PROSPECTUS

GENERAL

1. Regional Equestrian League for JNEC 2022 and Tent Pegging (Senior) NEC 2022 will be conducted from 27 Oct to 29 Oct 2022 according to the rules of the EFI (REL Events) at the Army Equestrian Centre (AEC), Delhi Cantt under the aegis of Equestrian Federation of India.
2. **Camping.** Temporary stabling facility will be provided to participants for the duration of REL 2022 at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt. Rules and regulations for the temporary stabling facility are attached at **Appendix 'A'**.
3. **Covid-19.** In light of the Covid-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines as promulgated by EFI/Govt of India/Higher Head Quarters must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. Valid Covid-19 vaccination certificate (at least 02 doses) must be produced by all member of Team/Clubs including riders/participants and their associates.
4. **Medical Cover.** The APRC will as usual provide basic medical first aid cover for riders at the ground. The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider/player on the ground or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual to give a written undertaking (Indemnity Bond) absolving the APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations of any responsibility in this regard. Specimen of the Indemnity Bond to be given by all playing members/rider is as per **Annexure 3 of Appendix 'A'** to this Prospectus. The APRC will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the nearest hospital when necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.
5. **Insurance Cover.** It is recommended that all players/individual take insurance against any injury sustained while participating in the events or practicing at the Army Equestrian Centre. It would be ideal for the ponies as well to be covered under some insurance policy. The APRC may be informed as regard the above while signing the medical declaration. The APRC excludes all liability for any injury and/or loss occasioned to any person and/or their property within the premises of Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt.
6. **Coggin's and Glanders Test.** All rules and instructions issued by the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. Coggins and glanders negative certificate valid for a minimum of 15 days at the time of entry for participation.
7. **Veterinary Doctors.** The following vet doctors are available in case of an emergency.

8. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the IHQ of MoD (Army), QMG's Branch along with representative of the Animal Husbandry Commissioner for the season will have full right to examine all the horses participating. It is advisable to have horses checked by the Veterinary Officer on duty before the event start

9. **Foreign Nationals.** Managers/coaches of all Teams/Clubs who are arranging for foreign riders for taking part in the subject events are required to forward the details of the foreign riders and companions if any as per format enclosed as **Appendix 'B'** along with photocopy of their passport and visa, 15 days prior to start of the event, so as to obtain MI Clearance from the concerned authorities. Foreign riders whose MI Clearance is delayed for want of submission of details by the Team manager/coaches will **NOT** be allowed to enter in the Army Equestrian Centre/Army Area.

10. **Arboriculture.** No Det/Camp will spoil or cut the environment. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced. **No warning will be issued.**

11. **Responsibility.** The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the player/rider themselves.

12. **Miscellaneous.** The AEC is a facility of the Army and no defence/para military contingents, private horse owners and the APRC members/riding facility (Temp) has any right to allow him/them to take claims over this land. OIC AEC reserves the rights to remove all horses, men and material without any notice.

13. **Final Decision.** The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final on all matters connected with the REL which will be conducted from 27 Oct to 29 Oct 2022.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

16. **Category.** The REL for JNEC 2022 and Tent Pegging (Senior) for NEC 2022 events will be held in accordance with the EFI REL Rules for the events. The events will be held on the following :-

17. **Programme.** Programme for the REL is attached at **Appendix 'C'**.

18. **Entries & Entry Fee.**

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as attached at **Appendix 'D'** and should be completed in all respects and submitted to the APRC office. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any wrong entry. The fee will be as under :-

(b) **Entry Fee.**

- (i) Individual Events : Rs. 500/- per exhibit
- (ii) Post Entry : Rs. 1000/- per exhibit

(c) **Closing Date for Entries.** Entries will be closed by 25 Oct 2022. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES.

(d) **Payment.** The entry fee may paid by NEFT, cheque or by demand draft in favour of "Army Polo and Riding Centre". The Bank account details are as under :-

19. **EFI Horses Passport.**

- (a) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in the REL have to be in possession of EFI passport.
- (b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration No has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

20. **EFI Riders ID Number.**

- (a) As per latest EFI ruling all the riders participating in the REL has to be EFI ID No. The EFI ID No has to be filled in the entry form. Entries will not be accepted without EFI ID number.
- (b) NRI/OCI Card Holders. OCI Card Holders/NRI's/ Foreigners shall be given Rider ID but they cannot participate in RELs which shall be only for Indian Citizens. NRI/OCI Card Holders/Foreigners would be allowed to participate in REL as HC entry only.

21. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

- (a) **Withdrawal.** The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- (b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse/rider once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

22. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders.** As per EFI Rules.

23. **Technical Specifications of Events.** As per EFI Rules.

24. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition, veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

25. **Judging.** Decision of the ground jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

26. **Appeal.** Any appeal shall be dealt as per FEI GR 161.

27. **Use of Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

28. **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for Vet Inspection, rider should be properly dressed. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a well secured hardhat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per FEI Guidelines.

29. **Elimination/Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition/practice for rough handling, excessive brutality/abuse or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they fee justified. Rapping will be severely penalized.
