REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE PROSPECTUS

General

1. The Regional Equestrian League 2023 will be conducted from February 25th to February 26th 2023 and will be conducted as per the rules of the Equestrian Federation of India by Yadvindra Public School, Patiala.

2. **Entry fees:**

Individual Event **INR 500/-** per entry

Team event **INR 1000** per team

Stabling charges: (a) If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

(b) If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

Show Stables will be allotted on first cum first serve basis

Note: The entries will not be accepted without the COVID - 19 Self Declaration Form.

ADMINISTRATION

3. **Venue.** All events will be held at Raja Bhalindra Singh Sports Complex, Polo Ground, Mall Road, Patiala.

(Note: The venue will open on February 23rd 2023.)

4. **Camp.** All horses will be stabled at temporary stables at the camp site. Stables will be allotted by the organizing committee to all teams depending on the number of horses per team. All horse handlers are permitted to stay along with the horses in temporary accommodation earmarked for the same.

5. Camp In charge: Daljit Singh : +91-97819-40434

6. **Self-containment.** In addition to the above all teams must be self- contained in terms of tentage, equipment for camping and transport inorder to be prepared for any unforeseen emergency.

7. **Ration /Fodder;** All teams should bring their own feed, hay, bedding, grass, etc. for their horses and should make their own provision for staff food. Grass & Bedding can be arranged on special request by the organisers. In case you require this service kindly share your requirement with the Camp in Charge, Mr. Daljit Singh.

8. **Coggin's and Glanders Test;** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI on this subject will be strictly adhered to by all participating teams. All teams must produce a valid negative EIA and Glanders status certificate on arrival with a validity advised by the governing authorities.

9. **Veterinary commission** The Veterinary Commission detailed by Equestrian Federation of India/ Organisers will have the right to examine all the horses participating.

10. **Medical cover.** The organizing committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor on the venue or the consequences thereof. Each rider participating in the Regional Equestrian League will fill the Indemnity Bond attached as and

submit the same along with entry form.

11. Insurance. The organizing committee recommends

club/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to event loc and during the conduct of the events. The organizing committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.

12. Responsibility. The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves.

13. Clearance Certificate. Horse owners are required to obtain clearance certificate from the OC during work hours. All concerned accounts need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses/ Person will be allowed to leave by the Camp In-charge without the clearance certificate.

15. **Note:** The organizing committee may at any time alter/ amend anyof the above conditions owing to unforeseen circumstances.

16. **Covid 19 Protocol.** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training andcompetition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.

A separate set of guidelines will be sent from time to time to ensure safety of all. You are all requested to abide by the same. All decisions made by the

COVID - 19 Compliance Officer will be final and binding.

It is mandatory for all athletes, parents, trainer, grooms and all accompanying individuals to fill the COVID - 19 Self Declaration Form.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

17. Technical Guidelines. Regional Equestrian League will be conducted as per EFI REL Guidelines/ Technical Guidelines in vogue.

18. Schedule of Tentative Events – Attached.

19. Entries.

(a) All entries will be on proper Entry Form as attached for the Regional Equestrian League and should be completed in all respect. Entries not on the prescribed entry form will not be considered.

(b) The entries will not be accepted without the COVID - 19 Self Declaration Form.

(c) Entry fees must be paid by bank transfer only before the submission of the entry forms. Cash payment will not be accepted under any circumstances.

(d) **Entry Fee:**

Individual events INR 500 per entry

Team events INR 1000 per entry

Post entries INR 1000 per entry

(e) **Closing date for Entries** All entries for PHS & Regional Equestrian League will close by **23 Feb 2023**. Entries received thereafter will be accepted as post entry.

- (f) **Description and Registration of Horses:** All entries must give the description, EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number, name and year of birth of the horse concerned.

20. EFI Horses Passport.

As per EFI rules all horses participating in the Regional Equestrian League events must have a valid EFI passport in original. Entries will not be accepted without the EFI Registration/Passport/Show Number of the horse.

21. EFI Rider Registration.

- (a) All riders participating in the Regional Equestrian League must have a valid EFI Rider Identification Number.

22. Grading of Horses: It will be the responsibility of the participant to ensure that their horses are entered in the correct grade as per the latest updated list. Entries of the horses in the wrong grade will lead to elimination from that event and disqualification from the entire horse show.

23. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry.

- (a) **Withdrawal:** The entry fee of a horse will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying an additional entry fee for the class to which is transferred. A horse once entered in any event cannot be

substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever.

(c) **Change of Riders;** Riders cannot be changed unless the Jury accepts that there are sufficient reasons for change of riders. All changes will be treated as Fresh Entries. Once an event has started, being judged, no change in rider / horse will be accepted.

(d) **Technical specification of events;** the events will follow broadly the technical guidelines of FEI and EFI as per relevant discipline. However, the organizing committee reserves the right to amend technical specifications for various events keeping in consideration prevalent weather conditions and local merits / climate in consultations with EFI.

24. Cancellation or reschedule; The Organizing committee may cancel or reschedule any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded. However, depending on the numbers of entries received, the organizing committee may decide against this for any particular event.

25. Reporting for Each Class; All horses will report to the collecting ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated unless the exhibitor shows good cause for the delay. The Ring Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

26. Show Number. All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever

taken out of the stable under the saddle.

27. **Abuse/ Cruelty to horses.** As per EFI / FEI Rules.
28. **Rosettes;** A horse will wear no rosettes during judging.
29. **Elimination / Disqualification;** the judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, or anytype of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.
30. **Whips/spurs;** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
31. **Dress code;** As per EFI guidelines.
32. **Appeal;** Any appeal shall be dealt as per FEI GR 161.

DECLARATION (INDEMNITY BOND)
