REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAUGE 2022

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Regional Equestrian League 2022 will be conducted on 07 Nov to 09 Nov 2022 according to the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (REL Guidelines: Dressage & Show Jumping) JNEC – 2022.

2. **Age Category.** Age categories are as follow:-

S No	Category
(a)	Children II (10-12 years)
(b)	Children I (12-14 years)
(c)	Junior (14-18 years)
(d)	Young Rider (16-21 years)

3. **Entries.**

(a) Entries should be submitted on the prescribed form given 06 Nov 2022.

(b) Entry Fee. Entry fee must be paid in the form of a demand draft in favour of the **Director, Mayo College, Ajmer.** Entry fee is Rs. 500/- for per entry.

(c) Closing Date for Entries. Entries will close on 1200 hrs, 07 Nov 2022.

(d) Description and Registration of Horses. All entries must give the description, registration number, grading and name of the concerned horse. One horse cannot be registered for two different riders in same category.

4. **EFI Horses Passport.** Only horses registered with the EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI registration No of horses. Riders/team Captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd No of horses which have not yet been registered for passport.

5. **EFI Rider Registration.**

(a) As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without Valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

(c) All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of Renewed EFI identity number in 2022.

(d) NRI/OCI Card Holders. OCI Card Holders/NRI's/ Foreigners shall be given Rider ID but they cannot participate in RELs and NEC which shall be only for Indian Citizens. NRI/OCI Card Holders/Foreigners would be allowed to participate in REL/NEC as HC entry only.

6. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) Withdrawal. The Entry Fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the category.

(b) Transfer and Substitutions. A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in an event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) Change of Riders. Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once the event starts being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

5. Reporting for Each Event. All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the Events. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows valid cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has absolute authority to take appropriate disciplinary action.

6. Show Number. All horses will display the EFI Registration No on the bridle during the competition, veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

7. Elimination / Disqualification. The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised.

8. Whips/Spurs. As per EFI rules per subject.

9. Dress Code. When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. Riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly colored plain shirt, white tie and Jacket or School uniform must be worn. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform..

10. First Aid. Mayo College will provide First Aid for riders at the venue. The School shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. Mayo College will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be made available.

11. Responsibility. The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor shall be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

12. Camp. Mayo College will provide space for stabling of mounts. All participating teams must therefore, be self-contained in term of tentage and other equipment needed for camping.

13. Miscellaneous.

(a) Please get the Coggins and Glanders tests in respects of the mounts participating in the event. The test reports for all mounts participating are required to be '**Negative**'. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory. Test reports are also required and the same may be kindly be forwarded to us.

(b) Glanders and EIA (coggins) negative certificate: Glanders validity 30 days and EIA (Coggins) validity 90 days. Recognized Labs are: NRCE Hissar, DRL Pune Race Course and Central Military Veterinary Laboratory, Meerut.

(c) Animal Ration and School Flag. All teams must bring their own animal ration and two school flags.

14. **Appeal.** Any appeal shall be dealt as per FEI GR 161.
15. **Covid-19.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. **Strict adherence to MHA guidelines as renewed from time to time will be followed.** The guidelines for resuming equestrian trng and competition activities in a COVID-19 envt issued by the EFI will be followed strictly.

4.
