GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **General.** **National Equestrian Championship Show Jumping Preliminary and Junior National Equestrian Championship-2023** will be held with effect from 20 Dec to 30 Dec 2023 at AGRAM Riding & Polo Academy, Bangalore under the aegis of the Equestrian Federation of India. All participants are advised to go through the EFI technical guidelines, rules, regulations and specification, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.

2. **Events-** Refer Appendix 'F'.

3. **Tentative Programme**– Refer Appendix 'G'.

4. **Age Eligibility of Riders for JNEC Events.** Age Categories and eligibility of Riders as per EFI/FEI rules are as under-

(a)	Young Rider	Riders 16 to 21 years (born between 1 Jan 2002 to 31 Dec 2007)
(b)	Junior	Riders 14 to 18 years (born between 1 Jan 2005 to 31 Dec 2009)
(c)	Children – I	Riders 12 to 14 years (born between 1 Jan 2009 to 31 Dec 2011)
(d)	Children – II	Riders 10 to 12 years (born between 1 Jan 2011 to 31 Dec 2013)

Auth : Article 502 Technical Guideline 2021 of EFI

Note:-

(a) Age as on 1st Jan of the Calendar year will considered valid upto 31st Dec.

(b) It will be compulsory to submit the birth certificate and EFI registration number along with the entry form by the respective club/individual/life/ institution member as applicable.

(c) Foreign Nationals cannot participate in the NEC Show Jumping Preliminary and Junior National Equestrian Championship.

5. **Eligibility for Participation in Events** Horse and Rider to be a member of club/institution affiliated with EFI and or the Rider can be an Individual or Life member of EFI, wherein the horse shall be ridden by the owner or their dependent NOK upto to age of 21 years. It is worthy to note that any rider from any club registered with EFI can ride any horse of any other club provided that both the clubs are registered with EFI.

6 **Entry(s).**

(a) Entry(s) must be sent to the EFI only by the registered club/institution member of which the respective rider is a member on prescribed entry form attachment as Appx H, J alongwith fee deposition slip. The horse can be of same or different registered club/ institution member of EFI. The entry(s) will be forwarded to EFI by the club/institution member of the participating rider.

(b) A life/individual member of EFI can send their own entrie(s) or of their dependent children upto the age of 21 years directly to EFI on the prescribed entry form attachment as Appx H, J alongwith fee deposition slip.

- (c) Entry(s) can also be sent by life/individual members if they themselves or their NOK upto the age of 21 years are desirous to participate in the NEC Show Jumping Prelim /NEC or both.
- (d) All entry(s) for Young Riders, Juniors, and children I&II category riders must be accompanied by proof of age (passport/national ID).
- (e) All entry(s) must have EFI horse passport number, EFI registration number and name of the horse as well as and rider's EFI I.D.
- (f) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.
- (g) An eligible rider can take part on a maximum of two horses in all disciplines including NEC Show Jumping Prelim except Dressage which will be strictly as per final list of participation promulgated by EFI.
- (h) In case of riders participating on two horses in Show Jumping (Normal) and/or Dressage they can be part of one team only of respective discipline.

7. **Entry Fee**

- (a) Normal entry fee will be as under:-
- (i) Team Events –Rs 2000/-per team.
 - (ii) Individual Events-Rs 1000/-per entry
- (b) Late entry fee will be as under:-
- (i) Team Events: Rs.4,000/- per team.
 - (ii) Individual Events Rs.2,000/-per exhibit

9. **Withdrawal of Entries** Any entry can be withdrawn by 23 :59hrs, 16 December 2023 without attracting any loss of fee. No refund of fee will be allowed for entries withdrawn after cut off date unless it has to be withdrawn on Veterinary grounds and in such cases, a certificate from the Veterinary Officer will be required.

10. **Instructions for Entries**. For Young Rider, Junior, Children – I & Children – II Dressage and Show Jumping events, only the riders who qualified through REL will be allowed to participate in the respective categories in Individual, Team and side events of JNEC 2023 (Para 9 of REL Guidelines 2023 refers). No HC entry is allowed for NEC Show Jumping Prelim and JNEC.

11. **Payment**. Entries must be paid through Bank transfer. Bank details of EFI for electronic payment are as under :

12. **Participation List of Individual & Team**

(a) The Federation will forward to the OC the list of Horse Rider combinations who would be eligible to participate in various disciplines as per their category.

(c) The OC will accordingly arrange their horse inspection as per the schedule of Events attached as Appx G.

(d) Post horse inspection the OC will carry out draw of lots and prepare start order of various competitions and publish the same through all available means of communication for info of all participating riders/stakeholders.

