FEI EVENTING CCI1* (INTRO) & CCI2* (LONG) 2022 AT 61 CAVALRY, JAIPUR FROM 04 JAN 2023 TO 08 JAN 2023

General.

1. FEI Eventing CCI1* (Intro) & CCI2* (Long) 2022 will be held at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur wef 04 Jan to 08 Jan 2023 under the aegis of the Equestrian Federation of India as per FEI & EFI guidelines. Details of the events including specifications are as per schedule of event issued by FEI. The guidelines, protocol and SOP for the prevention of COVID-19 issued by the Govt of India, EFI and SAI will be strictly followed.

Camp Arrangement.

2. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located in Polo Lines, 61 Cavalry. The camp will be functional wef 01 Jan 2023. Contingents will ensure that they do not reach the camp before 01 Jan 2023.

3. The Camp OIC will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp OIC on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accn or property will be the responsibility of the rep of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all aspects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals and remain confined to their camps and maintain social distancing from the other teams. The teams should also be well prepared to make electrical connections in their respective camps, any assistance required in this regard should be intimated to Camp OIC by 01 Jan 2023.

4. All teams will intimate the total str of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 25 Dec 2022 and intimate the ETA well in advance. Format att as **Appx 'A'** to Adm Instructions duly filled and signed must reach the Camp OIC by 25 Dec 2022. Following documents should be submitted on arrival for considering the camping facility:-

- (a) Adhaar card copy of grooms/ horse handlers certified by OIC team.
- (b) Two passport size photographs of civil employees
- (c) Passport of horses (EFI)
- (d) Coggin's and CFT negative certificate.
- (e) Vet health certificate
- (f) COVID vaccination certificate

Accommodation.

5. All participants are required to make arrangement for their accn. In case any assistance is required you may contact Show Secy, 61 Cav.

COVID-19.

6. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian trg and competition activities in a COVID-19 envt issued by the EFI.

Practice and Exercise Area.

7. A suitable area will be earmarked close to the camp for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise area will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the events. Staggered timings will be allotted to use the practice/exercise areas to ensure minimum contact.

Lighting.

8. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/gen sets for emergency use. However light/power shall be provided under camp arrangements where feasible. Centralized distribution box will be provided from where teams can take their connection under own arrangement. Proper cable should be used for taking connections and joints to be properly taped and concealed.

Ration for Army Animals.

9. Rations for animals for all participating Army horses will be drawn from 303 ASC Coy Supply Depot, Type 'A', Jaipur. Sufficient packing materials for storage of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingent for horses and men. Contingent will submit their indent for drawing of ration to 303 Coy ASC Sup Depot Type 'A', Jaipur directly after publishing their Station Order from 61 Sub Area, Jaipur for attachment with 303 Coy ASC Sup Depot Type 'A', Jaipur.

10. Private horses of army personnel should come fully equipped with stabling facilities, fodder and grain etc.

Transport.

11. Contingents are advised to be self contained for transport.

Line Gear for Animals.

12. Contingents will bring adequate line gear and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Safaiwala.

13. The contingents will bring their own safaiwalas for cleaning of respective camp site.

Pitching of Tents.

14. Contingent will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp. Incase of reqmt of stables same should be communicated to camping offr by 25th Dec 2022.

Families.

15. No families will be accommodated in the camp.

Fire Precautions.

16. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precaution of their respective areas. The Camp OIC however, will detail fire fighting/picket parties from amongst the participant the contingent if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

17. Proper sanitation and hygiene measures will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precaution will be taken by all concerned.

Discipline.

18. All participants' grooms and administrative staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp OIC for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

Security.

19. All contingent will ensure highest level of security of their contingent during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Jaipur. Local/station order on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All civilian will be in possession of valid prelim verification. No unauthorized movement of the personnel staying in the camp without the permission of Camp OIC and the In/Out movement of all personnel will be registered at the camp reception.

Veterinary/Medical Cover.

20. Veterinary cover to army animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 40 Mil Vet Officer, Jaipur who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp.

Coggin's Test for Equine Infectious Anemia & CFT for Glanders.

21. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival at Jaipur as per policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have CFT negative cert and certificate stating the horse is free from any infectious or contagious disease, duly signed by the Veterinary Doctor from the station the horses are coming from, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and CFT negative certificate, **with minimum validity of 15 days on the day of arrival and exit** and the Vet Certificate will be produced to the Camp OIC, failing which the horse will not be allowed inside the camp.

Registration of Horses.

22. Only horses registered with the EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI Registration No of horses. Riders/team captain's should contact the EFI and obtain regd no of horses which have not yet been registered and pass port.

TECHNICAL INSTRS

TECH INSTRS FOR FEI EVENTING CCI1*-INTRO & CCI2*-LONG FROM 04 JAN 2023 TO 08 JAN 2023 AT 61 CAVALRY, JAIPUR

1. FEI Eventing CCI1*(Intro) & CCI2* (Long) will be conducted by 61 Cavalry wef 04 Jan 2023 to 08 Jan 2023 according to the FEI rules and Technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue.
2. **Tentative Schedule** FEI Eventing CCI1*-Intro & CCI2* Long is attached as **Appx 'A'**.
3. **Entries.**
 - (a) All EFI Eventing CCI1*-Intro & CCI2*-Long entries must be on the prescribed entry form given in appx `B' to the technical instructions and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for **FEI Eventing CI*-Intro & CCI 2* Long** must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate) and have details of EFI horse passport number, FEI registration number & name of the horse concerned and rider's FEI I.D. and sent to equestrian federation of India online through registered email to efindianf@yahoo.co.in.
 - (b) Entries must be sent to EFI office directly for FEI Eventing CI*-Intro & CCI 2* Long. To facilitate processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to cavalrytackshop@gmail.com.
 - (c) Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.
4. **Entry fee.** All individual events - Rs 2000/- per exhibit.
5. **Closing date of Entries.**
 - (i) Definite entries - 28 Dec 2022
 - (ii) Last date for substitutions - 03 Jan 2023

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider regn no and horse regn no issued by FEI/EFI as per the type of event.
6. Score achieved by a horse-rider combination in FEI CCI2* (L) competition shall be considered for indl/team selection for 19th Asian Games if rider request the EFI for the same as per para 4 and 30 of Selection Criteria (Version-V).
7. **Payment** All FEI Eventing CI 1*-Intro & CI 2*-Long entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under:-

8. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer and substitutions of Entry will be as per FEI rules**
- (a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
- (b) **Transfers and substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one rider to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as post entries if made after cutoff date of entries. Once a class has started being judged no change in riders will be accepted.
9. **Cancellation.** The organizing committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved, those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.
10. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders.** As per **EFI Specifications.**
11. **Technical Specifications of Events.** As per **EFI Specifications.**
12. **Horse Passport.** All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. **No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with EFI and FEI prior to the event.**
13. **EFI's Rider Registration.** All riders participating in the FEI Eventing CI1*-Intro & CI2*-Long should possess valid FEI ID Number. Riders not having valid/renewed/active FEI Rider ID number or putting wrong ID number will not be permitted to participate in the events.
14. **Foreign Riders.** EFI is requested to obtain MI Clearance for managers/coaches/judges/Riders who are taking part in FEI Events. Foreign officials/riders whose MI Clearance is not obtained will not be allowed to enter in 61 Cavalry being Army area.
15. **Show Number.** All horses participating in CI1* Intro and CI 2* Long will display the FEI registration number during the veterinary inspection, competition and wherever taken put of the stable preferably fitted on either side of the bridle for easy identification.
16. **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be attired in proper riding dress with boots on. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per FEI Guidelines.
17. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.
18. **Use of whips/spurs.** As per EFI rules and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
19. **Tack.** As per FEI rules.

20. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.

21. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

22. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the show secretary, 61 Cav along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

23. **Responsibility.** The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.

24. **Disqualification.** The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified. Defaulting on the COVID-19 protocols will also be liable for disqualification.

25. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti- Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation(EADCM)** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFi approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
