PROSPECTUS
NATIONAL TENT PEGGING (NEC) CHAMPIONSHIP

25 February – 03 March 2022

1. **General.** The National Equestrian Championship (NEC) Tent Pegging 2021-22, will be conducted according to the Rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) and ITPF Rules by ASC Riding & Polo Academy (ARPA), c/o ASC Centre & College, Bangalore - 560007 wef 25 February to 03 March 2022 at Bangalore.

2. **Programme.** Tentative Programme of National Equestrian Championship Tent Pegging 2021-22 are attached at **Appendix A.**

3. **Entries.**

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix B.** Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any wrong entry.

(b) **Entry Fee.**

(i) Individual Events : Rs500/- per exhibit

(ii) Team Events : Rs 1,000/- per team

(c) **Closing Date for Entries.** Entries will close by **24 Feb2022.** Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES.** No entry will be accepted without an entry fee.

(d) **Post Entries:** Post entries will be accepted two hours before the vet inspection of the event. Post entry fee will be: -

(i) Team Events : Rs 2000/- per team

(ii) Individual Events : Rs 1000/- per exhibit

(e) Only qualified riders in REL can participated in events of NEC Tent Pegging. List of qualified riders will be provided by EFI office.

(f) **Payment.** All payment must be done in cash or by RTGS or NEFT in favour of ASC Riding & Polo Academy (ARPA) to A/C No **10334168824**, IFSC Code No- **SBIN0004742.**

4. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI.**

(a) As per EFI rulings, all horses participating in the EFI approved events, have to be in possession of the new EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI at 011–25683601.

5. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI.**

(a) As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without Valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

(c) All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of Renewed EFI identity number in 2021-22. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI at 011–25683601.

6. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another class without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

7. The Class has started once the draw of lots for the order of start has been held.

8. **Reporting of Each Class.** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated.

9. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration No on the bridle during competition and Horse inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

10. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

11. **Elimination/Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised.

12. **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI/ITPF rules per discipline.

13. **Dress Code.** As per EFI rules.

14. **Appeal.** All complaints “protests” must be filed in writing within half an hour after declaration of results. A fee equivalent to 100 USD must be paid with the Show Secretary,

Army Polo & Riding Club at the time the complaint is filed. This fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

15. **Medical Cover.** The Club will provide medical cover for riders at the venue. The Club shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences thereof. The Club will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented. Each rider participating in the National Equestrian Championship Tent Pegging 2021-22 will please fill the Indemnity Bond attached as **Appendix C** and submit the same along with entry form.

16. **Insurance.** The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.

17. **Responsibility.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

18. Rail Freight. No rail freight for ponies, rail fare or, DA will be paid by the APRC to any player/attendant.

19. **Camping and Accommodation.**

(a) All teams should have come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of show.

(b) The Organisers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.

(c) All teams that require stables must send their requirements before the 20Feb 2022 after which no stable orders can be accepted. It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

(d) All teams must inform the organiser of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 14thFeb2022, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.

(e) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

- (f) The cost of transportation from the railway station to ASC Centre & College will be arranged by the respective clubs/stakeholders.
- (g) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.
- (h) The Camp is NO PLASTIC Zone and any defaulters will be fined Rs 1000/- without any appeal. Any waste is to be put into the dustbin provided. Use of bio degradable bags is permitted in the campus.
- (j) No open fires are permitted on ARPA grounds.
- (k) Cutting of trees, branches bushes is strictly prohibited.

20. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. Strict adherence to MHA guidelines as renewed from time to time will be followed. The guidelines for resuming equestrian trg and competition activities in a COVID-19 envt issued by the EFI will be followed strictly.

21. **Compliance of NADA Rules.** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) is liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

22. **Self Containment.** All teams coming to participate in NEC Tent Pegging must be self-contained, i.e, they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping, cooks and transport, etc.

23. **Ration/Fodder.** Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/fodder to sustain their horses during their stay in Bangalore or, they can ask for attachment with the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations.

24. **Coggin's and Glanders Tests.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must have a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT) certificate on arrival to ASC Centre & College Bangalore as per directions. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 30 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

25. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

Certificates to this effect issued by Civil Police in respect all of my civilian employees along with two copy of their photographs are enclosed for records.

I understand that no civilian temporarily stabling at the camp premises is permitted to enter any area of surrounding military establishments and any one caught on tress passing surrounding military establishments will be handed over to the civil police for further prosecution. I hereby take full responsibility of my civilian employees and assure that they will not indulge in an act leading to breach of security.
8. I also assure that all members of my contingent/our horses & vehicles will use only the earmarked way for entry/exit to/from the Camp Area. I will ensure that all the pers entering the camp will be RTPCR tested negative and all COVID 19 protocols will be followed
9. The responsibility as regard safety of men, material and horses is mine. No claim will be made against the camp authorities /Army in this regard.
