ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION

NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP- EVENTING (PRE NOVICE, NOVICE, CCN 1*-INTRO, CCN 2*, CCN 3*) FROM 29 APR -10 MAY 2023 AT ASC CENTRE & COLLEGE, BANGALORE

GENERAL

1. National Equestrian Championship Eventing All Grades (Pre Novice, Novice, CCN1*-Intro, CCN2* & CCN3*) is scheduled to be conducted at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore wef 29 Apr to 10 Mar 2023 under the aegis of the Equestrian Federation of India as per EFI guidelines and FEI Rules. The guidelines, protocol and SOP for the prevention of COVID-19 issued by the Govt of India, EFI and SAI will be strictly followed.

INTIMATIONFORPARTICIPATION

2. All teams desirous to participate in the said event will intimate the show secretary/OIC, Camp about the total str of contingent and ETA in terms of participants / adm staff/ syces/ grooms and horses positively by 15 Apr 2023as per format attached as Appendix 'A' to these adm instruction for arrangements in camp loc.

CAMP ARRANGEMENT.

3. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located at Harbour location. The camp will be functional wef **26 Apr 2023 (FN)** to **11 May 2023 (AN)**. All teams / contingents to ensure that they do not reach the Camp before **26 Apr 2023** and also make suitable arrangements for the return journey well in time since the camp facilities will not be available after **11 May 2023**.

4. The Camp OIC will earmark the site for each contingent/team/Indl. The rep of the contingent/team/Indl will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp OIC on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition. Any damage to camp, accommodation or property/facilities will be the responsibility of the OIC contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all respects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals.

ACCOMMODATION.

5. **Combatants** : Army personnel, ie JCOs and OR will be accommodated in Camp Area. Offrs and other participants should arrange for their accomodation under own arrangements. However, efforts to provide accommodations within in the ASC Centre & College will be made.

6. **Civilians**. Civilian participants are requested to make their own arrangements for accommodation. Camping site near the stabling area of civilian horses will be earmarked for accommodating civilian grooms and support staff. The contingents/indl/riders should be self-contained with respect to tentage and other basic requirement for camping of their personnel.

PRACTICE AND EXERCISE AREA.

7. A suitable area will be earmarked close to the camp for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise area will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the events. Riders are requested to utilize the earmarked areas only and other parts of training ground are not permitted.

LIGHTING.

8. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns / petrol maxes / gen sets etc for emergency use. However, light / power supply shall be provided under camp arrangements. No contingents will break the supply wire for connection and the joints if any will be properly taped leaving no naked wire under any circumstances. Responsibility of any untoward incidence, if any, of electric shock or fire due to short circuiting will solely be of OIC contingent. Under no circumstance, the electric cables will be connected inside the stables. Any light / fan arrangements to be provisioned for horses, should be given from outside the stables. In addition, the electric cables to be kept overhead well above the reach of horses and not to be laid underground.

RATION FOR ARMY ANIMALS.

9. Rations for animals for all participating Army horses will be drawn from 56 Coy ASC (Sup) Type G, Bangalore. Sufficient packing/stocking materials for storage of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingent for horses and men. Contingent will submit their indent for drawing of ration to 56 Coy ASC (Sup) Type G Bangalore directly after publishing their Station Order from HQ K & K Sub Area, for attachment with 56 Coy ASC (Sup) Type G. Tpt for collection will be made avl at the camp.

10. Private horses/civil continent should come fully equipped with stabling facilities, fodder and grain etc.

Transport Letter to PUPSA for CHT Funds

11. Contingents are advised to be self contained for tpt incl conveyance of animals and stores from respective unit location to Bangalore and back. If CHTs are reqd for return journey the requisite CHT indents will be signed by Offrs I/C of the unit/contingent concerned and fwd through the Camp office to HQ K&K Sub Area. ASC Centre & College will not initiate CHT indent for out station teams.

Line Gear for Animals.

12. Contingents should bring adequate line gear and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddle and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Pitching of Tents.

13. Contingent will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

14. No families will be accommodated in the camp. Any participant / supporting staff coming along with their family have to look for their own accommodation / lodging.

Fire Precautions.

15. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precaution of their respective areas. The Camp OIC however, will detail fire fighting/piquet parties from amongst the participating the contingents if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

16. Measures to ensure proper sanitation and hygiene in camp area as well as on the venue of competition will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti-malaria precautions will be adhered too.

Discipline.

17. All participants, grooms and administrative staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp commandant for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

PETS

18. It is advisable that no teams / participants / supporting staff to bring pets into the camp area or venue of the event. If unavoidable, same should be intimated to the organizing committee well in advance. However, **under no circumstances will the pet be brought to competition area / venue.**

Security.

19. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingent during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Bangalore. Local/station order on the subject shall be strictly complied with.

Veterinary / Medical Cover.

20. Veterinary cover to army animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 49 Mil Vet Hospital, Bangalore who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp. Medical cover for personnel will be provided under the arrangements of ASC Centre & College, Bangalore.

VETHEALTHPROTOCOLS,COGGIN'SANDCFTTESTS

21. All **participating equines** are required to be **exam by Veterinary Officer** at station of origin and issued with a **certificate stating them to be free from any infectious or contagious disease.** In addition to this, they must be in possession of **valid negative Coggin's test certificate and sero- negative CFT certificate for Glanders, in original.** These **certificates will only be valid for particular stn of participation** and will have to be issued by authorized test Centers as per latest policy in vogue. The **validity of Coggin's test** on arrival at the camp should preferably be such that animals return to their respective places within the validity. Test **date will be** calculated from **the date on which the sample was collected.**

22. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will also be done by a designated veterinary commission to ascertain the health status of the animals on arrival.

23. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 20 above or arriving before stipulated date i.e **26 Apr 2023** will not be allowed to unload their horses in ASC Centre & College premises and will not be allowed access to camp / training areas. **No animal will**

be allowed to enter the camp area till veterinary and health documents are checked and found to be in order.

DOPING

24. Riders need to follow guidelines on medication control as per rules in vogue. Therapeutic exemption to be obtained by athletes if under medication and same need to be declared before start of competition.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP – EVENTING (PRE NOVICE, NOVICE, CCN 1*-INTRO, CCN 2*, CCN 3*) FROM 29 APR -10 MAY 2023 AT ASC CENTRE & COLLEGE, BANGALORE

1. National Equestrian Championship Eventing All Grades (Pre Novice, Novice, CCN1*-Intro, CCN2* & CCN3*) is scheduled to be conducted at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore wef 29 Apr to 10 May 2023 according to the FEI rules and Technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue.

2. **Tentative Schedule** Tentative programme is attached as **Appx 'A'**.

3. **Entries.**

(a) All entries must be on the prescribed entry form given in Appx 'B' to the technical instructions and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries must have details of EFI horse passport number, EFI registration number & name of the horse concerned and rider's EFI I.D. and sent to OC of the event online through registered email to trainingmashal@hotmail.com.

(b) Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.

4. **Entry Fee.** Entry fee will be deposited with OC of the event.

(i) Normal Entry: Indl - Rs.500/- , Team Event – 1000/-

(ii) Post Entry : Indl - Rs. 1,000/- , Team Event - 2000

5. **Payment.** The entry fee may be paid only by cheque/transfer/ online or by demand draft in favour of ARPA Fund.

6. **Closing time/date of entries.** Entries will be accepted upto **26 Apr 2023**. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES and will be accepted till twenty four hours before vet inspection.**

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider regn no and horse regn no issued by EFI as per the type of event.

