TECH & ADM INSTRS

1. **General**- National Equestrian Championship Endurance 2022-23 (NEC- 40 km and JNEC 40 km) will be held with effective from 20 to 22 Jan 2023 at the Sagar Equestrian Sports Academy, Jaipur as per technical guidelines & rules/regulations of the equestrian federation of India/FEI. All participants are advised to go through the EFI technical guidelines, rules, regulations and specification, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.
2. **COVID-19 PROTOCOL**. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI (available on EFI Website) will be strictly adhered to. A separate set of guidelines will be sent from time to time to ensure safety of all. You are all requested to abide by the same. All decisions made by the COVID – 19 Compliance Officer will be final and binding. It is mandatory for all athletes, parents, trainer, grooms and all accompanying individuals to fill the COVID – 19 Self DeclarationForm.
3. **Tentative Programme**. Refer **Appendix‘A’**
5. **Entries**.
 - (a) All entries must be on the prescribed Entry form given in **Appendix ‘B’** and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for National Equestrian Championship -2022-23 (NEC- 40 km and JNEC 40km) must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate). All entries must be EFI horse passport number description, EFI registration number & name of the horse concerned & Rider's EFI I.D.
 - (b) Entries must be sent to the Show office, Sagar Equestrian Sports Academy Gajadharpur, Jaipur. To facilitate processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to sagarequestianacademy@gmail.com
 - (c) **Entry Fee**- the entry fee will be asunder:-
 - (i) Individual Events- Rs 500/-+ 18% GST per entry.
 - (ii) Team Events Rs. 1000/-+18% GST Per Team.
 - (d) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.
 - (e) **Closing Date for Entries**– Entries will close by 16:00 hours on 19th Jan 2023Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES. However, post entries will be accepted up to ten hour before the event. No entries will be accepted thereafter. Post entry fee will be:-
 - (a) Individual Events Rs. 500/-+ 18% GST perexhibit.
 - (b) Team events Rs. 1000/- + 18% GST PerTeam
 - (f) **Payment**-All entries must be paid in DD or by local Cheque or RTGS/NEFT in favor of “**Sagar Equestrian Sports Academy**” Account No. **29570200001186**, IFSC – **BARB0JHOTWA** Jaipur(Payable at Jaipur)BANK OF BARODA.

(g) Foreign Nationals & OCI card holders cannot participate in the NEC and JNEC Endurance. It is the responsibility of OC to ensure this aspect by obtaining a copy of Indian Passport from all athletes alongwith entry form participating in NEC / JNEC Endurance (40km).

5. **EFI Horses Passport.**

(a) As per EFI rules all horses participating in the National Equestrian Championship - 2022-23 (NEC- 40 km and JNEC 40 km) have to be in possession of EFI passport.

(b) No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the show.

6. **EFI Rider Registration.** All the riders participating in the EFI recognized events should be in possession of EFI identity number. No entry will be accepting without valid/renewed EFI Rider ID.

7. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal**- The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

(d) All changes will be treated as post entries.

8. **Cancellation.** The organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, the events where upgradation of horses is involved , those events will be held irrespective of number of entries.

9. The class will start once the draw of lots for the order of start has been held.

10. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI registration number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out from the stable.

11. **Rosette.** No rosette will be worn by a horse during judging.

12. **Elimination/Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animal. Rapping will be severely penalized.

13. **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI rules on the subject.

14. **Dress Code.** As per relevant rules of EFI/FEI.

(a) Protective headgear, of a recognized equestrian/endurance standard and securely fastened, is compulsory for all persons at all Endurance events whilst mounted.

(b) Safe riding footwear with heels If 12 mm or more, or alternatively caged/Boxed stirrups/equestrian safety stirrups are compulsory for all persons at all endurance events whilst mounted.

(c) Dress, that is appropriate and not detrimental to the image of Endurance Riding is required.

(d) Athlete.- Smart Pressed Team or Individual Riding uniforms.

(e) Team Officials, Grooms, Crews :-Smart Pressed Team or Individual uniforms.

(f) FEI Officials :- Smart Clothing to include jacket and tie where applicable, Shorts or sandals are unacceptable standards of dress and will not be allowed.

