PROSPECTUS

General- Japaloupe Equestrian Centre is being organized REL 60Km Endurance event at HRG Stables, Bhadaj, Gujarat on the dates 20th and 21st March 2023 as per technical guidelines & rules/regulations of the Equestrian Federation of India/FEI. All participants are advised to go through the EFI technical guidelines, rules, regulations and specification, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.

1. **Tentative Programme –** refer appendix 'A'

2. **Entries:-**

(a) All entries must be of the prescribed Entry form given in Appendix 'B' and should be completed in all respects. Entries not in the prescribed entry form and not accompanied by the entry fee will not be considered. All entries for REL 60 km must be accompanied by proof of age (birth certificate). All entries must be EFI horse passport number description, EFI registration number & name of the horse concerned & Rider's EFI I.D.

(b) Entries must be sent to OC to facilitate the processing of the data please also email a copy of the entries to:-

(c) **Entry Fee-** The entry fee will be Rs. 500/-. No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.

(d) **Closing Date for Entries-** Entries will close by 12:00 hours on 17th March 2023. Entries will be on a first come first basis as we have a limited capacity of maximum 15 riders. No further entries will be accepted once the maximum capacity level is reached.

(e) **Payment-** All entries must be paid in CASH/ONLINE at the time of checking in at the event location.

3. **EFI Horses Passport.**

(a) As per EFI rules, all the horses participating in 60 Km REL will have to be in possession of EFI passport.

(b) No entry will be accepted without EFI horse ID. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event

(c) All the riders participating in the EFI recognized events should obtain EFI identity number.

4. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal-** The entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Change of Riders –** Riders cannot be changed unless the jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. Once a class has started being judged, no change in rider will be accepted.

(c) Cancellation- The organizing Committee may cancel the event for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded.

5. **Horse ID Tag** – All horses will put on the horse's EFI ID on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out from the stable.

6. **Rosette**- No rosette will be worn by a horse during judging.

7. **Elimination/Disqualification** – The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to the animal.

8. **Whips/Spurs** – As per EFI rules on the subject.

9. **Dress Code**- As per EFI Technical Guideline.

(a) Protective headgear, of a recognized equestrian/endurance standard and securely fastened, is compulsory for all persons at all Endurance events whilst mounted.

(b) Safe riding footwear with heels of (If 12 mm or more), or alternatively caged/Boxed stirrups/equestrian safety stirrups are compulsory for all persons at all endurance events whilst mounted.

(c) Dress, that is appropriate and not detrimental to the image of Endurance Riding is required.

(d) Athlete :- Smart Pressed Team or Individual Riding uniforms.

(e) Team Officials, Grooms, Crews :- Smart Pressed Team or Individual uniforms.

(f) Officials :- Smart Clothing to include jacket and tie where applicable, Shorts or sandals are unacceptable standards of dress and will not be allowed.

(g) During the actual ride.

(i) Athlete :- Appropriate riding attire, shirt/polo shirt to include a collar.

(ii) Team officials, Grooms, Crews : Smart Team or Individual attire. No Shorts within the Vet Inspection area, or sandals allowed within the 'Field of Play'

(iii) Officials :- Smart working attire, no shorts or Sandals.

10. **Appeal** – Any appeal shall be dealt as per FEI GR 161.

11. **Medical Cover**- The organizers will provide basic medical cover for riders at the venue. The organizers will not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider at the venue or the consequent hospital wherever necessary, through every possible means available. Each rider participating in the event will fill out the Indemnity Release Bond attached to Appendix C and submit the same along with the entry form.