7. **Stabling charges.** It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

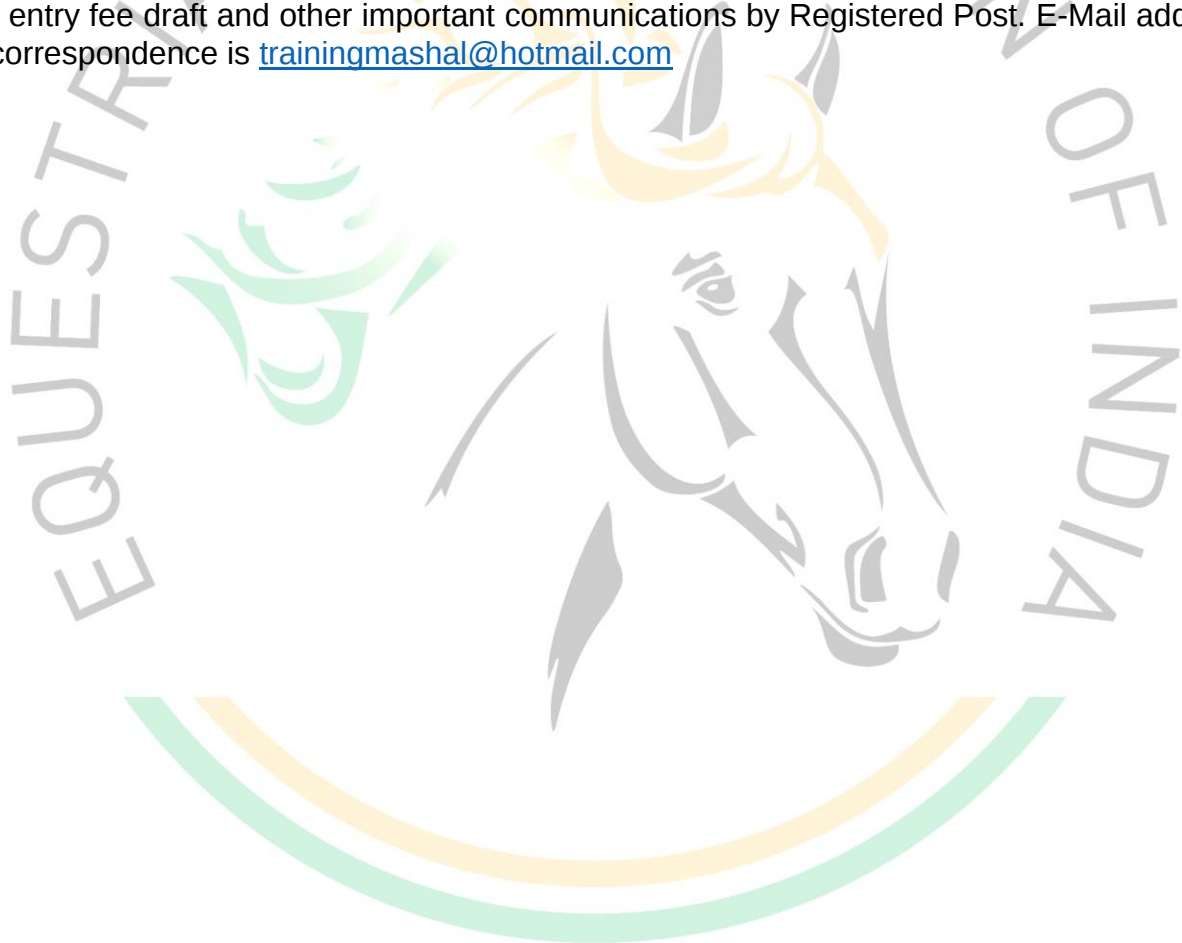
If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be maximum Rs 2500/- per horse.

8. **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A rider/horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another for any reason, whatsoever.
9. **Eligibility of Horses** Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades. All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries as available on EFI Website. A hard copy of the current grading list will also be available at the Show office and displayed on their notice board. **Riders are liable to be disqualified or penalized for incorrect entry of the horses, as per EFI regulations.**
10. **Technical Specifications of Events.** As per FEI/ EFI Technical Specifications.
11. **Horse Passport.** All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. **No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with EFI.**
12. **EFI's Rider Registration.** All riders participating in the EFI approved event should possess valid EFI ID Number. Riders not having valid/renewed/active EFI Rider ID number or putting wrong ID number will not be permitted to participate in the events.
13. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Regn/ passport number on the bridle during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable under a saddle.
14. **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be attired in proper riding dress with boots on. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per EFI/FEI Guidelines.
15. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.
16. **Use of whips/spurs.** As per EFI rules and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
17. **Tack.** As per FEI rules.
18. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.
19. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.
20. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the show secretary, ASC Centre & College, Bangalore along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

21. **Responsibility.** The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.
22. **Disqualification.** The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.
23. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti- Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation(EADCM)** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
