PROSPECTUS

General

1. The Anand Delhi Horse Show 2023 (DHS) will be conducted from 20th March 2023 to 02 April 2023 under the aegis of the Equestrian Federation of India at the Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt. The guidelines, protocol and SOP for the prevention of Covid-19 issued by the Govt of India (MHA), EFI and SAI will be strictly followed. The Covid-19 vaccination of indls will be declared by respective camp owners and indls.

PART-I

ADMINISTRATION

2. **Programme.** Programme for the Anand Delhi Horse Show 2023 is attached at **Appendix 'B'**.

3. **Camping.** Temporary stabling facility will be provided to participants for the duration of Anand Delhi Horse Show 2023 at Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt. Rules and regulations for the temporary stabling facility are attached at **Appendix 'C'**.

4. **Covid-19.** In light of the Covid-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines as promulgated by EFI/Govt of India/Higher Head Quarters must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. Valid Covid-19 vaccination certificate (at least 02 doses) must be produced by all member of Team/Clubs including riders/ participants and their associates.

5. **Coggin's and Glanders Test.** All rules and instructions issued by the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. Coggins and glanders negative certificate valid for a minimum of 15 days at the time of entry for participation.

6. **Veterinary Doctors.** The following vet doctors are available in case of an emergency.

7. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the IHQ of MoD (Army), QMG's Branch along with representative of the Animal Husbandry Commissioner for the season will have full right to examine all the horses participating. It is advisable to have horses checked by the Veterinary Officer on duty before the event start

8. **Arboriculture.** No Det/Camp will spoil or cut the environment. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced. **No warning will be issued.**

9. **Medical Cover.** The APRC will as usual provide basic medical first aid cover for riders at the ground. The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider/player on the ground or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual to give a written undertaking (Indemnity Bond) absolving the APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations of any responsibility in this regard. Specimen of the Indemnity Bond to be given by all playing members/rider is as per **Annexure 3 of Appendix 'C'** to this Prospectus. The APRC will only provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the nearest hospital when necessary, though every possible available medical cover will be presented.

10. **Insurance Cover.** It is recommended that all players/individual take insurance against any injury sustained while participating in the events or practicing at the Army Equestrian Centre. It would be ideal for the ponies as well to be covered under some insurance policy. The APRC may be informed as regard the above while signing the medical declaration. The APRC excludes all liability for any injury and/or loss occasioned to any person and/or their property within the premises of Army Equestrian Centre, Delhi Cantt.
11. **Responsibility.** The APRC/Govt of India (MoD)/ Army/61 Cavalry or any member or officer or employee or other representative of the said organizations accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the player/rider themselves.
12. **Miscellaneous.** The AEC is a facility of the Army and no defence/para military contingents, private horse owners and the APRC members/riding facility (Temp) has any right to allow him/them to take claims over this land. OIC AEC reserves the rights to remove all horses, men and material without any notice.
13. **Foreign Nationals.** Managers/coaches of all Teams/Clubs who are arranging for foreign riders for taking part in the subject events are required to forward the details of the foreign riders and companions if any as per format enclosed as **Appendix 'D'** along with photocopy of their passport and visa, 15 days prior to start of the Show to e-mail ID – aprcdelhi@gmail.com, so as to obtain MI Clearance from the concerned authorities. Foreign riders whose MI Clearance is delayed for want of submission of details by the Team manager/coaches will **NOT** be allowed to enter in the Army Equestrian Centre/Army Area.
14. **Compliance of NADA Rules.** As per order, NADA rules as per Govt norms are mandatory for all riders participating in the EFI approved events to avoid any embarrassment to the Association and the Nation at International platform.
15. **Rail Freight.** No rail freight for ponies, rail fare or, DA will be paid by the APRC to any player/attendant.
16. **Clearance Certificate.** All riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the APRC office during working hours. All outstanding dues are required to be cleared before they can obtain the same. On exit No demand certificate will be submitted by all contingents, private horse owners and APRC Members/Riding Facility (Temp).
17. **Final Decision.** The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final on all matters connected with the DHS-2023.

PART II

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

20. The Technical Instructions for the Anand Delhi Horse Show 2023 are as follows:-

(a) Schedule of Events. Attached **Appendix 'A'**.

(b) Tentative Programme. Attached at **Appendix 'B'**.

(c) **Entries.** All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as attached at **Appendix 'E'** and should be completed in all respects. Entries not on the prescribed entry form and without entry fee will not be considered. **ALL ENTRIES FOR YOUNG RIDERS, JUNIOR RIDERS AND CHILDREN RIDERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY BIRTH CERTIFICATES.**

(d) **Entry Fee.** Entry fee for DHS 2023 will be as under. Post entries will be accepted twenty-four hours before the event. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.**

(e) **Closing Date for Entries.** Entries will close by **17 Mar 2023**. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as POST ENTRIES or as per Show Secretary's decision.

