ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **General.** FEI Eventing World Challenge 2023 will be conducted from 30 Oct to 02 Nov 2023 by the Army Polo and Riding Centre at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt as per guidelines of the Equestrian Federation of India, FEI Eventing Rules and FEI Eventing World Challenge Rule-2023.
2. **Camping.** Temporary stabling facility will be provided to participants for the duration of FEI Eventing World Challenge 2023 at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt. Rules and regulations for the temporary stabling facility are attached at **Appendix 'A'**.
3. **Covid-19.** The guidelines, protocol and SOP for the prevention of COVID-19 issued by the Govt of India (MHA), EFI and SAI will be strictly followed.
4. **Medical Cover.** The APRC will as usual provide basic medical first aid cover for riders at the ground. The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider/player on the ground or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual to give a written undertaking (Indemnity Bond) absolving the APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations of any responsibility in this regard. Specimen of the Indemnity Bond to be given by all playing members/rider is as per **Annexure 3 of Appendix 'A'** to this Prospectus. The APRC will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the nearest hospital when necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.
5. **Insurance Cover.** It is recommended that all players/individual take insurance against any injury sustained while participating in the events or practicing at the Army Equestrian Centre. It would be ideal for the ponies as well to be covered under some insurance policy. The APRC may be informed as regard the above while signing the medical declaration. The APRC excludes all liability for any injury and/or loss occasioned to any person and/or their property within the premises of Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt.
6. **Veterinary Doctors.** The vet doctor available in case of an emergency.

7. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the IHQ of MoD (Army), QMG's Branch along with representative of the Animal Husbandry Commissioner for the season will have full right to examine all the horses participating. It is advisable to have horses checked by the Veterinary Officer on duty before the event start.
8. **Coggin's Test for Equine Infectious Anemia & CFT for Glanders.** All rules and instructions issued by the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival as per policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have CFT negative cert and certificate stating the horse is free from any infectious or contagious disease, duly signed by the Veterinary Doctor from the station the horses are coming from, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and CFT negative certificate, **with minimum validity of 30 days on the day of arrival and exit** and the Vet Certificate will be produced to the Camp OIC, failing which the horse will not be allowed inside the camp.

9. **Registration of Horses.** Only horses registered with the EFI/FEI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI/FEI Registration No of horses. Riders/team captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd no of horses which have not yet been registered. All horses to in possession of EFI passport.
10. **Compliance of NADA Rules.** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
11. **Arboriculture.** No Det/Camp will spoil or cut the environment. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced. **No warning will be issued.**
12. **Responsibility.** The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the player/rider themselves.
13. **Miscellaneous.** The AEC is a facility of the Army and no defence/para military contingents, private horse owners and the APRC members/riding facility (Temp) has any right to allow him/them to take claims over this land. OIC AEC reserves the rights to remove all horses, men and material without any notice. _
14. **Clearance Certificate.** All rider/unit/team/club are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Camp OIC and Show Secretary during working hours prior to departure. All accounts are required to be cleared before leaving the AEC premises. No horses will leave unless the clearance certificate is duly signed by the concerned authority.
15. **Final Decision.** The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final on all matters connected with the FEI Eventing World Challenge 2023.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS
FEI EVENTING WORLD CHALLENGE 2023
30 OCT TO 02 NOV 2023
AT ARMY EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, DELHI CANTT

1. FEI Eventing World Challenge 2023 is being organized by Army Polo and Riding Centre at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt from 30 Oct to 02 Nov 2023 according to the FEI Eventing World Challenge Rule 2023. Refer to the FEI Website.

2. **Tentative Schedule.** Attached as Appendix 'B'

3. **Entries**

(a) All FEI Eventing World Challenge 2023 entries must be on the prescribed Entry form given in Appendix 'C' to the prospectus and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed Entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for **FEI Eventing World Challenge 2023** must be accompanied by proof of age and have details of EFI horse passport number, FEI registration number & name of the horse concerned and rider's FEI I.D. and sent to Equestrian Federation of India online through registered email to efiindianf@yahoo.co.in.

(b) Entries must be sent to EFI office directly.

(c) Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.

(d) **Horse Declaration Form.** Participants with more than one horse need to fill the FEI Horse Declaration form and submit to the organizing committee before the vet check duly signed by FEI Judge. The declared horse must be ridden first in all rounds.

4. **Entry Fee.** Rs 1000/- per exhibit.

5. **Closing date of entries.**

(a) Definite Entries - 25 Oct 2023

(b) Last date for substitutions - 27 Oct 2023

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider registration no and horse registration no issued by FEI/EFI as per the type of event.

6. **Payment.** Entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under :

7. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer and substitutions of Entry**

(a) **Withdrawal**. The entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfers and substitutions**. A horse cannot be transferred from one rider to another without paying an additional entry fee for the event. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders**. Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as Post Entries if made after the cutoff date of entries. Once a class has started being judged, no change in riders will be accepted.

8. **Cancellation**. The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved, those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

9. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders**. As per FEI Specifications.

10. **Technical Specifications of Events**. As per FEI Specifications.

11. **Horse passport**. All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI and FEI prior to the event.

12. **EFI Rider Registration**.

(a) As per EFI rules all Riders participating in the EFI/FEI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without **Valid /Renewed/** EFI registration number.

(c) Participating rider must be a life/ individual member of EFI or he/her should be a member of registered club of EFI. The same shall be checked by OC and such cases will not be permitted to participate in the REL. Also a list of same will be brought to the notice of EFI as soon as possible

13. **Foreign Riders**. EFI is requested to obtain MI Clearance for managers/ coaches/judges /Riders who are taking part in FEI Events. Foreign officials/riders whose MI Clearance is not obtained will not be allowed to enter AEC.

14. **Show number**. All horses participating in World Challenge 2023 will display the FEI registration number during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable preferably fitted on either side of the bridle for easy identification.

15. **Dress Code**. When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be attired in proper riding dress with boots on. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per FEI Guidelines.

16. **Rosettes**. No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.
17. **Use of whips/spurs**. As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
18. **Tack**. As per FEI rules.
19. **Reporting for each class**. All horses will report to the collecting ring stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the ground jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.
20. **Judging**. Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.
21. **Appeal**. Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the Secretary, APRC along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
22. **Disqualification**. The ground jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality/abuse or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.