12. **Insurance** – The Organizer recommends that units/clubs/associations/schools to take Insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to the event location during the event. The Organizer will not be held responsible for any accident or illness due to failure or mishap of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.
13. **Responsibility** – The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any animal of any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Organizer nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any aid or other medical treatment provided.
14. **Eligibility of Rider** As per EFI Technical Guidelines/ relevant FEI Rules.
15. **Restriction on Horse** - As per EFI Technical Guidelines/ relevant FEI Rules.
16. **Saddlery and Equipment** - As per EFI Technical Guidelines/ relevant FEI Rules.
17. **Technical conduct** :- As per EFI Technical Guidelines/ relevant FEI Rules.
18. **Accommodation** – All Participants are required to make arrangements for their accommodation. In Case any assistance is required you may contact the organizing committee.
19. **Inspection Decorum**:- As per EFI Technical Guidelines/ relevant FEI Rules.
20. **Abuse/cruelty to horses** – As per EFI Technical Guidelines/ relevant FEI Rules.
21. **Camp**- The organizer has permitted the stabling of horses for all participants in event to be held for the duration of the event. Permission to stable horses during the above period is subject to certain conditions as laid down Pertaining to civilian employees of all contingents including Club members entering the site for temporary stabling will be strictly adhered to. No civilian employee of any contingent will be allowed to enter HRG Stables, Bhadaj, Ahmedabad / Amar Bharti Mahila College, Dehgam, Gujarat without civil police verification.
22. All participants, crew members, and teams have to vacate the facilities provided by the organizers after the event is over and should be returned to the organizers in the condition in which it was provided to them. The rider / crew member is responsible to pay fully for any damages/losses incurred to the facilities provided by the organizers.
23. Rent Chargeable for Stabling:-
 - (a) All teams should preferably come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
 - (b) Fee of Rs 500 will be charged per stable which is set up on the club grounds.
 - (c) The cost of one temporary stable provided by Club is Rs. for the duration of the show on first come first basis'.
24. **Self – Containment** – All teams coming to participate in the above mentioned event will have facilities of accommodation, food and horse stabling on chargeable basis. Kindly reach to the organizing committee for further information.
25. **Ration/Fodder**- Army contingents are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/ fodder to sustain their horses during their stay in Ahmedabad or, they can ask for attachment to the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations.

26. **Coggin and Glander Test** – All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount veterinary Directorate, army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander Status (CFT) certificate on arrival. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 14 days arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.
27. **Trotting Parade** – All participants are requested to present their horses for veterinary inspection (Trotting parade) at 1100 Hours on 20th March 2023.
28. **Ground jury, Veterinary / Technical Delegate, Appeal Committee and insurance-** These are as per Equestrian Federation of India under governing competitions.
29. **Spectators** – The Spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the judges. The Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help. Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena. The Judge's decision will be final. Participants/Team members or Crew Members must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the judges.
30. **Fire Fighting Arrangement** – All contingents are requested to carry adequate fire fighting equipment.
31. **Veterinary Commission** – The Veterinary Commission detailed by the OC will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
32. **Veterinary Assistance** – Vets will be available for vet assistance in case of an emergency. Details of the vets along with their contact will be provided at the event.
33. **Anti Doping.** The organizer will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti-doping policy of NADA and restricted/ banned medicines. The Riders / Athletes who need to use prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition a Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate (TUEC) will be obtained from the doctor prior to taking any medicine.
34. **Compliance of NADA Rules** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for drug testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
35. **Clearance Certificate** – All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Show office at HRG Stables the event location base camp site, during working hours. All accounts concerned needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless they obtain the clearance certificate.

INDEMNITY RELEASE FORM

Hereinafter referred to as "I" and Horse Riding Group Stables; hereinafter referred to as HRG Stables.

It is hereby agreed to as follows:

- 1. HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY:** I understand that horseback riding is a hazardous activity and that horses are unpredictable by nature; that when frightened or angry or under stress, a horse's natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger at a trot, canter, or gallop, to kick, to buck, to rear up in front, or to bite; that horses may trip, stumble, and/or fall down while being led, ridden, or otherwise attended to; that horses may step on feet or other body parts; that the behaviour of horses may be affected by weather, terrain, other animals, and the presence of people; that horses are extremely powerful; and that if a rider falls to the ground, the fall distance will generally be more than 5 feet. I understand that these risks and voluntarily assume these risks and dangers for myself or on behalf of my participating rider, child or legal ward.

- 2. ENDURANCE EVENT:** I understand that travel may be delayed, postponed, interrupted or affected by accident, that horses may be injured in travel, that horses may be certified not fit to compete, show schedules may change, events may be cancelled by show organizers, organizers may take a decision in the interest of the horse, my safety, my psyche's safety, my child or legal ward's safety, or interest of the team, which may result in I or my team members being unable to compete. I understand that it is not guaranteed that I or my team will win a medal or place in the event. All expenses towards endurance event will be contributed by participating members. I also take full responsibility for the actions of all those associated with my stable including my horses. All losses or issues created by the team or horses are solely my personal responsibility and I am legally and financially liable for the same.
