ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **GENERAL**

Regional Equestrian League 2022 for JNEC is being organized on 24th & 25th September 2022 at the Chennai Equitation Centre, Chennai.

2. **CATEGORIES**

3. **PROGRAMME**

4. **ENTRIES**

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix 'C'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered.

(b) **Entry Fee:**

(i) Individual Entry: Rs.500/-

(ii) Post Entry: Rs.1,000/-

(c) **Closing Date for Entries:**

Entries will close 22 Sep 2022 by 6PM. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES**. No entry will be accepted without an entry fee.

(d) **Payment:**

All entries must be paid in cash or by local cheque in favour of "Chennai Equitation Centre".

5. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI**

(a) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in REL have to be in possession of the new EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

6. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI**

(a) As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without Valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

(c) All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of Renewed EFI identity number in 2022.

(d) NRI/OCI Card Holders. OCI Card Holders/NRI's/ Foreigners shall be given Rider ID but they cannot participate in RELs and NEC which shall be only for Indian Citizens. NRI/OCI Card Holders/Foreigners would be allowed to participate in REL/NEC as HC entry only.

7. **WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTIONS OF ENTRY**

(a) **Withdrawal:**

The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions:**

A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders:**

Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

8. **SHOW NUMBER**

All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

9. **ROSETTES**

No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

10. **ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION**

The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised. Please refer relevant EFI and FEI rules.

11. **WHIPS/SPURS**

As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline

12. **DRESS CODE**

When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.

13. **APPEAL**

Any appeal shall be dealt as per FEI GR 161.

14. **MEDICAL COVER**

The Club will as usual provide medical cover for riders at the venue. The club shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving the club of any responsibility in this regard. The Club will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.

15. **INSURANCE**

The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Chennai and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.

16. **RESPONSIBILITY**

The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

17. **CAMP: CAMPING AND ACCOMODATION**

(a) The camp opens on 20 Sep 2022 and camp closes on 26 Sep 2022.

(b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.

(c) The Organisers will try to arrange for Bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.

(d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements before the 17 Sep 2022, after which no stable orders can be accepted.

(e) Stable Charge. (a) If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

(b) If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

(c) The OC will ensure at all times the safety and security of the camp to avoid any mishap.

(f) All teams must inform the organisers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 17 Sep 2022, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government as per Annx I.

(g) All teams must inform the organisers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(h) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited

18. **COGGIN'S AND GLANDERS TESTS**

All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT or Mallein) certificate on arrival in Chennai. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

19. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.

20. **VETERINARY COMMISSION**

The Veterinary Commission detailed by CEC/EFI will have full right to examine all the horses participating

21. All outstation attendees will need to mandatorily submit Negative Covid Test report dated not older than 2 days prior to their arrival at CEC.