(f) **Payment.** All entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer or by local cheque in favour of Army Polo & Riding Centre. Bank details for electronic payment are as under :-

(g) **Team Events.** Team events will be held for Dressage, Tent Pegging and Jumping competitions. Please forward your team entries accordingly. Minimum 04 teams should be entered to hold the team events.

(h) **A rider can take part only on a max of two horses in each category of all disciplines for which competitions are being conducted in DHS.**

21. **Common Instructions for All Events.**

(a) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give the description, registration No, grading and name of the horse concerned. The name of the rider will be given for all mounted classes.

(b) **EFI Horses Passport.** As per EFI rules all horses participating DHS 2023 events which are recognized by the EFI in their technical guidelines ie, Dressage, Show Jumping and Tent Pegging have to be in possession of EFI passport. No entries will be accepted without EFI passport of horses and EFI registration. The Team Captains to be in possession of EFI Passports of horses during event. The registration No has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) **EFI Rider Registration.**

(i) ALL THE RIDERS PARTICIPATING IN THE EFI RECOGNIZED EVENTS SHOULD POSSESS EFI ID NO.

(ii) RIDERS NOT HAVING VALID/RENEWED/ACTIVE EFI RIDER ID NUMBER OR PUTTING WRONG ID NO WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENTS.

(d) **Grading of Horses.** It will be the responsibility of the riders/clubs/units to ensure that their horses are entered in the correct grade as per the latest updated list. Entry of the horse in the wrong grade will entail elimination from that event and disqualification from the entire horse show. Please refer relevant rules of EFI Tech Guidelines 2021 for each discipline.

(e) **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(i) **Withdrawal.** The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(ii) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(iii) **Change of Riders.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as **Post Entries**. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

(f) **Technical specifications of events.** The events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of FEI & EFI as per the relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions and local merits/demerits in consultation with EFI.

(g) **Cancellation.** The Organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded.

(h) **Reporting for Each Class.** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. The first three riders in dressage and first five riders in jumping must report to the arena stewards at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start that event. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action. This is for Gymkhana events and Show Classes too.

(j) **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration No on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

(k) **Abuse/Cruelty to horses.** Refer to EFI Technical Guidelines 2021 and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

(l) **Elimination/Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.

(m) **Whips/Spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

(n) **Dress Code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy. In any case, riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness including riders in uniform.

(o) **Appeal.** Any appeal will be dealt as per FEI GR 161.

(p) **Prizes & Certificates.**

(a) **Junior & Children's Events.** Medals and Rosettes will be given upto 6th place.

(b) **Senior Events:** Prizes and Rosettes will be given only upto 4th position.

(c) Certificates will be given only upto 3rd place, as per requirement of participants.

(q) All events scheduled in the evening will continue under lights, when required.

Note – The Show office will close at 08 PM every day. No entries will be entertained after 08 PM.

8. **Reporting for each Class.**

- (a) All riders must report to the collecting ring steward half an hour before the event for Hacks/Gymkhana races.
- (b) The first three riders in dressage and first five riders in jumping must report to the arena stewards at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start that event.
- (c) The arena steward has full authority to take appropriate action as per existing rules if competitors are late.

9. For Group III Gymkhana events the Riders will be permitted to be held by a Syce. However, they must be able to ride alone for the hacks, dressage and jumping.

10. SPECTATORS ARE REQUESTED NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE JUDGES. THE ARENA STEWARD HAS THE RIGHT TO ELIMINATE ANY PARTICIPANT WHO HAS OUTSIDE HELP. ONCE THE EVENT HAS COMMENCED ALL SPECTATORS AND HELPERS ARE REQUESTED TO CLEAR THE ARENA. IN THE CHILDREN GROUP III RACES, SYCES ARE PERMITTED TO HOLD THE HORSE. IN THE GROUP I & GROUP II RACES CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED ANY ASSISTANCE WHATSOEVER. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL. PARENTS MUST NOT ENTER THE ARENA OR DISPUTE THE JUDGES DECISION. PARENTS AND COACHES ARE REQUESTED TO STAY WELL CLEAR OF THE ARENA. IT IS DANGEROUS FOR THE CHILDREN AND HORSES OTHERWISE. SAFETY COMES FIRST. WE REQUEST TEAM CAPTAINS/ COACHES TO READ THE PROSPECTUS FULLY AND NOT JUST THE PROGRAMME.

11. Competitors are required to be correctly dressed for all the events. Civilians should wear a Blazer and Tie. Competitors improperly dressed can be disqualified. Hard hats must be worn with three-point contact. In gymkhana events a white shirt is permitted.

12. APRC members are requested to submit their entries by the given date. A draw will be held for allotment of APRC horses before the Show for entries received.

13. Competitors are responsible for entering correct grades or categories. The EFI has made a new list of grades for Dressage and Show Jumping horses. The Organising Committee will NOT be held responsible for incorrect entries.

14. DOUBTS/QUERIES/CLARIFICATION MAY BE SOUGHT WELL BEFORE THE EVENT.
