(NORTH INDIA) CATEGORY 'A', 'B' & 'C' AT JAIPUR

General.

1. The FEI Jumping World Challenge -2023 (North India) will be conducted with effect from 12 Nov 2023 to 21 Nov 2023 at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur as per guidelines of the Equestrian Federation of India, FEI Jumping Rules and FEI Jumping World Challenge Rule-2023.

2. **Stabling/ Camp Facility and Charges.**

(a) Venue & stabling will be open on 05 Nov 2023 and close on 25 Nov 2023 at 1800 Hrs.

(b) All teams that require space for stables must send their requirements before 01 Nov 2023 to facilitate smooth adm arng.

(c) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as give below:-

(i) The Camp OIC will provide an area wherein the participants will erect their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse for entire duration of events (05 Nov to 25 Nov 2023) to cater far consumption of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

(ii) **Venue.** The event will be held at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur.

3. **Camping.**

(a) All teams shall come fully equipped with their own tentage for stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of show.

(b) The organisers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder will be made available for sale at retail prices at 61 Cavalry, Jaipur.

(c) All teams must inform the organisers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 01 Nov 2023, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and Army/CPOs.

(d) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(e) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put into the pits provided.

(f) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbin provided. Please minimize your use of plastic materials.

(g) No open fires are permitted within 61 Cavalry, Jaipur premises.

(h) Cutting of trees, branches/ bushes is strictly prohibited.

4. **Self Containment.** All teams coming to participate in the FEI Jumping World Challenge 2023 must be self-contained, in all respects i.e they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping and transport, etc.
5. **Ration/Fodder.** Army Teams can ask for attachment with the local Supply Depot. Other contingents are advised to make their own arrangements for animal rations.
6. **Coggin's and Glanders Tests.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must have a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT) certificate on arrival to as per directions. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.
7. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
8. **Farrier.** All teams and riders are responsible to arrange their own farrier.
9. **Medical Cover.** The Regt will provide first aid medical cover for riders at the venue. The Regt shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences thereof. The Regt will only provide emergency first aid treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary, though every possible available medical cover available. Each rider participating in the FEI World Jumping Challenge 2023 will fill the Indemnity Bond attached to this document and submit the same along with entry form.
10. **Responsibility.** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.
11. **Clearance Certificate.** All horses owners/ riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the organizing committee during working hours. All concerned accounts need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses/ person will be allowed to leave the camp by the Camp in charge unless they obtain the clearance certificate.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

13. **Technical Specification.** Events will be conducted as per FEI Jumping World challenge rules 2023/ FEI Jumping Rules available on FEI/EFI website.

14. **Programme.** Tentative programme of FEI Jumping world Challenge 2023 is att at Appendix 'A'.

15. **Entries.**

(a) All entries will be on proper entry form as per format attached at Appx 'B' should **be submitted to EFI office latest by 05 Nov 2023.** EFI: (M) +91-7042472080 | (E) efiindianf@yahoo.co.in

(b) **Entry Fee-** Rs 1000/- per competition to be paid directly to EFI as per guidelines.

(c) **Closing Date of Entries-** Submission of entries will be closed on 05 Nov 2023. No entries will be accepted post this date as the entries will need to be uploaded on the FEI Portal.

(d) **FEI WJC Horse Declaration.** Participants with more than one horse need to fill the FEI horse declaration form and submit the same to the organizing committee before the VET check.

(e) **Description and Registration of Horses.** All entries must give description, EFI Registration, Passport/ Show Number, EFI Regn Number, Name and year of Birth of the horse.

(f) **Payment.** All entry fees must be paid to Equestrian Federation of India either online, by local cheque or NEFT in favor of Equestrian Federation of India.

16. **EFI Horse Passport.** As per EFI rules all horses participating in the FEI Jumping World Challenge 2023 events must have a valid EFI passport in original. Entries will not be accepted without the EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number of the horse.

17. **EFI Riders Registration.**

(a) As per EFI rules all Riders participating in the EFI Events have to be registered with the EFI.

(b) Entries will not be accepted without **Valid /Renewed/** EFI registration number.

(c) Participating rider must be a life/ individual member of EFI or he/she should be a member of registered club of EFI. The same shall be checked by OC Camp and such cases will not be permitted to participate in the Jumping. Also a list of same will be brought to the notice of EFI as soon as possible.

18. **Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.**

(a) **Withdrawal.** The entry fee of a horse will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitution.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Rider.** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as post entries. Once an event has started being judged, no change in rider/ horse will be accepted.

(d) **Technical specification of event.** The event will follow the FEI Jumping rules/FEI WJC 2023 rules and guidelines of EFI as per relevant discipline.

19. **Cancellation or Reschedule.** The organizing committee may cancel or reschedule any class which has less than four entries or for any reasons after consultation with FEI/EFI. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, depending on the numbers of entries received, the organizing committee may decide against this for any particular event.

20. **Reporting of each class.** All horses will report to the collecting ring steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor show good cause for the delay. The ring steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

21. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

22. **Abuse/ Cruelty to horses.** Refer to EFI Technical guidelines and FEI rules.

23. **Rosettes.** A horse will not wear rosettes during judging.
24. **Elimination/ Disqualification.** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, or any type of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.
25. **Whips/ spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
26. **Dress Code.** When inspecting the course, dress must be neat and tidy, In any case, riding boots, white breeches, white or lightly colored plain shirts, white tie and Jacket must be worn. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone jumping a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with a three point retention harness including riders in uniform.
27. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF should be deposited with the show secretary, 61 Cavalry, Jaipur along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
28. **Compliance of NADA and FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable to be screened for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.
29. **COVID-19 Protocol.** The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.
