



FEI SOLIDARITY PGME: ROR **PROJECT FOR NE INDIA**

❑ **EFI FORWARDED APPLICATION TO THE FEI SOLIDARITY DEPT FOR RETRAINING OF RACE HORSES (ROR) PROJECT AT DIBRUGARH (ASSAM) UNDER ASSAM EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION (AEF) ON 22 JUL 2014.**

❑ **MR JEAN-PHILIPPE CAMBOULIVES FEI SOLIDARITY OFFICER ACCOMPANIED BY SECRETARY GENERAL EFI VISITED DIBRUGARH TO INSPECT FACILITIES AND HOLD FORMAL INTERACTION WITH ALL STAKEHOLDERS OF THE REGION ON 9TH APRIL 2015.**

❑ **ROR PROJECT APPROVED BY THE FEI ON 07 DEC 2015**

❑ **ACTION PLAN: TO TRAIN RIDERS AND EX RACE HORSES CAPABLE OF COMPETING AT ELEMENTARY TO ADVANCE LEVEL IN DRESSAGE, 120 CM IN JUMPING AND CIC* EVENTING. THIS WILL BE DONE BY HOLDING A SERIES OF PROGRESSIVE TRAINING CAMPS SPREAD OVER A TWO YEAR PERIOD COMMENCING FROM OCTOBER 2016. AT THIS STAGE 10 TO 12 TRAINING CAMPS SHALL BE CONDUCTED SPREAD OVER TWO YEARS, EACH CAMP WILL BE OF TWELVE TO FOURTEEN DAYS DURATION. THE DETAILED TRAINING SCHEDULE WILL HOWEVER BE PREPARED BY THE FEI NOMINATED RESOURCE PERSON AFTER HIS INITIAL VISIT.**

❑ **INFRASTRUCTURE: INFRASTRUCTURE SUCH AS ACCOMMODATION FOR HORSES, PERSONNEL, TRAINING AREA AND TRAINING AIDS ARE AVAILABLE AT DIBRUGARH, ASSAM.**



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❑ TOTAL BUDGET: CHF 52,000/- (CHF 26,000/- PER YEAR FOR TWO YEARS). THE SANCTIONED AMOUNT IS MEANT FOR THE TRAINER'S TRAVEL EXPENSES AND FEE PAYABLE TO HIM (AS CLARIFIED BY THE FEI). THE FUNDING WILL BE DIRECTLY DISBURSED TO THE FEI NOMINATED RESOURCE PERSON BY THE FEI SOLIDARITY DEPARTMENT. ALL OTHER EXPENSES PERTAINING TO THE HOSTING OF THE CAMP INCLUDING THE TRAINERS LOCAL HOSPITALITY WILL HAVE TO BE BORNE BY EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION OF ASSAM ON BEHALF OF THE EFI.

❑ MR ANTHONY LOWRY IS THE RESOURCE PERSON FOR THE ROR PROJECT IN ASSAM APPOINTED BY THE FEI.

❑ PARTICIPANTS / BENEFICIARIES: RIDERS FROM ASSAM, MANIPUR, ASSAM POLICE AND WEST BENGAL / KOLKATA POLICE WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN THE PROPOSED PROJECT. TRAINERS FROM ASSAM VALLEY SCHOOL, ROYAL GLOBAL SCHOOL AND DPS NUMALIGARH WILL ALSO JOIN THE CAMPS. TO OPTIMIZE THE OUTCOME OF THE PROJECT THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS TO BE APPROXIMATELY TWELVE IN NUMBER.
