ADM AND TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FEI JUMPING WORLD CHALLENGE 2021

(SOUTH INDIA)

1. GENERAL

FEI World Jumping Challenge – 2021 is being organized on 20th, 22nd and 29th November 2021- At Amateur Riders' Club, Mumbai as per the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India and FEI. Competition 3 of Category A will be considered as Qualifying Competition for 2022 Youth Jumping Competition (YJC).

2. CATEGORIES

FEI World Challenge Jumping Categories A, B and C. FEI Jumping World Challenge-2021 rules are attached as **Appendix A**.

3. **PROGRAMME**. Tentative Programme of FEI Jumping World Challenge 2021 including Qualifying Competition for 2022 Youth Jumping Competition (YJC) is attached at Appendix '**B**'.

4. ENTRIES

(a) All entries will be on proper Entry Form as per format attached at **Appendix C** should be submitted to EFI office latest by 18 November 2021.

(b) **Entry Fee.** Rs 500/- per competition.

(c) **Closing date for Entries:** Entries for FEI Jumping World Challenge 2021 will be close on **November 18, 2021**. No Entries will be accepted post this date as the entries will need to be uploaded on the FEI Portal.

(d) **FEI WJC HORSE DECLARATION.** Participants with more than one horse need to fill the FEI horse declaration form and submit to the organizing committee before the VET Check.

(e) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give description, EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number, name & year of birth of the horse.

(f) **Payment.** All entry fees must be paid to **Equestrian Federation of India** either online, by local cheque or NEFT in favour of Equestrian Federation of India.

5. REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI

(a) As per EFI rules ALL horses participating in the FEI World Challenge have to be in possession of the EFI passport.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before submitting entries for the Event. The registration number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI rules.

- (c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

6. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI**

- (a) As per EFI rules ALL Riders participating in EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.
- (b) Entries will not be accepted without a valid / renewed / active EFI registration number.

7. **WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRY**

- (a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- (b) **Transfer and Substitution.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

8. **SHOW NUMBER**

All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

9. **ROSETTES**

No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

10. **ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION**

The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized. Refer relevant rules of FEI/EFI.

11. **WHIPS/SPURS**

As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline

12. **DRESS CODE**

When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn.

Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.

13. **APPEAL**

Appeal can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee equivalent to Indian currency of 150 CHF should be deposited with the Secretary, ARC Mumbai along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

14. **MEDICAL FACILITIES**

The Club will as usual provide medical facilities for riders at the venue. The Club shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving the club of any responsibility in this regard. The Club will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary.

15. **INSURANCE**

The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Mumbai and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.

16. **RESPONSIBILITY**

The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

17. **CAMP: CAMPING AND ACCOMODATION**

- (a) The camp opens on 15th November 2021 and closes on 01 Dec 2021.
- (b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
- (c) The Organizers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- (d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements before 5th November 2021.
- (e) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

(f) The organizers will provide one bulb and electrical connection for a fan. Fans to be brought by participants.

(g) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 5th November 2021, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.

(h) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(i) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.

(j) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbins provided. Please minimize your use of plastic materials.

(k) No open fires are permitted in the camp.

(l) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited.

18. Medical Protocol requirements for all horses issued by EFI / Amateur Riders' Club / RWITC. Every horse should be accompanied by the following valid Veterinary Documents:-

(a) Identification Certificate or Passport alongwith vaccination record.

(b) . All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT) certificate on arrival in Mumbai. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory, (Glanders validity 30 days, EIA validity 120 days).

(c) Every horse must be duly vaccinated with the Calvanza 03 vaccine. For horses who are being vaccinated for the 1st time, 3 doses with a gap of 21 days between each dose is required. Horses already vaccinated will require an annual booster dose.

(d) Proof of Pneumobort – K Vaccination (only for horses coming from within Maharashtra itself)

(e) Health Certificate of the horse (Authorized Vets for Certifying: State Veterinary Officer active, Army Veterinary Office active, Panel Vet (RWITC) Registered).

(f) Declaration Letter from the owner (on his letterhead) stating where the horse was stabled in the last 60 days before proposed entry into ARC / Mahalaxmi Race Course, Mumbai.

Note: to avoid difficulties to your animal, we strongly suggest that all above named documents be, prior to loading of the horse, sent to ARC office by email. Upon examination of the same once a “GO AHEAD” is given in writing or by email to you may not send your horses here and cause unnecessary problems to us as well as you for all practical purposes.

19. **VETERINARY COMMISSION**

The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating

20. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.

21. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
