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General.

1. REL for JNEC 2022 will be held at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur wef 22 Aug to 23 Aug 2022. Details of the events including specifications are as per attached technical instructions.
2. The competition will be conducted as per FEI and EFI guidelines.

Camp Arrangement.

3. Horses and support staff accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located in Polo Lines, 61 Cavalry. The camp will be functional wef 20 Aug 2022. Contingents will ensure that they do not reach the camp before 20 Aug 2022.
4. Camp OIC will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp OIC on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the rep of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all aspects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals and remain confined to their camps and maintain social distancing from the other teams. The teams should also be well prepared to make electrical connections in their respective camps, any assistance required in this regard should be intimated to Camp OIC by 15 Aug 2022.
5. All teams will intimate the total strength of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 12 Aug 2022 and intimate the ETA well in advance through E-mail. Format att as **Appx 'A'** to Prospectus duly filled and signed must reach the Camp OIC by 12 Aug 2022.
6. Civilians staying in the camping area will be allowed to stay only after producing 02 x passport size photographs along with a government issued Identity Proof for the issue of security passes to them. Also the team members will not visit any other area inside the Military Station other than the camping area and the training and competition venue.
7. The camp will be established by the teams in adherence to the SOP for stabling being followed by the organizing unit, in case any violation of the same the defaulting contingent/team will be asked to vacate the area within 24 hours.
8. All civ/pvt horses would be levied with a fixed amount of Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

Accommodation.

9. All participants are required to make arrangement for their accn. In case any assistance is required you may contact Mess Secy, 61 Cav.

COVID-19.

10. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. **Strict adherence to MHA guidelines as renewed from time to time will be followed.** The guidelines for resuming equestrian trg and competition activities in a COVID-19 envt issued by the EFI will be followed strictly.

11. The Army teams staying in the Camping Area will be allowed only after producing a cert (**Appx 'B'**) signed by med auth & countersigned by Adjt of respective unit, also the Personal Travel Declaration Form (**Appx 'C'**) and COVID-19 Daily Self-Assessment Screening Questionnaire (**Appx 'D'**) to Prospectus to be produced without fail. A COVID-19 Compliance Register (**Appx 'E'**) for all personnel and for personnel above 60 yrs of age (**Appx 'F'**) will be updated by the org and fwd to EFI on daily basis.

12. **Entry/ Exit.** For smooth conduct of event and to follow COVID-19 protocol list of all players, support staff require access inside camp and trg area to be provided by respective team not later than their arrival at 61 Cavalry.

13. Only participants, staff and coach will be allowed to enter the 61 Cavalry premises. No guests/spectators will be allowed.

14. Riders and staff will be screened before being allowed access to 61 CAV grounds.

15. Social distancing to be strictly adhered to.

16. Use of masks would be compulsory. However riders while on horseback can take their masks off.

17. Any person exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to enter the premises.

18. Riders/support staff to exit the premises as soon as event finishes.

19. All riders/support staff must be made aware not to attend if they are unwell with any of the symptoms i.e Cough, Soar throat, fever & shortness of breath.

20. All members of the team to carry the fwg :-

(a) Medical Fitness cert signed by AMA.

(b) COVID vaccination cert.

21. Fwg Drill to be followed at time of reporting :-

- (a) Temperature will be checked.
- (b) Indl will be screened for any symptoms.
- (c) Entry will be made in register.
- (d) All indls to strictly avoid intermingling with the staff from 61 Cav i.e they are to be self sustained in r/o accommodation, ration, waste disposal etc.
- (e) Once inside all indl will be under adm auth of 61 Cav and any movement outside will be after approval of Camp OIC.

22. **Protocol to be followed during and after the event.**

- (a) Social distancing is to be maintained with mandatory use of mask and hand sanitizer.
- (b) Teams not to leave their respective enclave.
- (c) No social gathering is allowed.

Practice and Exercise Area.

23. A suitable area will be earmarked close to the camp for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise area will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the events. Staggered timings will be allotted to use the practice/exercise areas to ensure minimum contact.

Lighting.

24. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/patronages/gen sets for emergency use. However light/power shall be provided under camp arrangements where feasible. Contingent should be self sufficient in terms of all electrical and light equipment. Necessary support will be provided by Camp OIC. Any electrical accidents to horses/men will be responsibility of respective owners.

Ration for Army Animals.

25. Rations for animals for all participating Army horses will be drawn from 303 ASC Coy Supply Depot, Type 'A', Jaipur. Sufficient packing materials for storage of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingent for horses and men. Contingent will submit their indent for drawing of ration to 303 Coy ASC Sup Depot Type 'A', Jaipur directly after publishing their Station Order from 61 Sub Area, Jaipur for attachment with 303 Coy ASC Sup Depot Type 'A', Jaipur.

26. Private horses of army personnel should come fully equipped with stabling facilities, fodder and grain etc.

Transport.

27. Contingents are advised to be self contained for transport.

Line Gear for Animals.

