ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **General.** FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long) will be conducted from 06 Dec 2022 to 10 Dec 2022 by the Army Polo and Riding Centre at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt under the aegis of the Equestrian Federation of India as per FEI & EFI guidelines. The guidelines, protocol and SOP for the prevention of COVID-19 issued by the Govt of India (MHA), EFI and SAI will be strictly followed. The COVID-19 vaccination of individuals will be declared by respective camp owners and individuals.
2. **Camping.** Temporary stabling facility will be provided to participants for the duration of FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long) at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt. Rules and regulations for the temporary stabling facility are attached at **Appendix 'A'**.
3. **Covid-19.** In light of the Covid-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines as promulgated by EFI/Govt of India/Higher Head Quarters must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. Valid Covid-19 vaccination certificate (at least 02 doses) must be produced by all member of Team/Clubs including riders/participants and their associates.
4. **Medical Cover.** The APRC will as usual provide basic medical first aid cover for riders at the ground. The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider/player on the ground or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual to give a written undertaking (Indemnity Bond) absolving the APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations of any responsibility in this regard. Specimen of the Indemnity Bond to be given by all playing members/rider is as per **Annexure 3 of Appendix 'A'** to this Prospectus. The APRC will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the nearest hospital when necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.
5. **Insurance Cover.** It is recommended that all players/individual take insurance against any injury sustained while participating in the events or practicing at the Army Equestrian Centre. It would be ideal for the ponies as well to be covered under some insurance policy. The APRC may be informed as regard the above while signing the medical declaration. The APRC excludes all liability for any injury and/or loss occasioned to any person and/or their property within the premises of Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt.
6. **Coggin's and Glanders Test.** All rules and instructions issued by the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned.
7. **Veterinary Doctors.** The following vet doctors are available in case of an emergency.

8. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the IHQ of MoD (Army), QMG's Branch along with representative of the Animal Husbandry Commissioner for the season will have full right to examine all the horses participating. It is advisable to have horses checked by the Veterinary Officer on duty before the event start

9. All participating equines are required to be exam by veterinary officer at station of origin and issued with a certificate duly countersigned by Vet Officer stating that the horse(s)is/are free from any infectious or contagious disease. In addition to this, they must be in possession of valid negative Coggin's test certificate (validity of test – 90 days) and seronegative CFT certificate for Glanders (validity of test - 30 days), in original. However, the seronegative CFT certificate for Glanders will be valid for a particular station of participation only and will have to be obtained fresh before travelling to next station by authorized test centers as per policy in vogue. The validity of Coggin's test on arrival at the camp should preferably be such that animals return to their respective places within the validity. Test date will be calculated from the date on which the sample was collected.

10. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will also be done by a designated veterinary commission to ascertain the health status of the animals on arrival.

11. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 9 above or arriving before stipulated date will not be allowed to unload their horses in AEC premises and will not be allowed access to camp areas. No animal will be allowed to enter the camp area till veterinary and health documents are checked and found to be in order.

12. **Compliance of NADA Rules.** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

13. **Arboriculture.** No Det/Camp will spoil or cut the environment. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced. **No warning will be issued.**

14. **Responsibility.** The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the player/rider themselves.

15. **Miscellaneous.** The AEC is a facility of the Army and no defence/para military contingents, private horse owners and the APRC members/riding facility (Temp) has any right to allow him/them to take claims over this land. OIC AEC reserves the rights to remove all horses, men and material without any notice._

16. **Clearance Certificate.** All rider/unit/team/club are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Camp OIC and Show Secretary during working hours prior to departure. All accounts are required to be cleared before leaving the AEC premises. No horses will leave unless the clearance certificate is duly signed by the concerned authority.

17. **Final Decision.** The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final on all matters connected with the FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long) from 06 Dec to 10 Dec 2022.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

FEI EVENTING CCI 1* (INTRO) & CCI 2* (LONG)

06 DEC TO 10 DEC 2022 AT ARMY EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, DELHI CANTT

1. FEI Eventing CCI1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long) are being organized by Army Polo and Riding Centre at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt from 06 Dec to 10 Dec 2022 according to the FEI Eventing rules and technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue. Technical instructions

2. **Tentative Schedule** FEI Eventing CCI1* (Intro) & CCI2* (Long) is attached as Appendix 'B'

3. **Entries**

(a) All FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long) entries must be on the prescribed Entry form given in Appendix 'C' to the technical instructions and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed Entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for **FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long)** must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate) and have details of EFI horse passport number, FEI registration number & name of the horse concerned and rider's FEI I.D. and sent to Equestrian Federation of India online through registered email to efiindianf@yahoo.co.in.

(b) Entries must be sent to EFI office directly for FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* (Long).

(c) Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.

4. **Entry Fee.** All individual events – Rs 2000/- per exhibit.

5. **Closing date of entries.**

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider registration no and horse registration no issued by FEI/EFI as per the type of event.

6. Score achieved by a horse-rider combination in FEI CCI2* (L) competition shall be considered for indl/team selection for 19th Asian Games if rider request the EFI for the same as per para 4 and 30 of Selection Criteria (Version-V).

7. **Payment.** All FEI Eventing CCI 1* (Intro) & CCI 2* -(Long) entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under :

8. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer and substitutions of Entry**

(a) **Withdrawal**. The entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfers and substitutions**. A horse cannot be transferred from one rider to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders**. Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as PostEntries if made after the cutoff date of entries. Once a class has started being judged, no change in riders will be accepted.

9. **Cancellation**. The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved, those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

10. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders**. As per FEI Specifications.

11. **Technical Specifications of Events**. As per FEI Specifications.

12. **Horse passport**. All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI and FEI prior to the event.

13. **EFI's Rider Registration**. All Riders participating in the FEI Eventing CCI1* (Intro) & CCI2* (Long) should possess valid FEI ID Number. Riders not having valid/renewed/active FEI Rider ID number or putting wrong ID number will not be permitted to participate in the events.

14. **Foreign Riders**. EFI is requested to obtain MI Clearance for managers/coaches/judges /Riders who are taking part in FEI Events. Foreign officials/riders whose MI Clearance is not obtained will not be allowed to enter AEC.

15. **Show number**. All horses participating in CCI 1* (Intro) and CCI 2* (Long) will display the FEI registration number during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable preferably fitted on either side of the bridle for easy identification.

16. **Dress Code**. When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be attired in proper riding dress with boots on. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per FEI Guidelines.

17. **Rosettes**. No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.

18. **Use of whips/spurs**. As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

19. **Tack**. As per FEI rules.

20. **Reporting for each class.** All horses will report to the collecting ring stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the ground jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.
21. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.
22. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the Secretary, APRC along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
23. **Medals/Rosettes** Prize distribution ceremony will be held following all COVID norms as per Govt guidelines.
24. **Disqualification.** The ground jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality/abuse or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.