During the actual ride

(g) Athlete :- Appropriate riding attire, shirt/polo shirt to include a collar.

(h) Team officials, Grooms, Crews : Smart Team or Individual attire. No Shorts within the Vet Inspection area, or sandals allowed within the 'Field of Play'(Safety)

(i) Officials :- Smart working attire, no shorts or Sandals.

15. **Appeal**– Appeal can be lodged by competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF in Indian Currency should be deposited with the Show Secretary SESA along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

16. **Medical Cover**- SESA will provide medical cover for riders at the venue. SESA will not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences hospital where necessary, through every possible means available. Each rider participating in the ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP -2022-23 will fill the indemnity Bond attached at Appendix C and submit the same along with entry form.

17. **Insurance**. The Organizer recommends that units/clubs/associations/schools to take Insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Jaipur during the events. The Organizer will not assume responsibility for any accident or illness due to fail of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.

18. **Responsibility**. The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury any animal of any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Organizer nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any aid or other medical treatment provided.

19. **Eligibility of Rider**. Please ref relevant rule of EFI/FEI Guidelines.

20. **Restriction on Horse** . Please ref relevant rule of EFI/FEI Guidelines.

21. **Saddlery and Equipment** –Please ref relevant rule of EFI/FEI Guidelines.

22. **Technical conduct:-** As per EFI Tech Guideline and FEI Rules.

23. **Accommodation** –All Participants are required to make arrangement for their accommodation. In Case any assistance is required you may contact show secretary SESA, Jaipur.

24. **Inspection Decorum**:- As per EFI Tech Guideline and FEI Rules.

25. **Abuse/cruelty to horses** –As per EFI Tech Guideline and FEI Rules.

26. **Camp**- The SESA has permitted stabling of horses for all participants in NATIONAL AND JUNIOR NATIONAL ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP -2022-23 for the duration of the event. Permission to stable horses during the above period is subject to certain conditions as laid down in Appendix 'D' to this prospectus. No civilian employee of any contingent will be allowed to enter will be SESA, Jaipur without civil police verification. Camp will open on 18th Jan 2023.

(a) Rent Chargeable for Stabling:-

(i) All teams should preferably come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.

(ii) Fee of Rs 500 + 18% taxes will be charged per stable which is set up on SESA grounds.

(iii) The cost of one temporary stable provided by SESA is Rs. 2500 + 18% taxes for the duration of the show on first come first basis' (Tarpaulin for the sides must be arranged at your end).

(b) The Camp incharge will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp incharge on arrival & handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the contingent. The teams should come self contained in all respects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals. All teams will intimate the total strength of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 16th Jan 2023 and intimate Extended Time of Arrival well in advance SESA, Jaipur to org AdministrativeArrangements.

27. **Self – Containment**– All teams coming to participate in the NATIONAL AND JUNIOR NATIONAL ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP -2022-23 must be self-contained, ie, they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping, cooks and transport, etc.

28. **Ration/Fodder**- Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/ fodder to sustain their horses during their Stay in Jaipur or, they can ask for attachment both the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animalrations.

29. **Coggin and Glander Test** –All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount veterinary Directorate, army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander Status (CFT) certificate on arrival to Jaipur. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 14 days arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

30. **Trotting Parade** –All participants are requested to present their horses for veterinary inspection (Trotting parade) at 1000 Hrs at 20th Jan 2023.
31. **Ground jury, Veterinary / technical delegate, Appeal Committee and insurance-**
These are as per Equestrian Federation of India under governing competitions.
32. **Spectators** –The Spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the judges. The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help. Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena. The Judges decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the judges.
33. **Prize Distribution** –Tentatively prizes will be distributed on the 22th Jan 2023.
34. **Fire Fighting Arrangement.** All contingents are requested to carry adequate firefighting equipment.
35. **Veterinary Commission** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
36. **Veterinary Assistance** The following is available for vet assistance in case of an emergency.

37. **Clearance Certificate.** All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Show office during working hours. All accounts concerned needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless they obtain the clearance certificate.
38. **Anti Doping.** The organizer will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti-doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders / Athletes who need to use prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition a Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate (TUEC) will be obtained from the doctor prior to taking any medicine.
39. **Compliance of NADA Rules** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for drug testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