28. Contingents will bring adequate line gear and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Safaiwala.

29. The contingents will bring their own safaiwalas for cleaning of respective camp site.

Pitching of Tents.

30. Contingent will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

31. No families will be accommodated in the camp.

Fire Precautions.

32. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precaution of their respective areas. The Camp OIC however, will detail fire fighting/picket parties from amongst the participants of the contingent if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

33. Proper sanitation and hygiene measures will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precaution will be taken by all concerned.

Discipline.

34. All participants' grooms and administrative staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp OIC for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

Security.

35. All contingent will ensure highest level of security of their contingent during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Jaipur. Local/station order on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All civilian will be in possession of valid police verification. No unauthorized movement of the personnel staying in the camp will be undertaken without the permission of Camp OIC. Movement of all personnel will be registered at the camp reception.

Veterinary/Medical Cover.

36. Veterinary cover to army animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 40 Mil Vet Hospital, Jaipur who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp. Medical cover will be provided by the Military Hospital, Jaipur.

Coggin's Test for Equine Infectious Anemia & CFT for Glanders.

37. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival at Jaipur as per policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have CFT negative cert and certificate stating the horse is free from any infectious or contagious disease, duly signed by the Veterinary Doctor from the station the horses are coming from, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and CFT negative certificate, **with minimum validity of 15 days on the day of arrival and exit** and the Vet Certificate will be produced to the Camp OIC, failing which the horse will not be allowed inside the camp.

Registration of Horses.

38. Only horses registered with the EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI Registration No of horses. Riders/team captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd no of horses which have not yet been registered. All horses to in possession of EFI passport.

Clearance Certificate.

39. All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Camp OIC and Show Secretary during working hours prior to their departure. All accounts concerned are reqd to be cleared before leaving the camp premises. No horses will leave unless the clearance certificate is duly signed by the concerned authority.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTION

REL FOR JNEC 2022 AT 61 CAVALRY, JAIPUR **FROM 22 AUG TO 23 AUG 2022**

1. REL for JNEC 2022 will be conducted by 61 Cavalry, Jaipur wef 22 Aug to 23 Aug 2022 according to the REL Guidelines, Technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue and relevant rule of FEI. Tentative Pgme is as per **Appx 'A'** to Technical Instruction.

2. **Entries.**

(a) All entries must be on the prescribed Entry form given in **Appendix 'B'** to Technical Instructions and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for **REL FOR JNEC 2022** must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate). All entries must be EFI horse passport number description, EFI registration number & name of the horse concerned & Rider's EFI I.D.

(b) Entries must be sent to the Show office, 61 Cavalry Jaipur. To facilitate processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to cavalrytackshop@gmail.com.

3. **Entry Fee.**

(a) The entry fee will be as under :-

- (i) Individual Events - Rs. 500/- per entry.
- (ii) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.

(b) **Closing Date for Entries.** Entries will close by 1200h on 20 Aug 2022. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES. However, post entries will be accepted up to one hour before the draw of lots for each event. No entries will be accepted thereafter. Post entry fee will be :-

- (i) Individual Events - Rs. 1000/- per entry.

(c) **Payment.** The entry fee may be paid in cash or by cheque/demand draft in favor of Commandant 61 Cavalry, Jaipur (preferably by cheque).

4. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI**

(a) As per EFI rulings ALL horses participating in REL have to be in possession of the new EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration Number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

5. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI**

(a) As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without Valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

(c) All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of Renewed EFI identity number in 2022.

(d) **NRI/OCI Card Holders.** OCI Card Holders/NRI's/ Foreigners shall be given Rider ID but they cannot participate in RELs and NEC which shall be only for Indian Citizens. NRI/OCI Card Holders/Foreigners would be allowed to participate in REL/NEC as HC entry only.

6. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one rider to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed once entry is given.

(d) All changes will be treated as post entries if made after the cut off dt of entries.

7. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders.**

(a) Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades.

(b) All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. Riders are liable to be disqualified and /or penalized for incorrect entry of the horse, as per EFI regulations.

8. **Technical Specifications of Events.** As per FEI specifications.

9. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.

10. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Regn number on the bridle during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable under a saddle.

11. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

12. **Objections.** Objection may be lodged in writing by the team Captain/ Competitor to the Technical delegate within 30 minutes before commencement of the event and for objections concerning irregularities or incidents during the competition not later than half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 2000/- in cash will accompany the objection and will be refunded, if the objection is up held.

13. **Certificates/Medals/Rosettes.** Prize distribution ceremony will be held following all COVID norms as per Govt guidelines.

14. **Responsibility.** The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.

15. **Disqualification.** The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified. Defaulting on the COVID-19 protocols will also be liable for disqualification.

16. **Correspondence.** All communication should be addressed to **Show Secretary, Organising Committee, c/o 61 Cavalry, PIN – 912661, c/o 56 APO**, clearly marked at the top centre of the envelope. It would be advisable to send entry form with entry fee draft and other important communications by **Registered Post**.