13. **REGISTRATION OF HORSES WITH EFI**

(a) All horses participating in the EFI approved events have to be in possession of the EFI passport. No entry will be accepted without EFI Registration number. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the event through respective club/individual/life/ institution members as applicable.

(b) Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before entries for the Event. The registration number has to be filled in the entry form as per EFI ruling.

(c) Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

14. **REGISTRATION OF RIDERS WITH EFI**. As per EFI Guidelines

15. **Participation of Horse & Athletes** Only eligible horses and riders can participate in NEC Show Jumping Prelim and JNEC who had achieved qualification in RELs as per the list published on EFI website. The same shall be checked by the OC. If any horse and rider found without membership of registered club/institution of EFI then OC will be responsible for the same. The same is also applicable for life/individual member.

16. **Participation of Horses in Equestrian Events** A horses will not be allowed to participate in more than three rounds of events in a day. One horse can participate only once in each category (Children I, Children II, Junior & Young Rider) of discipline (Dressage, Show Jumping & Eventing). Maximum participation of a horse in a day will be as under:-

Category : Children I/Children II/ Junior/ Young Rider

- (i) Two Dressage Competition and a side event of Jumping

OR

- (ii) Two rounds of jumping normal and one Dressage competition

17. **Elimination Round** In case there are a large number of participants for any event, elimination round may be held.
18. **Cancellation of an Event** A min of 4 entries in individual and same under Team Category should exist for event to be conducted or else the OC will cancel the event.
19. All events scheduled in the afternoon will continue under lights, if required.
20. **Change In Schedule of Events** The organizers may make changes in the schedule of events with prior approval of EFI for which communication to be made by OC to all athletes through all communication means available
21. **Responsibility**. The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Organizer nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any aid or other medical treatment provided.
22. **Show Numbers** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition, veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the camp.
23. **Judging** As per FEI/EFI Rules.
24. **Elimination/ Disqualification**. As per FEI/EFI Rules.
25. **Insurance**. The Organizer recommends that club/institution/individual/life member to take Insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to Bangalore to during the events. The Organizer will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness during the duration of the NEC Show Jumping Preliminary and JNEC 2023-24 at AGRAM Riding & Polo Academy, Bangalore of any horse, competitors, groom/ any other member of the team.
26. **Protest**
- (a) All objections must be made in writing to the Show Secy as per FEI GR-161.
- (b) A fee of INR 13,500 (Rupees Thirteen Thousand and Five Hundred only) will accompany the protest. If the protest is overruled by the Jury, the deposit will be forfeited. The amount will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- (c) All Protests will be governed by relevant EFI/FEI rules.
27. **Loss or Damage** The organizers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any horse, rider or to any other person or property arising directly or indirectly from accident or any other causes. Neither the Committee nor the Vet / Med doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

28. **Medical Cover.** OC will provide medical cover for riders at the venue. OC shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a rider on the venue or the consequences hospital where necessary, through every possible means available. Each rider participating in the NEC Show Jumping Preliminary and Junior National Equestrian Championship-2023 will fill the indemnity Bond attached at **Appendix H** and submit the same along with entry form.
29. **Abuse/Cruelty** As per relevant FEI/EFI Rules.
30. **Abandonment** If for any reasons the show has to be abandoned, the competing units/civilian participants and concerned riders will be informed by all available members.
31. **Rules** The rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) and the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) will be followed for the conduct of the events of the competition, until and unless otherwise specified for any event.
32. **Tacks, Whips And Spurs** As per EFI guidelines and FEI rules
33. **Questions Not Provided for** In the eventuality of any questions arising that has not been covered in this prospectus, the matter will be referred to Secy Gen of EFI and the decision of federation will be final and binding.
34. **Arrival of the Horses / Riders at the Show Ground** All horses/riders should be present at the venue half an hour before the scheduled starting time for the respective event and report to the Marshall of the event.
35. **Camping and Accommodation**
- (a) It is the intention of the organisers to accommodate and stable all civil horses at the ARPA. However, space will be allocated on a First Come First basis. The camp will function from the 16th December 2023 to 31st December 2023. The representative of ARPA will earmark site for each team at the club. The team in charge will take over the sites allotted to them on arrival and hand them over before departure in the same condition. The team in charge shall be responsible for his teams discipline, security and precautions towards fire.
 - (b) All Army horses will be stabled at AT Harbour. The camp for the same would be functional from 16 Dec 2023. For any queries regarding stabling arrangements and transportation of Army Horses please contact Maj Vishwadeep Dahiya **(9622521414)**. The camp will open on 01st Dec 2023 and closes on 31Dec 2023.
 - (c) All teams should come fully equipped with their own arrangement for stabling and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
 - (d) The Organizers will try to arrange for bedding **straw and fodder to be made available** for sale at retail prices.
 - (e) All teams that require stables must send their requirements on or before 30th Nov 2023 after which no stable orders will be accepted.
 - (f) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse for the duration the event.

