ADM INSTRUCTIONSARMY EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP (AEC) 2024 AT ARPA,
ASC CENTRE & COLLEGE FROM 26 SEP - 09 OCT 2024General.

1. Army Equestrian Championship (AEC) 2024 will be held at ARPAASC Centre & College wef 26 Sep to 09 Oct 2024. Details of the events including specifications are as per attached technical instructions.
2. The competition will be conducted as per FEI and latest EFI Technical guidelines.

Camp Arrangement.

3. The horses and grooms/horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above competition will stay in the camp which will be located in **ASC Centre & College, ARPA**. The camp will be functional wef **21 Sep 2024**. Contingents will ensure that they do not reach the camp before **21 Sep 2024**.
4. The Camp OIC will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp OIC on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accn or property will be the responsibility of the rep of the contingent. The teams should come self-contained in all aspects for camping in respect of their personnel and animals and remain confined to their camps and maintain social distancing from the other teams. The teams should also be well prepared to make electrical connections in their respective camps, any assistance required in this regard should be intimated to Camp OIC by **20 Sep 2024**.
5. All teams will intimate the total str of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 18 Sep 2024 and intimate the ETA well in advance. Format att as **Appx 'E'** to Adm Instructions duly filled and signed must reach the Camp OIC by **18 Sep 2024**.

Accommodation.

6. All participants are required to make arrangement for their accn. In case any assistance is required you may contact Secy, ARPA.

COVID-19.

7. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. All indl are required to produce their vaccination cert on arrival.

Practice and Exercise Area.

8. A suitable area will be earmarked close to the camp for exercise and practice of horses/riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise area will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the events. Staggered timings will be allotted to use the practice/exercise areas to ensure minimum contact.

Lighting.

9. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/patronages/gen sets for emergency use. However, light/power shall be provided under camp arrangements where feasible.

Ration for Army Animals.

10. Rations for animals for all participating Army horses will be drawn from 56 Coy ASC Supply Depot, Bangalore. Sufficient packing materials for storage of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingent for horses and men. Contingent will submit their indent for drawing of ration to 56 Coy ASC Supply Depot, Bangalore directly after publishing their Station Order from K&K Sub Area for attachment with 56 Coy ASC Supply Depot, Bangalore.

Private horses of army personnel should come fully equipped with stabling facilities, fodder and grain etc.

Transport.

11 Contingents are advised to be self-contained for transport.

Line Gear for Animals.

12 Contingents will bring adequate line gear and picketing gear with them. Repair of saddlery and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Safaiwala.

13 The contingents will bring their own safaiwala's for cleaning of respective camp site.

Pitching of Tents.

14 Contingent will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

15 No families will be accommodated in the camp.

Fire Precautions.

16. Contingents will be responsible for organizing own fire fighting precaution of their respective areas. The Camp OIC however, will detail fire fighting/picket parties from amongst the participant the contingent if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

17. Proper sanitation and hygiene measures will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precaution will be taken by all concerned.

Discipline.

18. All participants' grooms and administrative staff coming for the championship and staying in the camp will be under Camp OIC for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

Security.

19. All contingent will ensure highest level of security of their contingent during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Jaipur. Local/station order on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All civilian will be in possession of valid police verification. No unauthorized movement of the personnel staying in the camp without the permission of Camp OIC and the In/Out movement of all personnel will be registered at the camp reception.

Veterinary/Medical Cover.

20. Veterinary cover to army animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Commanding Officer, 49 Mob Vet Hospital, Bangalore who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp.

Coggin's Test for Equine Infectious Anemia & CFT for Glanders.

21. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival at Jaipur as per policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have CFT negative cert and certificate stating the horse is free from any infectious or contagious disease, duly signed by the Veterinary Doctor from the station the horses are coming from, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and CFT negative certificate, **with minimum validity of 15 days on the day of arrival and exit** and the Vet Certificate will be produced to the Camp OIC, failing which the horse will not be allowed inside the camp.

Registration of Horses.

