NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP PRELIMINARY SHOW JUMPING
AND
JUNIOR NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP - 2022

1. **General- National Equestrian Championship Preliminary Show Jumping and Junior National Equestrian Championship-2022** will be held with effective from 12 Dec to 25 Dec 2022 at the National Equestrian Academy, Bisankheri, Bhopal, Under the again technical guidelines & rules/regulations of the equestrian federation of India. All participants are advised to go through the EFI technical guidelines, rules, regulations and specification, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.
2. **Events-** Refer Appendix 'A'.
3. **Tentative Programme** – Refer Appendix 'B'.
4. **Eligibility of Riders for JNEC Events**. Age Categories and eligibility of Riders as per EFI/FEI rules are as under-

(a)	Young Rider	16 to 21 Years	Born between 1 st Jan 2001 and 31 st Dec 2006
(b)	Junior Rider	14 to 18 Years	Born between 1 st Jan 2004 and 31 st Dec 2008
(c)	Children Group 1	12 to 14 Years	Born between 1 st Jan 2008 and 31 st Dec 2010
(d)	Children Group 2	10 to 12 Years	Born between 1 st Jan 2010 and 31 st Dec 2012

Note Age of the rider would be calculated as on 01 January of a particular year irrespective of the month of birth of the rider and the age which would be valid up to 31 Dec of that particular year . It will be compulsory to submit the birth certificate and EFI registration number of rider & horse along with entry form. Please also refer Article 502 JNEC TG 2021.

5. **Entries.**

(a) All entries must be of the prescribed Entry Form given in Appendix 'C' and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for Young Riders, Juniors, and children 1&2 category riders must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate). All entries must the EFI horse passport number description, EFI registration number & name of the horse concerned & Rider's EFI I.D. **For Rider's participating on two horses in Young Rider and Junior Category Dressage competitions to comply with Note (a, b, c & d) mentioned under the list of qualified riders JNC 2022 on EFI website.**

(b) **Foreign Riders** – Managers/coaches of all teams/clubs/school who are arranging for foreign nationals as coaches/staffs for the Junior National Equestrian Championship 2022 are required to forward the details of the foreigners as per format enclosed as Appendix 'D' along with photocopy of their passport and visa, 30 days prior to start of the competition to the club, so as to obtain MI Clearance from the concerned authorities. Foreigners whose MI Clearance is delayed for want of submission of details by the team manager/coaches will not be allowed to enter in the NEA. Only Indian passport holders are allotted to participate in JNEC & NEC Prelim Show Jumping.

(c) Entries must be sent to the Show office, NEA, Bisankheri, Bhopal. To facilitate processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to mpseabhopal12@gmail.com

(d) **Entry Fee**- The entry fee will be as under:-

- (i) Team Events – Rs 1000/- per team.
- (ii) Individual Events- Rs 500/- per entry.

(e) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.

(g) **Closing Date for Entries** – Entries will close by 12:00 hours on 09 Dec 2022. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES. However, post entries will be accepted up to two hour before the vet inspection of each event. No entries will be accepted thereafter. Post entry fee will be:-

- (i) Team Events: Rs. 2,000/- per team.
- (iii) Individual Events Rs.1000/- per exhibit.

(h) **Payment**. All entries must be paid in online or DD in favor of KHILADI PRASHIKSAKA KALYAN EQUESTRIAN BHOPAL A/C NO- 922020029458243 IFSC CODE - UTIB0001515, MICR CODE - 462211007, Madhya Pradesh (Payble at Bhopal) cash amount is not expected.

(i) **Entries Instructions**. For Young Rider, Junior, Children – I & Children – II Dressage and Show Jumping events, only the riders/athletes who qualified through REL will be allowed to enter/participate in the respective categories in Individual, Team & side events of JNEC 2022 (Para 9 of REL Guidelines 2022 refers). No HC entry are allowed for JNEC and NEC Prelim Show Jumping.

(j) Foreign Nationals & OCI card holders cannot participate in the NEC Prelim Show Jumping and JNEC. It is the responsibility of OC to ensure this aspect by obtaining a copy of Indian Passport from all athletes alongwith entry form participating in NEC Prelim Show Jumping and JNEC.

6. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI.**

(a) As per EFI rulings all horses participating in JNEC/NEC must be in possession of the EFI passport.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are registered before giving entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without renewed EFI registration number.

7. **PARTICIPATION OF HORSES IN EQUESTRIAN EVENTS** A horse should not be allowed to participate in more than three rounds of events in a day. One horse can participate only once in each category (Children I, Children II, Junior & Young Rider) of discipline (Dressage, Show Jumping & Eventing). Maximum participation of a horse in a day will be as under:-

Children Category

- (i) Two normal Jumping rounds and one side event

OR

- (ii) Two Dressage Competition and a side event of Jumping

OR

- (iii) Two rounds of jumping normal and one Dressage competition

Junior/ Young /Senior Category

- (i) Not more than two rounds of events (Dressage or Show Jumping).

8. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI.** As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI. Entries will not be accepted without valid/renewed/active EFI registration Number.

9. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal**- The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions** – A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders** – Riders cannot be changed unless the jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

(d) All changes will be treated as post entries.

10. **Cancellation.** The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved, those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

11. The class will start once the draw of lots for the order of start has been held.

12. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI registration number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out from the stable.

13. **Rosette**- No rosette will be worn by a horse during judging.

14. **Elimination/Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animal. Rapping will be severely penalized.

15. **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI rules on the subject.
16. **Dress Code.** When inspection the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly colored plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness.
17. **RULES.** Technical Guidelines-2021 of the Equestrian Federation of India and the relevant rules of FEI will be followed for the conduct of the events of the competition.
18. **JUDGING.** The decision of the judges will be final.
19. **ProtestAppeal.** Protest can be lodged by competitors in terms of FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the Show Secretary, National Equestrian Academy, Bhopal along with the protest. Money will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
20. **Medical Cover.** OC will provide medical cover for riders at the venue. OC not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences hospital where necessary, through every possible means available. Each rider participating in the Junior National Equestrian Championship-2022, National Equestrian Championship Preliminary Show Jumping 2022 will fill the indemnity Bond attached at **Appendix E** and submit the same along with entry form.
21. **Insurance.** The Organizer recommends that clubs/associations/schools to take Insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bhopal during the events. The Organizer will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fail of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.
22. **Responsibility.** The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Organizer nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any aid or other medical treatment provided.
23. **Reporting for Each Class.** All horses will report to the collecting ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take appropriate action as per existing rules.
24. All events scheduled in the afternoon will continue under lights, when required.
25. **Accommodation.** All Participants are required to make arrangement for their accommodation. In Case any assistance is required you may contact show secretary NEA, Bishankheri, Bhopal.
26. **Abuse/ cruelty to horses.** As per relevant rules of EFI/FEI.
27. **Camp: Camping And accommodation .** The MPSEA has permitted stabling of horses for all participants in NEA Bhopal for the duration of the event. Permission to stable horses during the above period is subject to certain conditions to this prospectus. Security aspects as mentioned in

to civilian employees of all contingents including Club members entering the NEA Bhopal for temporary stabling will be strictly adhered to. No civilian employee of any contingent will be allowed to enter NEA, Bhopal without civil police verification. Camp will open on 08 Dec 2022.

- (a) The camp will open on 08th December 2022 and closes on 26 Dec 2022.
- (b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
- (c) The Organizers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- (d) All teams that require stables must send their requirements on or before 30th Nov 2022 after which no stable orders will be accepted.
- (e) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse for the duration the event .

- (f) The OC will ensure at all times the safety and security of the camp to avoid any mishap.
- (g) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by the 30th November 2022, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.
- (h) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.
- (j) All Army and Government units will be provided space to set up their own camps. All tent age and other stabling material to be brought by them.
- (k) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.
- (l) No open fires are permitted on Amateur Riders' Club Riding School grounds.
- (m) The Camp In charge will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp In charge on arrival & handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the contingent. The teams should come self contained in all respects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals. All teams will intimate the total strength of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 30 Nov 2022 and intimate Extended Time of Arrival well in advance NEA to org Administrative Arrangements.

28. **Self Containment.** All teams coming to participate in the Junior National Equestrian Championship-2022, NEC Preliminary Show jumping 2022 must be self-contained in terms of tentage, equipment for camping, cooks, rations and transport in order to be prepared for any unforeseen emergency.
29. **Ration/Fodder-** Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/ fodder to sustain their horses during their Stay in Bhopal or, they can ask for attachment both the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations.
30. **Fire Fighting Arrangement –** All contingents are requested to carry adequate fire fighting equipment.
31. **Coggin and Glander Test.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI, NRC, ICAR Hissar and RVC Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander Status (CFT) certificate on arrival to Bhopal. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory. The above is as per the requirements of EFI.
32. **Ground Jury, Veterinary / Technical delegate, Appeal Committee and insurance-** These are as per Equestrian Federation of India under governing competitions.
33. **Spectators.** The Spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the judges. The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help. Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena. The Judges decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the judges.
34. **Prize Distribution.** Tentatively prizes will be distributed as per Appx 'B'.
35. **Trotting Parade.** All participants are requested to present their horses for veterinary inspection as per Appx B.
36. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
37. **Veterinary Assistance.** The following is available for vet assistance in case of an emergency:-

38. **Clearance Certificate –** All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the NEA Show Office during working hours. All accounts concerned needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless they obtain the clearance certificate.
39. **Anti Doping.** The organizer will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders / Athletes who need to use

prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition a **Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate (TUEC)** will be obtained from the doctor prior to taking any medicine.

40. **Compliance of NADA Rules and EFI Equine Anti- doping and Controlled medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per rules in vogue each participant (Both human and Equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In View of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for doping testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same . Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

41. **COVID 19 Protocol.** In light of the Covid 19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. Strict adherence to MHA/MP state guidelines as renewed from time to time will be followed. The guidelines for resuming equestrian trg and competition activities in a covid 19 environment issued by the EFI will be followed strictly.