(g) The OC will ensure at all times the safety and security of the camp to avoid any mishap.

(h) All teams must inform the organizers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by the 30th November 2023, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.

(j) All teams must inform the organizers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(k) All Army and Government units will be provided space to set up their own camps. All tentage and other stabling material to be brought by them.

(l) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put in to the pits provided.

(m) No open fires are permitted on The ARPA Club grounds.

(m) The Camp in charge will earmark the site for each contingent. The rep of the contingent will take over the site allotted to them from the Camp In charge on arrival & hand over the same before departure in the same condition, any damage to camp, accommodation or property will be the responsibility of the contingent. The teams should come self contained in all aspects for camping in respect of their personnel and horses. All teams will intimate the total strength of contingent in terms of men and horses positively by 30 Nov 2023. They should intimate expected time of arrival well in advance to ARPA to make administrative arrangements.

36. **Fire Fighting Arrangement** All contingents are requested to carry adequate fire fighting equipment.

37. **Coggin and Glander Test.** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI, NRC, ICAR Hissar and RVC Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander Status (CFT) certificate on arrival to ARPA Bangalore. Coggins and glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory. The above is as per the requirements of EFI.

38. **Spectators.** The Spectators or the supporters of the participants are not to interfere with the judges. The Arena Steward has the right to eliminate any participant who has outside help. Once the event has commenced, all spectators and helpers are to clear the arena. The Judges decision will be final. Parents must not enter the arena or dispute the decision or directly confront the judges.

39. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating. The FEI vet regulation alongwith their GR will be followed.

40. **Vet Protocol** It is mandatory for all teams to submit the following valid test reports in respect of their horses before entering the camp :-

- (a) Glanders Test
- (b) Coggins Tests
- (c) Vaccination with Fluvac or Calvenza vaccines

41. **Anti Doping.** The organizer will detail a Doctor who is well versed with the anti doping policy of NADA and restricted/banned medicines. The Riders/Athletes who need to use prohibited medication to treat a legitimate medical condition during the competition a **Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate (TUEC)** will be obtained from the doctor prior to taking any medicine.

42. **Clearance Certificate** All horse owners/riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the ARPA Club Show Office during working hours. All accounts concerned needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses will be allowed to leave unless they obtain the clearance certificate.

43 **Compliance of NADA Rules and EFI Equine Anti- doping and Controlled medication Regulation (EADCM).** As per rules in vogue each participant (Both human and Equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In View of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for doping testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same . Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete.

44. **Draw of Lots/Starting Order** The draw of lots will normally be held on the day before the day of the event. However, the organizers may change the draw of lots to any other time, after making necessary announcements for the same.

45. **Horses Inspection** As per Schedule of events.

46. **Clarification/direction from EFI.** Issues not covered in prospectus/EFI-Technical Guidelines-2021 should be referred to EFI through OC for deliberation based on which an informed decision will be promulgated which will be binding on all parties.

- (a) All athletes participate in respective categories as stated above will submit an indemnity bond and age proof alongwith their entries to the OC.
- (b) Freestyle to Music for Junior and Young Rider categories only will be conducted. The participation in Freestyle to Music shall be restricted to only top 15 Horse-Rider combinations who have scored above 60% marks in their normal category.
- (c) Individual medals will be given to winner of Freestyle to Music of each category.
- (d) Normal category will be awarded medals only for Team placing. However, participation in normal category is mandatory for all Horse-Rider combination to take part in Freestyle to Music.

Article 502**ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS IN NEC / REGIONAL SENIOR EVENTS**

