ADM INSTRS FOR NEC DRESSAGE 2021-22 FROM 20 FEB TO 27 FEB 2022 AT RVC CENTRE AND COLLEGE, MEERUT CANTT

GENERAL

1. NEC Dressage will be held from 20 Feb to 27 Feb 2022 at RVC Centre and College, Meerut Cantt under the aegis of EFI. The event will be held with all necessary precautions against COVID-19 as per protocol issued by MHA/EFI/other local adm of Govt of India.

INTIMATION FOR PARTICIPATION

2. All teams desirous to participate in the said event will intimate the Show Secretary about the total str of contingent and ETA in terms of participants, adm staff, syces, grooms and horses positively by 12 Feb 2022 well in advance as per format attached as appx 'A' to Adm Instruction for necessary administrative arrangements.

CAMP ARRANGEMENTS

3. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating in said competition will stay in the camp which will be located near **Sofipur Ranges**. The camp will be functional with effect from **16 Feb 2022 (FN) to 29 Feb 2022 (AN)**. All teams/contingents/club/indl participants to ensure that they do not report to the Camp before **16 Feb 2022** and also make suitable arrangements for the return journey well in time since the camp facilities will not be available after **29 Feb 2022**. Following documents should be submitted on arrival for considering the camping facility :-

- (a) Police verification of all civilians (grooms and supervisory staff).
- (b) Two passport size photographs of civil employees.
- (c) Passport of horses (issued by EFI).
- (d) Coggin's and CFT negative certificate.
- (e) Indemnity Bond.
- (f) Details of horses.
- (g) COVID certificates as brought out in succeeding paras.

4. The OIC, Camp will earmark site for each contingent/team/club/indl. The rep of the contingent/team/club/indl will take over the allotted site from the OIC, Camp on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition. Any damage to Camp site, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the OIC of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all respects for camping arrangements in respect of their personnel and animals. There will be no charge for camping facility.

5. **SECURITY DEPOSIT**. All contingent/team/club/indl will pay a refundable security deposit as given below prior to setting up their camps. At the time of vacation of their camp, the OIC Camp will inspect the respective area and if no discrepancy is found, the full amount will be returned to respective camp contingents/ civil camp :-

- (a) Defence/Para Military/CAPFs/State Police - Rs 5000/- per camp.
- (b) Civilian - Rs 10000/- per camp.

ACCOMMODATION

6. **SERVICES TEAM.** JCOs, OR and support staff will be accommodated in camp area. Officers participants should make their own arrangement for stay.

7. **CIVILIANS CLUBS/TEAMS.** Civilian participants or their associates are requested to make their own arrangements for accommodation. Camping site near the stabling area of civilian horses will be earmarked only for accommodating civilian grooms and support staff. The rider/unit/team/club should be self-contained with respect to logistics and administrative requirements for camping of their personnel. 8. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. **Strict adherence to MHA guidelines as renewed from time to time will be followed.** The guidelines for resuming equestrian trg and competition activities in a COVID-19 envt issued by the EFI will be followed strictly. Certain points specific to the event are highlight as under:-

(a) **Protocol to the followed on arrival.** Riders and staff will be screened before being allowed access to camp. Any person exhibiting any of the symptoms like Cough, Sore throat, fever & shortness of breath, will not be allowed to enter the premises. No facility of quarantine for visiting team will be provided/available. Fwg documents to be produced at time of reporting :-

(i) Medical Fitness cert attached as Appx '**B**'

(ii) Valid Covid Vaccination Cert (two doses).

(iii) Personal Travel Declaration Form (if had a foreign travel during last 14 days) attached as Appx '**C**'.

(b) **Protocol to the followed during stay for the event.**

(i) Use of masks would be compulsory. However, riders while on horseback can take their masks off.

(ii) Social distancing to be strictly adhered at all times.

(iii) All riders/support staff unwell with any of the symptoms i.e. Cough, Sore throat, fever & shortness of breath, must report to respective team commander/captain who will further report to Camp I/C.

(iv) All individuals are to strictly avoid intermingling with the staff during the event.

(v) Covid-19 daily self assessment screening questionnaire attached as Appx '**D**' to be handed over to camp NCO daily.

PRACTICE AND EXERCISE AREA

9. Suitable arenas will be earmarked for exercise & practice by riders participating in the competition. Practice and exercise arenas will also be provided at the venue for training of the horses prior to the commencement of the event.

LIGHTING

10. Power supply shall be provided under camp arrangements. However all contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane/lanterns/petromax/gen sets etc for emergency use. Centralized distribution box will be provided from where Camps can take their connection under own arrangement. Proper cables should be used for taking connections and all joints to be properly taped/ concealed. Each camp should have a central input board fitted with an MCB from where supply can be further extended with the help of sockets/plugs for end use. Under no circumstance, the electric cables/connection will be taken inside the stables. The electric cables will also not be laid underground since wet/ waterlogged ground can lead to electric shock. Electric cables and fittings also should not be supported on Iron poles. Unauthorised tapping of electricity is strictly prohibited. Responsibility of incidence, if any, of electric shock or fire due to short circuiting will solely be of IC contingent.

