CATEGORIES:-

National Tent Pegging is broadly divided into four categories, i.e. Individual Lance Events, Individual Sword Events, Team Lance Events and Team Sword Events. These will include namely nine competitions at the National Equestrian Championship given below:

(a)	Individual	Lance Tent Pegging.
(b)	Individual	Lance-Ring & Peg Lance
(c)	Individual	Sword Tent Pegging Event
(d)	Individual	Sword-Lemon & Peg Sword
(e)	Pair	Lance Tent Pegging Team
(f)	Pair	Sword Tent Pegging Team
(g)	Team	Lance Tent Pegging Team
(h)	Team	Sword Tent Pegging Team
(j)	Relay/ Individual File	Lance and Sword Team

Note: The conduct of events for above categories and award of medals will be as per Tent pegging Rules in Technical Guidelines-2024 (Article - 419).

Instructions:

1. General:

The NEC Tent Pegging event will be held from 15th February, 2025 to 23rd February 2025, at the Punjab Armed Police Grounds in Jalandhar under the aegis of EFI, in accordance with the Technical Guidelines-2024 and FEI's relevant rules and regulations. All participants are advised to review the latest Technical Guidelines-2024, as well as the FEI rules, regulations, and specifications, before the event, regardless of the extracts reproduced in this prospectus.

2. Tentative Schedule:

Attached as **Appendix-'A'**.

3. Eligibility for Participation in Events:

The horse and rider must be members of a club or institution affiliated with EFI. Alternatively, the rider may be an Individual or Life Member of EFI. Riders from any EFI-registered club are permitted to ride horses belonging to another EFI-registered club, provided both clubs are duly registered with EFI.

4. Entry(s):

- a) Entries must be submitted to EFI exclusively by the registered club or institution to which the respective rider is a member, using the prescribed entry form (attached as **Appendix-'C'**) along with the fee deposit voucher. The horse may belong to the same or a different EFI-registered club or institution. All entries will be forwarded to EFI by the registered club or institution of the participating rider.
- b) A Life or Individual Member of EFI may submit their own entries or those of their dependent children (up to the age of 21 years) directly to EFI using the prescribed entry forms (attached as **Appendix-'C'** and **Appendix-'D'**) along with the fee deposit voucher.
- c) All entries must include the EFI horse passport number, EFI registration number, the name of the horse, and the rider's EFI ID, all of which must

be valid.

d) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.

e) Entries must be submitted as per following events separately:-

6. Change of Horse Rider Combination:

There will be no substitution of either the horse or rider after the expiry of the cut-off date and time for late entries, as stipulated in Paragraph 6, for both individuals and teams. However, a horse may be changed with prior approval from EFI on veterinary grounds, provided that the veterinary officials at the Tent Pegging venue diagnose and issue a certificate. This certificate must be forwarded to EFI, along with a request for substitution, by the Club, Institution, Individual, or Life Member who submitted the entry. The request must be submitted through the Show Secretary of the Organizing Committee (OC) for EFI's approval within one hour of the veterinary inspection. No other reasons for substitution will be entertained.

7. Withdrawal of Entries:

Any entry may be withdrawn by 23:59 hrs on 11th February 2025 without any loss of fee. No refund of the fee will be allowed for entries withdrawn after the cut-off date, unless the withdrawal is due to veterinary grounds. In such cases, a certificate from the Veterinary Officer will be required.

8. Instructions for Entries:

No HC entries are permitted in the NEC Tent Pegging.

9. Payment:

Entries must be paid through Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under:

10. Participation List of Individual:

- a) The Federation will provide the Organizing Committee with a list of eligible horse-rider combinations, based on the individual category entries received prior to the horse inspection scheduled on the date specified in the competition schedule. This list will include combinations eligible to participate in various categories according to their grading.
- b) The Organizing Committee will then arrange the horse inspection according to the schedule of events attached as **Appendix-'A'**.
- c) After the horse inspection, the Organizing Committee will conduct a draw of lots for the horses found fit and prepare a start order for the various competitions. The start order will be published through all available means of communication for the information of all participating riders and stakeholders.

11. REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI:

- a) All horses participating in EFI-approved events must possess an EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without an EFI registration number. For further information regarding registration, please contact EFI. Horses participating in the event must be registered with EFI prior to the event through the respective club, individual, life, or institution members, as applicable.
- b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are registered prior to submitting entries for the event. The registration number must be provided on the entry form in accordance with EFI regulations.
- c) Entries will not be accepted without a valid EFI registration number.

12. EFI Rider Registration:

- a) As per EFI rules, all riders participating in EFI events must be registered with EFI.
- b) Entries will not be accepted without a valid EFI registration number.
- c) A participating rider must either be a Life or Individual Member of EFI,

or a member of an EFI-registered club or institution. EFI will verify the eligibility, and any rider who does not meet these criteria will not be allowed to participate.

13. Eligibility of Horses:

Riders are responsible for ensuring their horse is entered correctly according to the relevant EFI rules. Riders are liable to be disqualified or penalized for incorrect entry of the horses, as per EFI regulations.

14. Technical Specifications:

As per EFI/ FEI Rules.

15. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitutions of Entry:

- **Change of Riders**: Riders may not be changed unless the Jury, in consultation with EFI, deems there are sufficient reasons for the change. All changes will be treated as new entries. Once an event has begun, no changes to the rider or horse will be allowed.

16. Reporting for Each Class:

All horses must report to the collecting track Steward at least half an hour before the scheduled judging time of the class. Any entry not reporting on time will be eliminated, unless the exhibitor provides a valid reason for the delay. The track Steward has full authority to take disciplinary action.

17. Abuse/ Cruelty to horses:

As per relevant rules of EFI.

18. Medals:

Medals will be presented in each class only if there are four or more riders or teams. Otherwise, only rosettes will be awarded.

19. Rosettes:-

A horse may not wear any rosettes during judging.

20. Cancellation:

The Organizing Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries or for any reason at their discretion. In such cases, the entry fee will be refunded. However, events where the Minimum Eligibility Requirement (MER) for NEC is involved will proceed, regardless of the number of entries.

21. EFI's Code of Conduct:

Any inappropriate altercation with the Jury, officials, or the Organising Committee by the PR will result in the elimination or disqualification of the rider and horse.

22. Whips/spurs/Tack:

As per EFI rules of the discipline.

23. Dress code:

When presenting a horse for veterinary inspection, the rider must be attired in proper riding attire, including boots. Service personnel will be in uniform. It is mandatory for anyone riding a horse to wear a properly fastened hard hat with a three-point retention harness. The dress code for competition will follow FEI guidelines.

24. Camping & Accommodation:

- a) Venue & stabling will be open on 10th February 2025 and close on 25th March 2025.
- b) All teams must come fully equipped with their own tents for stabling, as well as sufficient grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
- c) The Organizers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
- d) All teams in need of stables must submit their requirements by 05 February 2025. After this date, no stable requests will be accepted.
- e) Camp fee will be charged by the Organising Committee as follows:

- i) If the Organising Committee provides an area where participants are required to build their own temporary sheds, a charge of Rs 500/- per horse will be levied to cover electricity, water, and cleaning costs.
- or
- ii) Temporary stables will be available at Rs 2500/- per stable.
- f) The Organising Committee will take all necessary measures to ensure the safety and security of the camp and prevent any mishaps.
- g) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 10th February 2024, so that an appropriately sized campsite can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.
- h) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.
- i) All Army and Government units will be provided space to set up their own camps. They must bring their own tents and other stabling materials.
- j) The organizers will provide one bulb and an electrical connection for a fan.
- k) All biodegradable waste, including horse dung, must be disposed of in the designated pits.
- l) Open fires are strictly prohibited on Punjab Armed Police grounds.
- m) Practice riding in all other grounds is free of charge.

25. Venue:

The event will take place at the Punjab Armed Police Grounds.

(Note: The camp will open on 10th February 2025 and close on 25th March 2025.)

26. Self-containment:

In addition to the above, all teams must be self-sufficient in terms of tentage, camping equipment, and transport to be prepared for any unforeseen emergencies.