1. In **Dressage and Jumping** a Young rider / Junior rider, **14 years and above**, can participate in a NEC / Regional Senior event in the same show on a appropriately graded horse without effecting their JNEC status.
2. In **Eventing**, a Young rider / Junior rider **16 years and above**, can participate in a NEC / Regional Senior event in the same show, without effecting their JNEC status, but **not** on a horse that is entered in the senior category with another senior rider in the same show.
3. In **Endurance** a YR / Junior rider **14 years and above**, can participate in a NEC / Regional Senior event in the same show, without affecting their JNEC status, but not on a horse that is entered in the senior category in the same show.
4. In **Tent Pegging**, a Young rider / Junior rider **16 years and above**, can participate in a NEC / Regional Senior event in the same show without effecting their JNEC status.
5. FEI World Challenge Children Dressage & FEI International Children's Jumping Competition is open to riders aged 12 to 14 yrs.
6. Age of the rider would be calculated as on 01 Jan of a particular year irrespective of the month of birth of the rider and the age which would be valid upto 31 Dec of that particular year. Eg. DOB 28 Jun 2009. The child would be considered 12 year old as on 01 Jan 2021 and would remain 12 years upto 31 Dec 2021.
7. Since there is an overlap of age in all categories, the rider has the choice to participate in a higher category in the **JNEC in all or number of events as per his/her choice**. However, once a rider decides to participate in a particular higher category he/she can be downgraded **only** the next year in that particular event. Such riders can further upgrade themselves in subsequent JNEC's only once they are in the age bracket of the category to which they upgraded themselves.
8. For participation in **International competitions** the lower age limit is **16 years**.
9. **Riders holding valid Indian passport are permitted to participate in JNEC.**

 - (b) No jump off will be held for Young Riders and Junior Jumping as the 2nd round will be against time.

- (c) Followed by Cross country and jumping (CH format).

2. **Eligibility/Restriction on horses:** - All horses 4 years of age and above are eligible. **There is no restriction on the grade of horses.**

3. **Dressage Test :** Attached (Appendix 'E') as per CCI* competition (FEI).

Article 507

1. Horse should ideally finish as close to optimum time as possible (**IN JNEC EVENTING ALL HORSES THAT FINISH MORE THAN 30 SECONDS BEFORE THE OPTIMUM TIME IN CROSS COUNTRY WILL BE PENALIZED BY 25 PENALTIES**).
2. For award of National medal there can be separate competition or separate medal with in same competition for Junior and Young riders.

Article 508

ENDURANCE

1. All Pre-Novice, Novice, Intermediate and 1 star events for Junior and Young riders will be same as Article 501 above. For 2 star Young Rider events a minimum of 120 km and maximum of 130 km in one day as per Article 802.4.3 of FEI Endurance rules will be applicable.
2. For conduct of the event, all guidelines as applicable for senior riders will be applicable for JNEC also.
3. For award of National medal there can be separate competition or separate medal with in same competition for Junior and Young riders.
4. A Junior or young rider while participating in senior competition or once he attains age of a senior rider, he will be retain his level achieved as per Endurance rules/ Technical Guidelines.

TECHNICAL CONDUCT AND VETERINARY REGULATIONS

1. For JNEC Eventing the technical standards of cross country and show jumping would be of Novice Eventing and the dressage test would be of CC1* competition, in case of any discrepancy in rules, EFI Technical guidelines for Eventing in conjunction with FEI Eventing Rules and FEI General Regulations may please be referred.

2. **For Dressage, Show Jumping and Endurance.** As per FEI Dressage Rules, FEI Show Jumping Rules, FEI Endurance Rules and FEI General Regulations.

3. **For Tent Pegging** - As per EFI and ITPF Rules.

4. **For Veterinary Purposes** - As per FEI Veterinary Regulations.

Article 511

Rider Points :- A Rider can enter a max of two horses in any one event of the JNEC. If two horses are entered the rider will have to nominate one horse. Only the penalties on the nominated horse will be counted towards rider points. However, he may be awarded medals for both horses. The nominated horse will start before the second horse in the competition.

Article 512

No HC entries are permitted in JNEC. However, EFI reserves the right to permit a rider to take part with prior approval of EFI in one or more than one discipline in age category as applicable based on the merit of the case.

Article 513**PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATE**

As the riders participating in Show Jumping and Dressage are selected through Regional Equestrian League (REL) they should be provided with participation certificate. Only riders participating in Eventing, Show Jumping (Normal) and Dressage (Normal) will be given the participation certificate for individual category only. In case of Tent Pegging & Endurance the top 25% of the riders for individual entry only may be given participation certificate.

Article 514**PARTICIPATION OF HORSES IN EQUESTRIAN EVENTS**

1. A horse should not be allowed to participate in more than three rounds of events in a day. One horse can participate only once with each category (Children I, Children II, Junior & Young Rider) of discipline (Dressage, Show Jumping & Eventing). Maximum participation of a horse in a day is as under:-

Children Category

- (i) Two normal Jumping rounds and one side event
OR
- (ii) Two Dressage competition and a side event of Jumping
OR
- (iii) Two rounds of Jumping normal and one Dressage competition

Junior/Young/Senior Category

- (i) Not more than two rounds of events (Dressage or Show Jumping).

2. All Organisers/Jury/Officials will ensure to implement the new guidelines in forthcoming events.