RATION FOR ANIMALS

11. (a) **Army Horses.** Ration for army animals will be drawn from 40 Coy ASC (Sup) Type 'D', Meerut. Sufficient packing/stocking materials for storage of ration including drinking water should be brought by the contingents both for horses and men. Contingents will submit their indents for drawing rations to 40 Coy ASC (Sup) Type 'D' Meerut, directly after publishing their station order from Stn HQ Cell, Meerut Cantt for attachment with 40 Coy ASC (Sup) Type 'D'.

(b) **Civil Horses.** All civil contingents are to be self-sustained in respect of ration for their horses and administrative/logistic arrangements.

LINE GEAR FOR ANIMALS.

12. Contingents should bring adequate line gear and picketing gear. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

PITCHING OF TENTS

13. Contingents will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp. It will be ensured that min of five mtr distance is kept between each team/contingent/club.

FAMILIES

14. No families will be accommodated in the camp. Any support staff coming along with their family have to look for their own accommodation/lodging outside the camping area.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS

15. Contingents will come with their own fire fighting equipments and ensure fire preventive measures of their respective areas. The Camp I/C however, will detail fire fighting/piquet parties from amongst the participating contingents, if required. No one will be permitted to light fires or smoke within the stabling area. Cooking on firewood or over conventional heaters will not be permitted. All contingents will be self sufficient with the following :-

(a) Hand held Fire Extinguisher (9kg) - Two

SANITATION AND HYGIENE

16. Measures to ensure proper sanitation and hygiene in camp area as well as on the venue of competition will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animal's litter by tight packing. Separate area will be earmarked for dumping of hay and litter. The contingent commander will ensure dumping at the earmarked area. No hay/litter will be disposed near stabling/camping area. All necessary anti-covid precautions will be adhered too.

DISCIPLINE

17. All participants, grooms and support staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp I/C for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is always maintained. They will strictly adhere to rule and regulations for the camping facility. Any violations of rules would render the concerned contingent liable to be asked to vacate the camp premises forthwith. Following will be strictly adhered:-

- (a) No liquor will be permitted within camping area. Intoxication, assault or affray will be viewed seriously and will result in the individuals being expelled immediate and inturn vacation of the respective camp with immediate notice.
- (b) Partying/ Social gathering inside the camp area is strictly prohibited.
- (c) Mov of horse from camp arena to the competition venue will be through designated route only.
- (d) The entry to camp will be closed by 2000h. No entry or exit to the camp will be permitted after the closer time.
- (e) No veh will be allowed entry into the camp area. Same to be parked outside the entry gate to ensure safety of horses.

PERS TPT/VEH/PETS

18. It is advisable that no team/participant/supporting staff to bring pets into the camp area or venue of the event. If unavoidable, same should be intimated to the organizing committee well in advance. However, **in no circumstances, pets will be brought into competition area/venue.**

SECURITY

19. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingents during their stay in the camp. All army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during their stay in Meerut. Local/station orders on the subject shall be strictly complied with.

20. Details of personal transport should also be intimated prior to arrival from security point of view. Entry and exit of vehicles in the camping area will only be through main gate. All vehicle will stop at the main gate for checking and verification.

RESPONSIBILITY

21. The organizing committee/EFI accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.

VETERINARY/MEDICAL COVER

22. Veterinary cover to animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Commanding Officer, 32 Military Veterinary Hospital, Meerut Cantt, who will establish a veterinary aid post in the camp. Medical cover for 'personals' will be provided under the arrangements of Military Hospital, Meerut.

VET HEALTH PROTOCOLS, COGGIN'S AND CFT TESTS

23. All **participating equines** are required to be **exam by veterinary offr** at station of origin and issued with a **certificate duly countersigned by Vet Offr stating that the horse(s) is/are free from any infectious or contagious disease**. In addition to this, they must be in possession of **valid negative Coggin's test certificate (validity of test – 90 days) and seronegative CFT certificate for Glanders (validity of test - 30 days), in original**. However the seronegative CFT certificate for Glanders will be valid for a **particular stn of participation only and will have to be obtained fresh before travelling to next station by authorized test centres as per policy in vogue**. The **validity of Coggin's test** on arrival at the camp should preferably be such that animals return to their respective places within the validity. Test **date will be** calculated from **the date on which the sample was collected**.

24. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will also be done by a designated veterinary commission to ascertain the health status of the animals on arrival.

25. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 23 above or arriving before stipulated date i.e **16 Feb 2022** will not be allowed to unload their horses in RVC Centre and College premises and will not be allowed access to camp / training areas. **No animal will be allowed to enter the camp area till veterinary and health documents are checked and found to be in order.**

ARBORICULTURE

26. No member of the visiting team/club participants will damage or cut trees/plants or cause damage to the environment/nature during their stay for the competition. No horse will be tied to trees nor support of trees will be taken for construction of camp. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced on report of such incidence.

