REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAUGE 2023

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Regional Equestrian League 2023 will be conducted from 14th – 15th Oct 2023 according to the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (REL Guidelines: Dressage & Show Jumping) JNEC – 2023.

2. **Age Category.** Age categories are as follow:-

S No	Category
(a)	Children II (10-12 years)
(b)	Children I (12-14 years)
(c)	Junior (14-18 years)
(d)	Young Rider (16-21 years)

3. **Entries.**

(a) Entries should be submitted in the prescribed form latest by 13th Oct 2023.

(b) Entry Fee. Entry fee must be paid in the form of a demand draft in favour of the **Director, Mayo College, Ajmer**. Entry fee is ₹ 1000/- for per entry.

(c) Closing Date for Entries. Entries will close on 1200 hrs, 13 Oct 2023.

(d) Description and Registration of Horses. All entries must give the description, registration number, grading and name of the concerned horse. One horse cannot be registered for two different riders in same category.

4. **EFI Horses Passport.** Only horses registered with the EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI registration No of horses. Riders/team Captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd No of horses which have not yet been registered for passport.

5. **EFI Rider Registration.**

(a) As per EFI rulings all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without valid /RENEWED/ ACTIVE EFI registration number.

(c) All the riders, participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of Renewed EFI identity number in 2023.

(d) NRI/OCI Card Holders. OCI Card Holders/NRI's/ Foreigners shall be given Rider ID but they cannot participate in RELs and NEC which shall be only for Indian Citizens. NRI/OCI Card Holders/Foreigners would be allowed to participate in REL/NEC as HC entry only.

6. **Withdrawal. Change. Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) Withdrawal. The Entry Fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the category.

(b) Transfer and Substitutions. A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in an event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once the event starts being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

7. **Reporting for Each Event.** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the Events. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows valid cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has absolute authority to take appropriate disciplinary action.

8. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration No on the bridle during the competition, veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

9. **Elimination / Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised.

10. **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI rules per subject.

11. **Dress Code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. Riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly colored plain shirt, white tie and Jacket or School uniform must be worn. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.

12. **First Aid.** Mayo College will provide First Aid for riders at the venue. The School shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. Mayo College will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be made available.

13. **Responsibility.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor shall be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

14. **Camp.** Mayo College will provide space for stabling of mounts for an amount of ₹ 1000/- per horses. All participating teams must therefore, be self-contained in term of tentage and other equipment needed for camping.

15. **Rent Chargeable for Stabling.** The cost of one fix stable provided by Mayo College is ₹ 2500/- for the duration of the event on first come first basis’.

16. **Miscellaneous.**

(a) Please get the Coggins and Glanders tests in respects of the mounts participating in the event. The test reports for all mounts participating are required to be ‘**Negative**’. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory. Test reports are also required and the same may be kindly be forwarded to us.

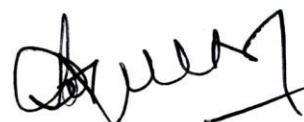
(b) **Glanders and EIA (coggins) negative certificate:** Glanders validity 15 days and EIA (Coggins) validity 90 days. Recognized Labs are: NRCE Hissar, DRL Pune Race Course and Central Military Veterinary Laboratory, Meerut.

(c) **Animal Ration.** All teams must bring their own animal ration.

17. **Appeal.** Any appeal shall be dealt as per FEI GR 161.

20. **Participation Confirmation.** Participation confirmation must reach the Organizing Secretary by **10 Oct 2023.**
21. **Entry Form.** Entry Form duly filled must reach Mayo College latest by **13 Oct 2023.**
Note. The Organising Committee reserved to alter/amend any of the above conditions, owing to unforeseen circumstances.
22. **EFI Registration of Horses.**
(a) As per EFI rules all horses participating in the Regional Equestrian League (REL) for JNEC-2023 have to be in possession of EFI passport.
(b) No entry will be accepted without valid EFI Horse Passport which has been timely renewed.
(c) Participating horse must be registered with an EFI affiliated club or the owner has to be an individual / life member of EFI. The same shall be checked by OC and cases found in violation will not be permitted to participate in the REL. Also, a list of same will be brought to the notice of EFI as soon as possible.
(d) Horses should be in compliance with vaccinations as per FEI/EFI vet rules & regulation.
23. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI.**
(e) As per EFI rules all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.
(f) Entries will not be accepted without **Valid /Renewed/** EFI registration number.
(g) Participating rider must be a life/ individual member of EFI or he/her should be a member of registered club of EFI. The same shall be checked by OC and such cases will not be permitted to participate in the REL. Also a list of same will be brought to the notice of EFI as soon as possible.
(h) In case an athlete is not in possession of valid/ renewed EFI Rider ID for the year 2023-24 before their participation in the said REL, result of said riders will not be considered towards their MER for JNEC.
