 positive.

- (d) Compliance with the domestic health authorities in the risk assessment and mitigation measures elaboration process.
- (e) Document the process, Communicate the outcome of the risk assessment and the mitigation measures plan including the contact list along with confirmation from the camp authorities so that the Event can be held accordingly.
- (f) Inform the symptoms of Covid-19 to any individual in vicinity or locally and if necessary repeat the risk assessment process closer to the Event to verify that the overall risk score has not changed and the mitigation measures are appropriate.
- (g) Disseminate the plan and mitigation measures communicated by OC Camp and FEI Officials to all team members and compliance.
- (h) Apply and enforce the mitigation measures identified for the Event. No one to leave the camp and visitors are strictly prohibited.
- (i) In addition, apply and enforce any measure identified as mandatory in this document and/or the Guidelines and Protocols which may be published by the FEI/EFI from time to time. Understand and comply with the Covid-19 risk mitigation measures applying at the Events they are appointed to.
- (j) Within their respective functions, assist OC Camp with the measures implemented under this Policy.
- (k) Assign roles: Ensuring the safety of your Event during the Covid-19 pandemic is a new task which will require additional staff/volunteers, there will be a need to designate a person who will have team responsibility for conducting the risk assessment overseeing the implementation of mitigation measures in accordance with this Policy.
- (l) If any team member has been exposed to a person with Covid-19 in the last two weeks or diagnosed or suspected to have Covid-19 in the last two weeks?
- (m) Enforce social distancing throughout the venue at all times.
- (n) Limited entries will be allowed in the arena and all teams captains are required to ensure compliance.
- (o) The public/spectators will be limiting or prohibiting on the competition grounds to reduce risk.
