FEI DRESSAGE WORLD CHALLENGE 2023 NORTH INDIA

General

1. FEI World Dressage Challenge 2023 (North India) will be conducted from 07 Nov to 08 Nov 2023 at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur.
2. Trials for selection of Indian Team for FEI Dressage World Challenge 2023 including elimination will be conducted from 04 Nov to 05 Nov 2023 and maximum of 40 horse-rider combinations will participate in the final event on 07 Nov&08 Nov 2023.
3. Technical specification will be as per FEI World Dressage Challenge Rule-2023 and other relevant rule of FEI.
4. Tests will be held on the following categories of Dressage:-
 - (a) FEI Intermediate I - 16 yrs age and above
 - (b) FEI Prix St George - 16 yrs age and above
 - (c) FEI Challenge Senior II Class - 16 yrs age and above
 - (d) FEI Challenge Senior I Class - 16 yrs age and above
 - (e) FEI Challenge Youth Class - 12 yrs to 16 yrs of age
 - (f) **Rules.** FEI World Dressage Challenge 2023 rules are attached at **Appendix 'A'**. The extant FEI rules for World Dressage Challenge will be followed in their entirety with no deviations whatsoever. Participants are advised to be conversant with the rules and to participate in the event accordingly
5. **Programme.** Tentative Programme of FEI World Dressage Challenge 2023 are attached at **Appendix 'B'**.
6. **Entries.**
 - (a) All entries will be submitted on proper Entry Form as per format attached at **Appendix 'C'** to EFI office latest by 1200H on 01Nov 2023.
 - (b) **Entry Fee.** Rs 1000/- per entry.
 - (c) **Closing date for Entries:** Entries for FEI Dressage World Challenge 2023 will be closed by 1200H on 01 Nov 2023. In case of less than 40 entries at any venue, late entries will be allowed till the figure of 40 is reached. This will be submitted individually by email only and will be strictly first come first serve basis going by time received.
 - (d) The distribution of entries (Not Horses) for final event will be as follows:-
 - (i) Youth - 20
 - (ii) Senior I/ Senior II - 14
 - (iii) PSG/Inter-I - 06

(e) Final selection of the 40 entries and the Indian Team will be based on overall score achieved by the participants keeping in mind the difficulty quotient across all categories after computation of the final score. The Indian Team will comprise of four riders and they can be from any category/class. There will be no fixed vacancy in the formulation of the Indian Team. It will comprise of the four highest scores keeping in mind the coefficient factor laid down by FEI.

(f) It may please be noted that further participation in the competition as individual or as team member of the Indian team will only be allowed to those participants who undergo the world challenge selection trial.

7. **Stabling/ Camp facility & Charges.**

(a) Venue & stabling will be open on 29thOctober 2023(1700 hours) and close on 10thNovember 2023(1000 hours).

(b) Limited show stables are available and will be allotted on first cum first serve basis.

(c) The OC will provide an area wherein the participants will build their own temporary shed, charges levied will be maximum Rs. 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

(d) If the OC provides permanent show stables constructed by them for the duration of the event the charges levied will be a maximum of Rs. 2500 per horse.

ADMINISTRATION

8. **Venue.** The event will be held at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur.

(Note: The venue will open on **29thOctober 2023(1700 hours)** and close on **10thNovember 2023 at (1000 hours)**).

(NOTE: Athletes, grooms, trainers, family, or any other person visiting 61 Cavalry, Jaipur will not be permitted to enter without the Covid 19 Self Declaration & Travel Declaration form as prescribed by EFI)

9. **Camp.** All horses will be stabled at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur. Area for stabling will be allotted by the organizing committee to all teams depending on the number of horses per team. All horse handlers are permitted to stay along with the horses in temporary accommodation earmarked for the same. All teams are requested to share the number of horses/ handlers per contingent, which are likely to come latest by **29thOctober 2023** with the show secretary via E-mail/whatsapp. Contact Number of Camp in charge is as under :-

10. **Self-containment.** In addition to the above all teams must be self-contained in terms of tentage, equipment for camping and transport in order to be prepared for any unforeseen emergency.