22. Only horses registered with the EFI are permitted to participate in the event. All entries must include the EFI Registration No of horses. Riders/team captains should contact the EFI and obtain regd no of horses which have not yet been registered and pass port.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTION**ARMY EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP (AEC) 2024 AT ARPA
ASC CENTRE & COLLEGE WEF 26 SEP TO 09 OCT 2024**

1. Army Equestrian Championship 2024 (AEC) will be conducted by Agram Riding & Polo Academy according to the FEI rules and Technical guidelines of Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) in vogue. List of events is as per **Appx 'C'** to Technical Instruction and Tentative Pgme is as per **Appx 'D'** to Technical Instruction.
2. **Entry Fee.** Entry fee for various events is as under:-
 - (a) All team events Rs 1000/- per team.
 - (b) All individual events Rs 1000/- per exhibit.
3. **Closing Time / Date of Entries.** Entries will be accepted latest by **1700** hrs on **23 Sep 2024**. Entries after due time / date will be by permission of Ground Jury and payment of Post entry fee as under:-
 - (a) All team events Rs 2000/- per team.
 - (b) All individual events Rs 2000/- per exhibit.
4. **Entries.** All entries will be on the prescribed excel format attached as Appx 'F' to Technical Instruction for events and mailed to trainingmashalarpa@hotmail.com. Riders/Units will be responsible for submitting correct entry, complete in all respects. Entries found not in the exact excel format will be taken as invalid. Riders/Unit/Contingent/Team/Club/participants will be responsible for submitting correct entry as per grade and eligibility of a horse.
5. **Payment.** The entry fee may be paid through QR Code/RTGS/NEFT or by demand draft in favour of ARPA, ASC Centre & College (preferably by cheque).
6. **Transfer and Substitutions.** A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another without paying addl entry fee for the class to which it is transferred. A rider/horse once entered in any event can not be substituted by another for any reason, whatsoever.
7. **Horse passport.** All horses have to be in possession of EFI horse passport as per policy in vogue. No entries will be accepted without valid/renewed/active horse passport issued by EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event.
8. **EFI's Rider Registration.** All Riders participating in the EFI events should possess valid EFI ID Number. Riders not having valid/renewed/active EFI Rider ID number or putting wrong ID number will not be permitted to participate in the events.

9. **Eligibility of Horses & Riders.**

- (a) Riders are responsible for correct entry of the horse in relevant grades.
- (b) All riders are requested to peruse the latest EFI grading list before submitting entries. Riders are liable to be disqualified and /or penalized for incorrect entry of the horse, as per EFI regulations.
- (c) Points of best placed command team per event will be counted towards "Best Command Trophy". However, Medals will be awarded to other teams in case placed in position. Point system for Best Command Trophy will be calculated from team events only.
- (d) Rider and Horse combination to be from the same command.
- (e) Points of highest placed horse rider combination in one event of maximum three horses will be counted towards "Best Rider Trophy".

10. **Technical Specifications of Events.** The events will follow broadly the Technical Guidelines of EFI and FEI rules as per the relevant discipline.

11. **Reporting for Each Class.** All animals will report to the Collecting Ring Stewards half an hour before the time of Judging of that class. Any entry not reporting at the time will be scratched unless the exhibitor shows good causes/reasons for the delay to the satisfaction of the Ground Jury. All horses will proceed from the collecting ring collectively under the steward concerned.

12. **Show Number.** All horses will display the EFI Regn number on the bridle during the veterinary inspection, competition and whenever taken out of the stable under a saddle.

13. **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for vet inspection, rider should be properly dressed. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse to wear a well secured hard hat with three point retention harness. Dress Code for competition will be as per EFI/FEI Guidelines.

14. **Rosettes.** No rosettes will be worn by horse during competition.

15. **Use of whips/spurs.** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

16. **Judging.** Decision of the Ground Jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

17. **Appeal.** Appeal may be lodged in writing by the team captain/competitors as per FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to CHIAF should be deposited with the show secretary, ARPA, ASC Centre & College along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

18. **Responsibility.** The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to animals or any other property or the exhibitors themselves through accident or any cause or in any form.

19. **Disqualification.** The Ground Jury is empowered to disqualify competitors at any stage of the competition / practice for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals or for any reasons which they feel justified. Defaulting on the COVID-19 protocols will also be liable for disqualification.

20. **Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti- Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM)**. As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

21. **Correspondence**. All communication should be addressed to **Show Secretary, ARPA, ASC Centre & College, PIN 900493, c/o 56 APO**, clearly marked at the top centre of the envelope. It would be advisable to send entry form with entry fee draft and other important communications by **Registered Post**.