27. Accommodation:

All participants are responsible for arranging their own accommodation. For assistance, you may contact a member of the Organizing Committee at mobile number +919779909002

28. Ration /Fodder:

All teams must bring their own feed, hay, bedding, grass, and other supplies for their horses, as well as make arrangements for their staff's food. The Punjab Armed Police will not provide assistance for these provisions unless special facilities are arranged for all teams.

29. Coggin's and Glanders Test; Medical Protocol requirements for all horses to be Camp at Punjab Armed Police Premises:

Every horse should be accompanied by the following valid Veterinary Documents:

- a) Only Participating horses are allowed in the Camp.
- b) Identification Certificate or Passport along with vaccination record.
- c) All rules and instructions issued from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT or Mallein) certificate on arrival in Punjab Armed Police Main Gate. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory, (Glanders validity 30 days, EIA validity 120 days).
- d) Every horse must be duly vaccinated with the Cal vanza /innovator fluvac innovator vaccine. For horses that are being vaccinated for the 1st time, 3 dosages for Clavanza and 2 dosages for fluvac with a gap of 21 days between each dose is required. Horses already vaccinated will require an annual booster dose.
- e) Proof of Pneumobort – K Vaccination (only for horses coming from within Maharashtra itself) Those horses got fluvac innovator vaccine

do not require pneumobort.

- f) Health Certificate of the horse (Authorized Vets for Certifying: State Veterinary Officer active, Army Veterinary Office active.
- g) Declaration Letter from the owner (on his letterhead) stating where the horse was stabled in the last 60 days before proposed entry into Punjab Armed Police Grounds.

30. Veterinary commission:

The Veterinary Commission detailed by Equestrian Federation of Indian will have the authority to examine all the participating horses. They will also provide veterinary assistance to all horses as needed.

31. Farrier:

All teams and riders are responsible to arranging their own farrier.

32. Medical cover

The organizing committee will not accept any liability for medical treatment administered to a competitor at the venue or for any resulting consequences. Each rider participating in the CDN-Dressage must complete the attached Indemnity Bond and submit it along with the entry form.

33. Insurance

The organizing committee recommends that riders, clubs, and associations obtain insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms, and horses, covering their transportation to the Punjab Armed Police grounds and throughout the duration of the events. The organizing committee will not assume any responsibility for accidents or illness resulting from the fall of any horse, competitor, groom, or any other team member.

34. Responsibility

The organizing committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves.

35. Judging

Decision of the ground jury will be final unless, altered on appeal under rules.

36. Appeal

Appeal may be lodged by competitors in accordance with FEI GR 161. A fee equivalent to 150 CHF in Indian currency must be deposited with the Show Secretary, Organizing Committee, Punjab Armed Police, along with the objection. The fee will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

37. Compliance of NADA Rules and FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulation (EADCM):

As per the current rules, each participant (both human and equine) is subject to doping screening at EFI-approved events. In this regard, if an athlete is approached by NADA to provide a sample for dope testing, they are mandatorily required to comply. Any refusal may result in the athlete's debarment.

38. Clearance Certificate:

Horse owners are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Organising Committee during working hours. All outstanding accounts must be cleared before the certificate can be issued. No horses or persons will be allowed to leave by the Camp In-charge without the clearance certificate.

39. Clarification/direction from EFI:

Issues not covered in the prospectus or the EFI Technical Guidelines-2024 should be referred to EFI through the Organizing Committee for deliberation. An informed decision will then be promulgated, which will be binding on all parties.

41. NEC Tent Pegging Class & Medals:

NEC-Tent Pegging will be conducted with consideration of the clubbing of several event categories by the ITPF at the international level/World Cup. This will also provide equal opportunity for individual Indian Tent Pegging riders, who are not part of any team, to participate at the national level. The marks are as follows:

42. Guidelines for Medals

Minimum standard is required for award of medals for the as mentioned above. The following National Medals will be awarded for first three position as under:

- (a) Individual Lance Medal.
- (b) Individual Sword Medal.
- (c) Individual Lance and Sword.
- (d) Team Sword Medal.
- (e) Team Lance Medal.
- (f) Team Sword and Lance Medal.
- (g) Best Rider Individual score is all 20 runs in nine events of Individual & Team Events.