11. **Ration /Fodder**.All teams should bring their own feed, hay, bedding, grass, etc. for their horses and should make their own provision for staff food. 61 Cavalry will not provide any assistance for the above unless special facilities are being provided for all teams.
12. **Coggin's and Glanders Test**.All rules and instructions issued from the EFI on this subject will be strictly adhered to by all participating teams. All teams must produce a valid negative EIA and Glanders status certificate on arrival with a validity advised by the governing authorities.
13. **Veterinary Commission**The Veterinary Commission detailed by Equestrian Federation of India, 61 Cavalry will have the right to examine all the horses participating.
14. **Veterinary Assistance**: Maj Raunak Bhardwaj is the Vet Offr at 61 Cavalry. Mobile - 9812025993.
15. **Farrier**All teams and riders are responsible to arrange their own farrier.
16. **Medical cover.** The organizing committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor on the venue or the consequences there-of. Each rider participating in the FEI Dressage World Challenge 2023 will fill the Indemnity Bond attached as and submit the same along with entry form.
17. **Insurance.** The organizing committee recommends units/club/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to 61 Cavalry and during the conduct of the events. The organizing committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitor, groom/ any other member of the team.
18. **Responsibility.** The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves.
19. **Clearance Certificate.** Horse owners are required to obtain clearance certificate from the OC during work hours. All concerned accounts need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses/ Person will be allowed to leave by the Camp In-charge without the clearance certificate.

21. **COVID-19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to. You are all requested to abide by the same. All decisions made by the COVID - 19 Compliance Officer will be final and binding. It is mandatory for all athletes, parents, trainer, grooms and all accompanying individuals to fill the COVID - 19 Self Declaration Form.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

22. **Technical Specifications.** Event will be conducted as per FEI Dressage World Challenge Rule 2023/ FEI Dressage Rules.

23. **Entries.**

(a) All entries will be on proper Entry Form as attached for the FEI Dressage World Challenge 2023 and should be completed in all respect and to be submitted to the Equestrian Federation of India Office. Entries not on the prescribed entry form will not be considered.

(b) **Entry Fee:** Rs 1000/- per entry

(c) **Closing date for Entries.** All entries for FEI Dressage World Challenge 2023 will close by **29th October 2023(1200 hours).**

(d) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give the description, EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number, name and year of birth of the horse concerned.

24. **EFI Horses Passport** As per EFI rules all horses participating in the FEI Dressage World Challenge 2023 events must have a valid EFI passport in original. Entries will not be accepted without the EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number of the horse.
25. **EFI Rider Registration.**
- (a) As per EFI rules all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.
 - (b) Entries will not be accepted without **Valid /Renewed/** EFI registration number.
 - (c) Participating rider must be a life/ individual member of EFI or he/she should be a member of registered club of EFI. The same shall be checked by OC Camp and such cases will not be permitted to participate. Also a list of same will be brought to the notice of EFI as soon as possible.
26. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**
- (a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.
 - (b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as Fresh Entries. Once an event has started, being judged, no change in rider / horse will be accepted.
27. **Cancellation or Reschedule.** The Organizing committee may cancel or reschedule any class which has less than four entries or for any reason after consultation with EFI who will apprise the FEI for the same. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, depending on the numbers of entries received, the organizing committee may decide against this for any particular event.
28. **Reporting for Each Class.** All horses will report to the collecting ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.
29. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.
30. **Abuse/ Cruelty to Horses.** As per relevant rules of EFI/FEI.
31. **Rosettes.** A horse will not wear rosettes during judging.

32. **Elimination / Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, or any type of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.
33. **Whips/spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
34. **Dress code.** As per EFI/FEI rules.
35. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the show secretary, MEA along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
36. **Compliance of NADA Rules** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

DECLARATION (INDEMNITY BOND)

(d) That in the event of any loss or injury to property or person including injury

shall not hold 61 Cavalry responsible for the same or for any consequence thereof.

2. If any rights exist by operation of law, I hereby waive them and undertake not to initiate
any action against 61 Cavalry, Jaipur & other persons.

3. It is further declared that stamp duty payable on this undertaking shall be borne by me.
