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**ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION : CCI1* (INTRO) & CCI2* (LONG) EVENTING AT ASC
CENTRE & COLLEGE, BANGALORE WEF 07-11 FEB 2023**

General FEI Eventing CCI1* (Intro) & CCI2* (Long) 2023 will be held at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore wef 07-11 Feb 2023 under the aegis of the Equestrian Federation of India as per FEI & EFI guidelines. Details of the events including specifications are as per schedule of event issued by FEI. The guidelines, protocol and SOP for the prevention of COVID-19 issued by the Govt of India, EFI and SAI will be strictly followed.

Camp Arrangement.

1. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located at 'C' Coy location. The camp will start functioning wef 05 Feb 2023. The Contingents will ensure that they do not reach the camp before 05 Feb 2023.
2. The Camp OIC will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp OIC on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the rep of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all respects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals.
3. All teams will intimate the total str of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 01 Feb 2023 and intimate ETA well in advance. Format attach as **Appx 'A'** to administrative instructions duly filled and signed must reach the show secretary by 01 Feb 2023.

Accommodation.

4. All participants are required to make arrangement for their accommodation. In case any assistance is required you may contact Secy ARPA at Army no 6634 and Mob 9409543000.

Civilians.

5. Suitable camping site near the horses will be earmarked for accommodating JCOs/OR and civil personnel. The contingents should be self contained to accommodate their civil personnel.

Practice and Exercise Area.

6. A suitable area will be earmarked close to the camp for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise area will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the events.

Lighting.

7. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/patronages/ Gen sets for emergency use. However light/power shall be provided under camp arrangements where feasible.

Ration for Army Animals.

8. Rations for animals for all participating Army horses will be drawn from Supply Depot, Bangalore. Sufficient packing materials for storage of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingent for horses and men. Contingent will submit their indent for drawing of

ration to Sup Depot Bangalore directly after publishing their Station Order from K & K Sub Area, Bangalore for attachment with Sup Depot Bangalore.

9. Private horses/civil contingent should come fully equipped with stabling facilities, fodder and grain etc. The rations if required will be made available through civil vendor at ARPA.

Transport.

10. Contingents are advised to be self-contained for transport.

Line Gear for Animals.

11. Contingents will bring adequate line gear and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddle and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Safaiwala.

12. The contingents will bring their own safaiwala for cleaning of respective camp site and the surrounding area.

Pitching of Tents.

13. Contingent will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

14. No families will be accommodated in the camp.

Fire Precautions.

15. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precaution of their respective areas. The Camp OIC however, will detail fire fighting/piquet parties from amongst the participating contingents if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

16. Proper sanitation and hygiene measures will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals' litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precaution will be taken by all concerned.

Discipline.

17. All participants, grooms and administrative staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp OIC for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained. No liquor is to be consumed in the camping area. Dogs are NOT permitted in the camp area and the Event area.

Security.

18. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingent during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Bangalore. Local/station order on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All civilians will be in possession of valid preliminary police verification.

Veterinary/Medical Cover.

19. Veterinary cover to army animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 49 Mil Vet Hospital, Bangalore who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp. Following are available for vet assistance in case of emergency: -

20. All pers arriving in the camp shall be Vaccinated with three dozes and or RTPCR Negative test within 72 hrs. Medical cover will be provided under the arrangement of Command Hospital, Bangalore. The organizing committee will provide medical cover for riders at the venue however, same shall not accept any liabilities for med treatment given to a player on the venue or the consequences thereof. The organizing committee will only provide first aid treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary. Each rider participating in CCI8 & CCI2* Eventing will fill the Indemnity Bonds attach as **Appx-B** to Administrative Instructions and submit the same along with entry form.

Foreign National.

21. All teams arranging foreign nationals as coach/riders are required to forward the details of the foreign national and companions as per format enclosed as **Appx-C** to Administrative Instructions along with photocopy of passport and visa prior to the start of the show and obtain MI clearance from the concerned authorities.

Coggins Test for Equine Infectious Anemia and Mallein Test / CFT for Glanders.

22. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival at Bangalore as per policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have been Mallein tested/ CFT negative and examined by Veterinary Officer with certificate stating to be free from any infectious or contagious disease, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and Mallein/CFT negative certificate are to be produced to Camp OIC on arrival.

Registration of Horses.

23. Only horses registered with the FEI/EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the FEI/EFI registration No of horses. Riders/team Captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd No of horses which have not yet been registered for passport.

Clearance Certificate.

24. All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Camp OIC and Show Secretary during working hours. All accounts concerned need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless clearance certificate is obtained.

Certificates to this effect issued by Civil Police in respect all of my civilian employees along with two copy of their photographs are enclosed for records.

I understand that no civilian temporarily stabling at the camp premises is permitted to enter any area of surrounding military establishments and any one caught on tress passing surrounding military establishments will be handed over to the civil police for further prosecution. I hereby take full responsibility of my civilian employees and assure that they will not indulge in an act leading to breach of security.
8. I also assure that all members of my contingent/our horses & vehicles will use only the earmarked way for entry/exit to/from the Camp Area.
9. The responsibility as regard safety of men, material and horses is mine. No claim will be made against the camp authorities /Army in this regard.

TECH INSTRS FEI EVENTING CCI1*-INTRO & CCI2*-LONG
FROM 07 FEB TO 11 FEB 2023

1. FEI Eventing CCI1*(Intro) & CCI2* (Long) will be conducted at ASC Centre & College Bangalore wef 07 Feb to 11 Feb 2023 according to the FEI rules and Technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue.

2. **Tentative Schedule** FEI Eventing CCI1*-Intro & CCI2* Long is attached as **Appx 'A'**.

3. **Entries.**

(a) All EFI Eventing CCI1*-Intro & CCI2*-Long entries must be on the prescribed entry form given in appx `B' to the technical instructions and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for **FEI Eventing CI*-Intro & CCI 2* Long** must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate) and have details of EFI horse passport number, FEI registration number & name of the horse concerned and rider's FEI I.D. and sent to equestrian federation of India online through registered email to efindianf@yahoo.co.in.

(b) Entries must be sent to EFI office directly for FEI Eventing CI*-Intro & CCI 2* Long. To facilitate processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to trainingmashal@hotmail.com

(c) Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.

4. **Entry fee.** All individual events - Rs 2000/- per exhibit.

Note: No entries will be accepted without valid rider regn no and horse regn no issued by FEI/EFI as per the type of event.

6. **Stabling charges.** It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be maximum Rs 2500/- per horse.

7. Score achieved by a horse-rider combination in FEI CCI2* (L) competition shall be considered for indl/team selection for 19th Asian Games if rider request the EFI for the same as per para 4 and 30 of Selection Criteria (Version-V).

8. **Payment** All FEI Eventing CI 1*-Intro & CI 2*-Long entries must be paid preferably by Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under:-

9. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer and substitutions of Entry will be as per FEI rules.

10. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders.** As per **FEI/EFI Specifications.**

11. **Technical Specifications of Events.** As per FEI **EFI Specifications.**

12. **Horse Passport.** All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. **No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with EFI and FEI prior to the event.**

13. **EFI's Rider Registration.** All riders participating in the FEI Eventing CI1*-Intro & CI2*-Long should possess valid FEI ID Number. Riders not having valid/renewed/active FEI Rider ID number or putting wrong ID number will not be permitted to participate in the events.

14. **Foreign Riders.** EFI is requested to obtain MI Clarence for managers/coaches/judges/Riders who are taking part in FEI Events. Foreign officials/riders whose MI Clearance is not obtained will not be allowed to enter in ASC Centre & College Bangalore.

15. **Show Number.** All horses participating in CI1* Intro and CI 2* Long will display the FEI registration number during the veterinary inspection, competition and wherever taken put of the stable preferably fitted on either side of the bridle for easy identification.

16. **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be attired in proper riding dress with boots on. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per FEI Guidelines.

17. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.

18. **Use of whips/spurs.** As per EFI rules and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

19. **Tack.** As per FEI rules.

20. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.

21. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

22. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the show secretary, ASC Centre & College, Bangalore along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

23. **Responsibility.** The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.

24. **Disqualification.** The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified.

25. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti- Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation(EADCM)** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
