ADMINISTRATIVE & TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. GENERAL

National Equestrian Championship Show Jumping for 2021-22 will be organized from 29 Jan to 05 Feb 2022 at the Amateur Riders Club, Mumbai according to the FEI rules and Technical guidelines-2021 of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue.

2. PROGRAMME

Schedule of Events - Attached at **Appendix 'A'**

3. ENTRIES

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix 'B'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered. It is the responsibility of the OC to accept entries as per grading list of EFI.

(b) **Entry Fee:**

(i) Normal Entry: Indl - Rs.500/- , Team Event – 1000/-

(ii) Post Entry : Indl - Rs. 1,000/- , Team Event - 2000/-

(c) **Closing Date for Entries:**

Entries will close **27 Jan 2022 by 12 noon**. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES and will be accepted two hours before vet inspection**. No entry will be accepted without an entry fee and after vet inspection.

(d) Foreign Nationals & OCI card holders cannot participate in the NEC Show Jumping. It is the responsibility of OC to ensure this aspect by obtaining a photocopy of Indian Passport from all athletes alongwith entry form.

(d) **Payment:** All entries must be paid in cash or by local cheque in favour of **"Amateur Rider Club Mumbai"** or by Bank transfer to the below account:-

4. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI**

(a) As per EFI rulings, all horses participating in the EFI approved events, have to be in possession of the new EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

5. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI**

(a) As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without Valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

(c) All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of Renewed EFI identity number in 2021

6. **Eligibility of Horses.** Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades. All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. A hard copy of the current grading list will be available at the Show office and displayed on their notice board. **Riders are liable to be disqualified or penalized for incorrect entry of the horses, as per EFI regulations.**

7. **WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTIONS OF ENTRY**

(a) **Withdrawal:**

The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions:**

A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders:**

Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

8. **SHOW NUMBER**

All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

9. **ROSETTES**

No rosettes will be worn by a horse during judging.

10. **ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION**

The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised. Please refer relevant EFI and FEI rules.

11. **WHIPS/SPURS**

As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline

12. **DRESS CODE**

When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. **Service personnel will be in uniform.** It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three-point retention harness including riders in uniform.

13. **Protest**

Appeal can be lodged by competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the Show Secretary, Amateur Riders Club, Mumbai along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

14. **MEDICAL COVER**

The Club will as usual provide medical cover for riders at the venue. The club shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving the club of any responsibility in this regard. The Club will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.

15. **INSURANCE**

The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore and during the events. The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.

16. **RESPONSIBILITY**

The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

17. **CAMP: CAMPING AND ACCOMODATION**

(a) The camp opens on 20 Jan 2022 and closes on 06 February, 2022.

- (b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tent age for stabling and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
- (c) The Organizers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- (d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements on or before 15 Jan 2022 after which no stable orders will be accepted.
- (e) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-
 - (i) If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will build their own temporary shed, charges levied will be Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.
 - OR
 - (ii) If the OC provides a temporary stable constructed by them, the charges levied will be Rs 2500/- per horse for the entire duration of the stay.
- (f) The OC will ensure at all times the safety and security of the camp to avoid any mishap.
- (g) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by the 15 Jan, 2022, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.
- (h) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.
- (i) All Army and Government units will be provided space to set up their own camps. All tent age and other stabling material to be brought by them.
- (j) The organizer will provide one bulb and electrical connection for a fan. Fans to be brought by participants. Option to buy fans are given in contacts list in the end.
- (k) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put in to the pits provided.
- (l) No open fires are permitted on Amateur Riders' Club Riding School grounds.

18. **COGGIN'S AND GLANDERS TESTS**

All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status certificate on arrival to Mumbai. Coggin's and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory. The above is as per the requirements of EFI.

Protocol for bringing horses to Amateur Riders' Club / RWITC premises.

Every horse should be accompanied by the following valid Veterinary Documents:-

- (a) Identification Certificate or Passport alongwith vaccination record.
- (b) Glanders & EIA (Coggins) Blood Test Report, (Glanders validity 30 days, EIA validity 120 days).
- (c) Every horse must be duly vaccinated with the Calvanza 03 vaccine. For horses who are being vaccinated for the 1st time, 3 doses with a gap of 21 days between each dose is required. Horses already vaccinated will require an annual booster dose.
- (d) Proof of Pneumobort – K Vaccination (only for horses coming from within Maharashtra itself)
- (e) Health Certificate of the horse (Authorized Vets for Certifying: State Veterinary Officer active, Army Veterinary Office active, Panel Vet (RWITC) Registered).
- (f) Declaration Letter from the owner (on his letterhead) stating where the horse was stabled in the last 60 days before proposed entry into ARC / Mahalaxmi Race Course, Mumbai.

The Veterinary documents should reach the ARC office at least 72 hours in advance to enable us to approve the same.

All the Veterinary Documents described above should be available with the horses during unloading at the Race Course.

Participants are advised not to bring horses having nasal discharge or cough (cattar in hindi) or with lower jaw lymph node swelling, while beginning the journey. Such horses will not be allowed to enter the race course.

On arrival all horses will be physically inspected for any infectious or contagious diseases by the Clubs Vet.

Horses which do not comply with the above medical protocol will not be allowed to enter the club / Mahalaxmi Race Course, Mumbai.

19. **VETERINARY COMMISSION.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.

20. **ANTI DOPING.** The organiser will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders/Athletes who need to use a prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition, a **Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate** (TUEC) will be obtained from the Doctor prior to taking any medicine.

21. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. **Strict adherence to MHA guidelines as renewed from time to time will be followed.** The guidelines for resuming equestrian trg and competition activities in a COVID-19 envt issued by the EFI will be followed strictly.

22. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
