

ENTRIES

Each NOC can participate with a maximum of four (4) athlete-horse combinations (no reserve horse can be entered for Dressage) and horses shall have registered at FEI. For NOCs not represented by a Team, they can enter one (1) or two (2) Individuals.

- **PARTICIPATION:** Each NOC with 1 team of 4 Athlete/Horse Combinations / or 1 or 2 Individuals – NO reserve horse.
- **ATHLETAS:** min. 16 years.
- **HORSES SMALL TOUR:** min. 7 years old. Competition 1 (Team & Individual Qualifier) – the FEI Prix St Georges (all athletes) Competition 2 (Individual Qualifier) – the FEI Intermediate I (all athletes), Competition 3 (Individual Final) – the FEI Intermediate I Freestyle.
- **HORSES BIG TOUR:** min. 8 years old. Competition 1 (Team & Individual Qualifier) – the FEI Grand Prix (all athletes), Competition 2 (Individual Qualifier) – the FEI Grand Prix Special (all athletes), Competition 3 (Individual Final) -the FEI Grand Prix Freestyle.

MERs: No requirement for Dressage

TECHNICAL LEVEL

COMPOSED TEAMS – SMALL TOUR / BIG TOUR (maximum 2 athlete-horse Big Tour (Grand Prix combinations))

A TEAM of 4 (four) can be composed of the following combinations:

- 4 (four) Small Tour (St. George) combinations;
- 3 (three) Small Tour (St. George) / 1 (one) Big Tour (Grand Prix) combinations;
- 2 (two) Small Tour (St. George) / 2 (two) Big Tour (Grand Prix) combinations.

A TEAM of 3 (three) can be composed of the following combinations:

- 3 (three) Small Tour (St. George) combinations;
- 2 (two) Small Tour (St. George) / 1 (one) Big Tour (Grand Prix) combinations;
- 1 (one) Small Tour (St. George) / 2 (two) Big Tour (Grand Prix) combinations.

TESTS: There will be two tests according to the technical level of participating combinations:

- **Tests Small Tour:** the FEI Prix St. Georges / the FEI Intermediate I / the FEI Intermediate I Freestyle;
- **Tests Big Tour:** the FEI Grand Prix / the FEI Grand Prix Special / the FEI Grand Prix Freestyle.

COMPETITION DETAIL:

FIRST DAY - Individual/Team qualifying competition:

COMPETITION 1: Team Competition and Individual Qualification

TEST: the FEI Prix-St Georges/the FEI Grand Prix.

OPEN TO: All athletes (All athletes entered in the Individual event must participate in the team event which serves as the qualification for the Individual event.)

DRAW: A draw will be held according to FEI Dressage Rules. Art. 417.4

- The Small Tour combinations will be the first to go in the Team Competition.
 - The Chef d'Equipe will determine the starting order of their Team members.
 - The starting order of the team draw will be kept through both parts of the test (PSG/GP).
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COMPETITION DETAIL:

SECOND DAY - Individual qualifying competition:

COMPETITION 2: Individual Qualification for Final (1st Individual Competition)

TEST: the FEI Intermediate I/ the FEI Grand Prix Special.

OPEN TO: All athletes who have completed Competition 1 (the FEI Prix-St Georges/the FEI Grand Prix).

DRAW: A draw will be held according to FEI Dressage Rules. Art. 417.4

A draw will be conducted as two draws:

- One for the Small Tour.
- One for the Big Tour.
- The Small Tour combinations will be the first to go.

COMPETITION DETAIL:

THIRD DAY - Individual Final competition:

COMPETITION 3: Individual Final (2nd Individual Competition)

TEST: the FEI Intermediate I Freestyle/ the FEI Grand Prix Freestyle.

OPEN TO: Best 15 horses of Individual Qualification for Final, max 2 for each NOC – each athlete must have achieved at least 60% in Competition 2 (1st Individual Competition the FEI Intermediate I/ the FEI Grand Prix Special), to participate in Individual final.

No more than two combinations from the same country may participate in this competition. In the event that among the top 15 best-placed combinations there are four (three) from the same country, the two best-placed combinations from said country will participate in the individual final. In case one of the two best-placed combinations from said country has a Veterinary or Medical issue, the Chef d'Equipe may substitute the combinations until two hours before the Individual Final Competition. All 4 horses must be accepted at the 2nd Horse Inspection.

DRAW: A draw will be held according to FEI Dressage Rules. Art. 417.4

A draw will be conducted as two draws:

- One for the Small Tour and one for the Big Tour.
- The Small Tour combinations will be the first to go.

CLASSIFICATION:

TEAM CLASSIFICATION:

The classification for Dressage Team will be decided with the results of Competition 1, the FEI Prix-St Georges/the FEI Grand Prix.

There will be a bonus point of 2% for each Grand Prix combination per team (i.e. a GP result of 60% will be equivalent to 62%).

The combinations in Small Tour will not receive a bonus point. The drop score will be determined after adding the bonus points to the Grand Prix results.

According to FEI Dressage Rule Art. 425, the team classification is decided as follows:

The winning team is the one having the highest total scores of their three (3), the second placed team is the one with the next highest total and so on.

CLASSIFICATION:

INDIVIDUAL CLASSIFICATION:

The classification of the Dressage Individual will be decided with the results of Competitions the FEI Intermediate I test/ the Grand Prix Special. There will not be a bonus point of 2% for Grand Prix combination.

(1st individual competition open to all riders having completed the FEI Prix-St Georges test/the FEI Grand Prix) and the 2nd individual competition (the FEI Intermediate I Freestyle test/ the FEI Grand Prix Freestyle) open to the top 15 athletes including those tied for the 15th place in the 1st Individual competition.

The final classification of the Individual dressage competition will be decided on the results of the 2nd individual competition Intermediate I Freestyle test/ Grand Prix Freestyle. There will not be a bonus point of 2% for Grand Prix combination.

According to FEI Dressage Rule Art. 425 the individual classification is decided as follows:

The winner is the Athlete having obtained the highest total percentage in the Intermediate I Freestyle/ Grand Prix Freestyle, the second placed Athlete is the one with the next highest total and so on. In case of equality of percentage for remaining places, the Athletes are given the same placing.

CLASSIFICATION:

TIES:

In case of equality of for the first three places, the higher artistic marks will decide on the better placing. Should the artistic mark be the same, the mark for harmony shall decide. In case the athletes are still tied the mark for choreography shall decide



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