COMPLIANCE OF NADA RULES

27. As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

TRANSPORTATION FOR ARMY TEAM/CONTINGENTS

28. Contingents are advised to be self contained for transport including conveyance of animals and stores from respective unit location to Meerut and back. **If CHT are reqd for return journey, requisite CHT indents will be placed as per standard format duly signed by Offr I/C of the unit/contingent concerned** and fwd through the Camp office to HQ PUPSA (Q) for allotment of CHT. RVC Centre & College will not initiate CHT indents for outstation teams.

CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE

29. All rider/unit/team/club are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the show office before departure. All outstanding dues to be cleared well in time.

FINAL DECISION

30. The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final on all administrative issues connected with the National Equestrian Championship Dressage 2021-22.

TECH INSTRS FOR NEC DRESSAGE 2021-22 FROM 20 FEB TO 27 FEB 2022 AT RVC CENTRE AND COLLEGE, MEERUT CANTT

1. NEC Dressage is being org at RVC Centre and College, Meerut Cantt wef 20 Feb to 27 Feb 2022. The competitions will be conducted as per FEI Rules/EFI Technical Guidelines 2021. Various class of competition that are to be conducted during the event are as follows :-

- (a) Intermediate-1.
- (b) Prix St. George.
- (c) Advance test.
- (d) Advance Medium test.
- (e) Medium test.
- (f) Elementary.
- (g) Preliminary.

2 **Tentative Schedule.** Attached as Appx 'A'

3. **Entry Fee.** Entry fee for various events will be as under :-

- (a) All team events – Rs 1000 /- per team.
- (b) All individual events – Rs 500/- per exhibit.

4. **Closing time/date of entries** Entries for **NEC DRESSAGE** will be accepted upto 1700h on **17 Feb 2022**. Entries after due time/date shall be considered as late/post entries and **will be accepted two hours before vet inspection**. Post entries will be charged as under:-

- (a) All team events – Rs 2000 /- per team.
- (b) All individual events – Rs 1000/- per exhibit.

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider regn no and horse passport no issued by EFI.

5. **Entries.** All entries will be on the prescribed specimen proforma att as Appx 'B' & 'C', for events and sent to Show Secretary, Organizing Committee, NEC Dressage, RVC Centre and College, Meerut Cantt PIN-900468 by post or online through registered email id **rvc.equestrian@gmail.com**. **Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.**

6. Foreign Nationals & OCI card holders cannot participate in the NEC Dressage. It is the responsibility of OC to ensure this aspect by obtaining a photocopy of Indian Passport from all athletes alongwith entry form. .

7. **Payment**

- (a) All entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under :

- (b) However, the entry fee can also be paid in cash or by demand draft/cheque in favor of **Commandant, RVC Centre and College, Meerut Cantt.**

8. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer and substitutions of Entry**

- (a) **Withdrawal**. The entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

- (b) **Transfers and substitutions**. A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another for any reason, whatsoever.

- (c) **Change of Riders**. Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as **Post Entries**. Once a class has started being judged, no change in riders will be accepted.

9. **Cancellation**. The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved, those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

10. **Eligibility of Horses**. Riders are responsible for correct entry of his/her horse in relevant grades. All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. A hard copy of the current grading list will be available in the camp office and displayed on the notice board of show office. **Riders are liable to be disqualified or penalized for incorrect entry of the horses, as per EFI regulations.**

11. **Technical Specifications**. The events will follow the latest technical guidelines of EFI and FEI Rules as per the relevant discipline. EFI reserves the right to amend technical specifications for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions and local merits/ demerits based on the request of event official and OC.

12. **Horse passport**. All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. **No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI.**

13. **EFI's Rider Registration**. All Riders participating in the NEC DRESSAGE 2021-22 should possess valid EFI ID Number. Riders not having valid/renewed/active EFI Rider ID number or putting wrong ID number will not be permitted to participate in the events.

14. **Show number.** All horses will display the EFI Regn number during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable preferably fitted on either side of the bridle for easy identification.
15. **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be attired in proper riding dress with boots on. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per FEI Guidelines.
16. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.
17. **Use of whips/spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
18. **Tack.** As per FEI rules.
19. **Reporting for each class.** All horses will report to the collecting ring stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the ground jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.
20. **Judging.** Decision of the ground jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.
21. **Objections.** Objection can be lodged by competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF in Indian currency should be deposited with the Show Secretary, Organizing Committee, NEC Dressage, RVC Centre & College, Meerut along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
22. **INSURANCE**
- The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore and during the events. The Organising Committee/EFI will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team.
23. **Disqualification.** The ground jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality/abuse or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.
24. The Show office will be open for all participants/team members from 0900 hrs to 1300 hrs and again from 1530 hrs to 1800 hrs.
25. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
